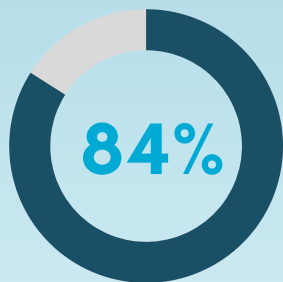

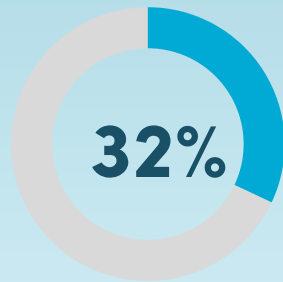

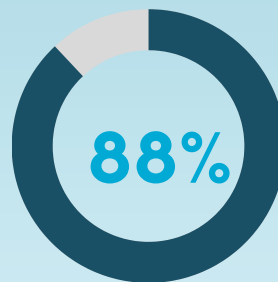
What do visitors do at the Midlands Machinery Show?



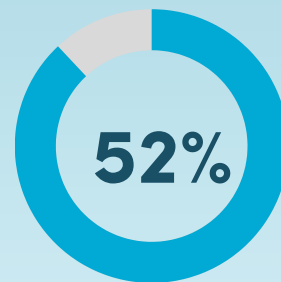

Indoor stands are in our permanent buildings and space sizes range from 4m x 3m to 12m x 9m with varying height clearance. There are a range of exhibition buildings to select from:

Stanley Sheldon Hall

Offering a total of 2,976 sqm. Maximum height clearance of 6.3m, minimum height clearance of 3.2m.

Fully Enclosed Marquee Option

The more premium of the two marquee options, full enclosed marquee complete with flooring, heating and large doors. The height clearance is 2.9m with a maximum of 4.5m.

Open Fronted Marquee Option

A simple, covered space, providing shelter from the elements but retaining the visibility of outdoor stand space.

The space is sold in 5m frontage by 10m depth blocks with a height clearance of 3.9m.
