# CHAMPIONSHIP FINAL FOR CHAMPIONS AND RESERVES FROM SPRING, SUMMER AND FOAL AND ADULT SHOW TO COMPETE. SASH TO CHAMPION

### NPS CLASSES RING ONE

This show is affiliated to the National Pony Society and the NPS affiliated classes will be run under NPS rules. Classes are open to Members and Non-Members of the NPS, but Non-Members will need to become members to enter the finals at the NPS Spring Festival 2025. The NPS General Rules for Showing apply (see NPS website for details).

In each class the three highest placed ponies, not already qualified, within the first six places, will qualify.

Winnings in the 2024/2025 Novice and Pure Novice Winter Championships will not debar ponies from the NPS 2024 Mountain and Moorland Novice Ridden competitions. Qualification cards will be awarded in the ring.

#### NPS/LEYHILLS STUD M&M IN-HAND CHAMPIONSHIP

This Competition is open to Mountain & Moorland ponies registered in the main body of their respective

Mountain & Moorland Stud Books.

At Foal Shows, the first three ponies in each class will qualify for the Yearling Final at the Spring Festival.

There are four classes as follows (may be amalgamated into two classes, either split by age or by breed size

large and small):

Class 75) Small Breeds, Yearling, 2 and 3 years old Colt, Filly or Gelding.

Class 76) Small Breeds, 4 years and over, Stallion, Mare or Gelding.

Class 77) Large Breeds, Yearling, 2 and 3 years old Colt, Filly or Gelding.

Class 78) Large Breeds, 4 years and over, Stallion, Mare or Gelding.

Handler any age, except for stallions or colts where the handler must be 14 years of age or over.

Winners and second place from classes 75-78 are eligible for the NPS/Blackertor & Sharptor Studs M&M In Hand Silver Medal Rosette Championship.

A Silver Medal Rosette is offered by the National Pony Society for the best registered pony owned by an NPS Qualifying or Life member in the M&M In Hand section. Qualifiers are entitled to compete in the final of the Silver Medal Rosette Championship to be held at the 2025 NPS Summer Championship Show.

A pony can only attend one M&M In Hand Silver Medal Rosette Championship final in a season either at NPS Summer Championships at Malvern or at NPS Scotland Championships at Blair. A pony may only take the qualification for the Silver Medal Final once in a season.

### **NPS RIDDEN QUALIFIERS**

### Class 79) NPS M&M FIRST RIDDEN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP

This Competition is open to mares and geldings four years old or over, registered in the main body of their respective Mountain and Moorland Stud Book. Not exceeding 128cms. (Riders must not have attained their 12th birthday by 1st January in the current year).

### Class 80) NPS/AREA 25 M&M NOVICE FIRST RIDDEN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP

This Competition is open to mares and geldings four years old or over, registered in the main body of their respective Mountain and Moorland Stud Book. Not exceeding 128cms. Pony not to have won a first prize in any First Ridden class before 1st September in the current season. Ponies must not be cantered except in their individual show. (Riders must not have attained their 12th birthday by 1st January in the current year).

### Class 81) NPS M&M LEADING REIN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP

This Competition is open to mares and geldings four years old or over, registered in the main body of their respective Mountain and Moorland Stud Book. Not exceeding 122cms. To be led by an attendant and shown in a snaffle bit, the leading rein to be attached to the noseband only. The reins must go directly from the bit to the rider's hands. (Riders must not have attained their 9th birthday by 1st January in the current year).

### Class 82) NPS/MARION WILLIAMS MEMORIAL M&M NOVICE LEADING REIN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP

This Competition is open to mares and geldings four years old or over, registered in the main body of their respective Mountain and Moorland Stud Book. Not exceeding 122cms. Pony not to have won a first prize in any Leading Rein class before 1st September in the current season. To be shown in a snaffle bit, the leading rein must be attached to the noseband only. The reins must go directly from the bit to the rider's hands. (Riders must not have attained their 9th birthday by 1st January in the current year).

Mini Championship. Winners and second places from classes 79-82 are eligible for the Mini Championship.

### NPS/CE FULLER & SON M&M OPEN RIDDEN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP

This Competition is open to stallions, mares and geldings five years old or over which must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Book. Rider any age (except stallions – see NPS Rules).

Pony not to have won a first prize of £10 or more in any open Ridden M&M Class before 1st September in the current season. Rider any age (except stallions – see NPS Rules)

### NPS/FREESTEP M&M PURE NOVICE RIDDEN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP

This Competition is open to stallions, mares and geldings four years old or over which must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Book. Pony not to have been placed first in any Ridden Mountain & Moorland Class (excluding Lead Rein or First Ridden) before 1st September in the current season. All ponies in this class must be shown in a snaffle bit. Rider any age (except stallions – see NPS Rules).

Class 87) Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, Welsh A & B

Class 88) Connemara, Dales, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Welsh C & D

Winners and second place from classes 83-88 are eligible for the NPS/ Nipna Dales Pony Stud M&M Ridden Silver Medal Rosette Championship

A Silver Medal Rosette is offered by the National Pony Society for the best registered pony owned by an NPS Qualifying or Life member in the M&M Ridden section. Qualifiers are entitled to compete in the final of the Silver Medal Rosette Championship to be held at the 2025 NPS Summer Championship Show.

