Classes SJ12 & SJ13 have been kindly sponsored by Hannah Stephens Equestrian

Class SJ12 TOP SCORE: Jump as many fences as you can within a time limit of 70 seconds.

Each fence will have a score ranging from 5 points to 25 points. You can jump the same jump as many times as you like until you knock a pole down, then you have to move onto another jump.

There are no points if you knock a jump down. Highest score wins.

Rosettes to sixth place and Trophy for the winner

Class SJ13 ACCUMULATOR: Jump the course as laid out.

Competitors to jump the course laid out, each jump will be worth

a higher score. The last jump called 'The Joker' will have an easy option and a more

difficult option with higher points. Highest score wins with the fastest time.
