PLEASE TAKE NOTE - To comply with BRC Guidelines, there will be NO COURSE WALK on the night. Course plans will be added to the Cornwall Trec Facebook page as soon as they are ready. You will be given a chance to "walk the course" whilst mounted before the bell rings.
Warm Up - Times will be given for both Warm up and Competition, you will be given a warm up time, followed by your competition time.

Riding hats to be securely fastened and to current standards in BRC Rulebook.

RULES:

- This competition is run under British Riding Club Rules. Please check the rule book.
- Juniors under the age of 18 years must be accompanied by an adult. (Following COVID-19 guidance, adults will need to remain in the carpark)
- Judges & Stewards decision is final.
- Competitors, Horses and Helpers attend this event entirely at their own risk. (No spectators are allowed at this event)
- There will be no refund of entries.
- Competition attire and correct footwear to be worn.

COVID-19 GUIDANCE

Only one helper per rider and horse, one additional person can be permitted per junior or disabled rider, however all parents/grooms will not be allowed through to the competition area.

Anybody displaying any COVID-19 symptoms, however mild, should stay at home. Anybody who has been in contact with someone that is showing symptoms should stay at home.

All those attending should check their own temperature before leaving home. Riders are permitted to wear soft face masks that cover the mouth and nose, but no face shields are permitted. Nothing is to be attached to the riding hat. Hand sanitising stations will be available at various points around the site.

Please consider social distancing when parking trailers and lorries. If you wish to tie your horse to the side of your trailer or lorry, please allow a minimum of 5M apart.

All social spaces will be closed, including the toilets (bring a bucket!) No grooms/drivers/parents will be allowed through from the carpark, only horse and rider will be permitted.

Times will be allocated for both warm up and competition, you will not be allowed through from the carpark area before your time so please do not arrive early in hope that you can, however please be on time as we will not be able to accommodate any late arrivals.

We will be operating a very strict One way System to be able to run this event safely and comply to all COVID-19 guidelines.

You will only be allowed through from the car park area when instructed.

Rosettes.

These will be available on the night, once results are announced you will be able to collect your rosette from the plastic boxes in the car park area, we ask that you please sanitise your hands before touching the boxes using the sanitiser provided and respect social distancing while collecting your rosette. All results will be published on our Facebook page, should you not want to wait until the class has finished, there is the option of paying £1 for postage, please contact Louise on chair@cornwalltrecgroup.co.uk if you would like to arrange postage.

Anyone that does not comply with the event protocols will be disqualified and asked to leave the site immediately. There will be no exception to this rule. Any such instances will also be reported to the BRC HQ for further disciplinary consideration if deemed appropriate.
