Class 2

In hand veteran , 15 years and over.

Class 3

In hand, Miniature horse, any age or colour.

class 4

In hand Mountain and Moorland ponies, small breeds 4 years and

over.

Open to registered Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, Welsh Section A, Welsh Section B ; stallions, mares and geldings four years old and over.

Class 5

In hand Mountain and Moorland ponies, large breeds 4 years and over. Open to Dales, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Connemara and Welsh Section C & D, Stallions, mares and geldings four years old and over.

Class 6

In hand Mountain and Moorland ponies; 1,2 and 3 year olds. A rosette will be awarded to the best yearling.

Open to registered Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, Welsh Section A, Welsh Section B, Dales, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Connemara and Welsh Section C&D

Ring Two To be judged by Oliver Burchell

Class 7 In hand show pony 1,2 or 3 year old A rosette will be awarded for the best yearling.

Class 8 In hand show pony, 4 years and over.

Class 9 In hand show hunter pony 1,2 or 3 year old A rosette will be awarded for the best yearling.

Class 10 In hand show hunter pony, 4 years and over. Class 11

In hand Part bred M&M or Arab.

Part Bred Arab. To be registered in the part bred or Anglo Arab section of the Arab Horse Society, with a minimum 12.5% Arab blood and Part bred M&M. Pony to be registered in the part bred section of one of the M&M Stud Books, with a minimum of 12.5% of that breed blood

Class 20

Ridden Novice M&M large breeds; Open to Dales, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Connemara and Welsh Section C & D, Stallions, mares and geldings four years old and over.

Class 21

Ridden M&M small breeds Open; Open to registered Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, Welsh Section A, Welsh Section B ; stallions, mares and geldings four years old and over.
