### **GUIDANCE NOTES FOR COMPLETION OF FORM**

Using the guidelines suggested below please consider what risks there are to those people setting up/dismantling, manning and members of the public attending your stand on Show day.

#### HAZARD

Look for hazards which you could reasonably expect to result in significant harm under the conditions in the workplace. Use examples below as a guide:

Slipping/tripping hazards

Chemical (eg battery acid)

Moving parts of machinery

Vehicles (eg forklift trucks)

Electricity (eg poor wiring)

Animal bedding (ie straw)

Work at height

Ejection of material

Pressure systems

Manual handling

Dust

**Fumes** 

Noise Poor lighting Low temperature

Fire (eg from flammable material)

#### CONTROLS TO MINIMISE RISK

### **FURTHER ACTION**

What more could you reasonably do for those risks which were not adequately controlled? You will need to give priority to those risks which may affect large numbers of people or could result in serious harm. Apply principles as listed below:

Remove risk completely. Try a less risky option. Prevent access to the hazard (eg by guarding). Organise work to reduce exposure to the hazard. Issue personal protective equipment. Provide welfare facilities (eg washing facilities and first aid).

Represent good practice.

Meet the standards set by legal

Comply with recognised industry standard.

Reduce risk as far as reasonably possible.