A pony can only attend one M&M In Hand Silver Medal Rosette Championship final in a season either at NPS Summer Championships at Malvern or at NPS Scotland Championships at Blair. A pony may only take the qualification for the Silver Medal Final once in a season.

**NPS Silver Medal Rosette Championships:** 

These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. NPS Silver Medal Rosettes are only awarded when the owner of the champion pony is a Qualifying or Life member of the NPS.

The owner's valid membership card must be in the rider's/handler's possession on entering the ring and be produced immediately on request by either the judge or the steward.

If the owner of the Champion pony is not a member, or the owner's membership card is not immediately produced, the rosette may be awarded to the Reserve Champion provided they have the required membership card. If the Champion pony has previously qualified it is still entitled to the Silver Medal Rosette but the qualification card goes to the Reserve Champion pony, provided the owner of that pony is a member of the NPS. The Silver Medal Rosette and the qualification card can be awarded no lower than first Reserve (third). Foals are not eligible for Silver Medal Championships.

# South Western Association of The Welsh Pony and Cob Society GENERAL DATA PROTECTION REGULATIONS

SWA holds personal data i.e. members' names, addresses, telephone numbers and email addresses in respect of membership and show entries. If you are entering a show you will need to give your consent to us holding this information when we forward or publish the show results. If appropriate details of the name of the owner/exhibitor/rider and animal's details will be given to the WPCS and any other Showing Society for this purpose and your consent is therefore needed for us to do this. Your consent will be taken as given unless you inform the Show Secretary otherwise.

### **RULES**

- 1. The Organisers and Show's officers, servants or agents shall not be in any way responsible or accountable for any loss, injury or damage from any cause or circumstances whatever to exhibitors or their servants or agents or other members of the public, to any animal or property or any vehicle or otherwise brought onto the showground, or on premises used in conjunction with the show or while entering or leaving the same or otherwise for anything else in conjunction with, or arising out of, or attributable to the Show.
- 2. The decision of the Judge is final and the Organisers reserve the right to amend the Judge's panel and order of classes if it should become necessary.
- 3. The Committee reserves the right to cancel/amalgamate any class with less than 3 entries.
- 4. The Committee reserves the right to retain all or part of the entry fees in the event of the show being cancelled.
- 5. Any protest shall be lodged in writing with the Show Secretary within half an hour of the incident together with a deposit of £10. If the protest is not upheld, the deposit will be forfeited to the funds of the show.
- 6. With the exception of the Part-Bred classes, all entries must be entered in the main section of the stud book for their respective breeds. Part Bred ponies must be registered in the Welsh Part-Bred register. Entries in the WPCS Section X of the Stud Book and Foundation Stock cannot compete but FS.1 and FS.2 may. *All stud book registration numbers must be given on all entry forms.*
- 7. Correctly secured current British Standard skull caps/riding hats must be worn at all times when mounted. Spurs are not permitted and no cane to be more than 30 inches.
- 8. NO MANES OR TAILS TO BE PLAITED IN ANY M&M CLASS, OPTIONAL FOR PART-BREDS.
- 9. No nominations or substitutions will be made.
- 10. Ponies must be the bona fide property of the exhibitor or officially leased.
- No change of handler may be made once a class has commenced without the permission of the judge
- 12. Stallions must be licensed in accordance with breed regulations.
- 13. The Committee strongly recommend that competitors have adequate third party insurance.
- 14. Competitors entering classes which may clash do so at their own risk, no entry fees will be refunded. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to ensure they are ready to enter the ring at the appropriate time.
- 15. All dogs must be kept on a lead.
- 16. Exhibitors must not enter an animal when that animal will be judged by a person who has or has had a financial interest in the animal, stud fee excluded, (the exhibitor being the owner, lessee or person producing and/or showing the animal). Judges may not adjudicate a pony which, to the judge's knowledge, is a pony bred, sold, leased or produced by the judge or his immediate family or employer.
- 17. Exhibitors are requested not to bring any coughing pony to the show and may be requested to remove any such animal.
- All cups and trophies remain the property of the South Western Association of the Welsh Pony & Cob Society and must be returned to the show secretary. All cups and trophies are the responsibility of the winner whilst in their possession. They may only be signed for by an adult. Any person who has had an SWA cup or trophy in the past and has not returned it by the time of the next show may not be allowed to take away a cup or trophy they have been awarded.
- 19. Refund of entry fee only on receipt of a veterinary certificate.
- 20. In accordance with WPCS showing rules animals 3 years old and under including foals must not be body clipped for showing purposes. Long hair under the jawline and those protruding from the ears may be trimmed off leaving as natural a line as possible. The whiskers around the muzzle must not be trimmed. If mane and tail are very thick, they can be discreetly thinned, the tail should look natural and should not be levelled off (banged).
- 21. FOR HEALTH AND SAFETY REASONS ALL HORSES AND PONIES MUST BE HELD AT ALL TIMES BY THE LEAD ROPE OR REINS
