

DIRECTIONS FROM THE EAST OR NORTH

From the M5 Junction 31 follow signs onto the A30 West, clearly signed to Okehampton/Bodmin. Continue along the dual carriageway to the exit sign-posted Okehampton (B3260), then exit the A30. At the end of the slip-road (with the BP garage on your left), turn right and drive down the hill into Okehampton. In the middle of the town you will come to traffic lights opposite the White Hart pub (on the far left). Go straight on at these lights and after one mile, at the top of the hill, turn right (sign-posted Northlew). Continue along this road for half a mile and take the right turn sign-posted Northlew. Continue on this road for 0.3 miles, then go straight on at the Hilltown Cross crossroads. The Grange EC is 1.5 miles further along this road, on the left.

DIRECTIONS FROM THE WEST OR SOUTH

Exit the A30 at Sourton Cross (A386 sign-posted Tavistock/ Bideford) following signs to Bideford. Go past the Shell filling station and the Little Chef restaurant on your left, and follow the road for 2.1 miles until you come to a mini-roundabout (Fowley Cross). Turn right, following signs to Bideford. After 0.4 miles turn left at the mini-roundabout (sign-posted to Northlew). After a further 0.2 miles take the second left, sign-posted to Northlew. The Grange EC is 1.5 miles along this road, on the left.

Whilst we have tried to work out a suitable timetable, the Committee of Area 10 cannot be held responsible for any clashing of classes. We will try to accommodate within reason, but the responsibility of getting to classes on time is down to the exhibitor.

This show is affiliated to the National Pony Society and the NPS affiliated classes will be run under NPS rules.

National Pony Society Qualifying Rounds:

NPS Winter Championship Qualifying Rounds

This show is affiliated to the National Pony Society and the NPS affiliated classes will be run under NPS rules. Classes are open to Members and Non-Members of the NPS, but Non-Members will need to become members to enter the finals at the NPS Spring Festival, 26th April 2025. The NPS General Rules for Showing apply (see NPS website for details). In each class the three highest placed ponies, not already qualified, within the first six places, will qualify. Winnings in the 2024/2025 Novice and Pure Novice Winter Championships will not debar ponies from the NPS 2025 Mountain and Moorland Novice Ridden competitions. Qualification cards will be awarded in the ring.

NPS Summer Championship Qualifying Rounds

These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. Ponies must be registered in any of the British Riding Pony studbook sections or the Ridden Register; the GSB; the AHSB; the AASB, or registered in the main body of their respective M&M Stud Book. Part bred are not eligible unless over stamped into one of the British Riding Pony studbook sections or the Ridden Register. Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and nonmembers but only ponies owned by adult NPS Qualifying or Life members are eligible to qualify for the final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show at Malvern from 5th – 7th August 2025. The highest placed pony, if owned by an NPS member, in each class will qualify for the final. Qualification may pass down to third place if the first and second ponies are already qualified. NPS/WTJ Insurance Brokers Ltd Home Produced Ridden Championship - Riders of Home Produced ponies (see definition in the NPS Rules Book) can wear a white arm band in classes where this is indicated. These ponies, if owned by NPS members, are then eligible to qualify for the final at the NPS Summer Championship Show. The Owner's Membership cards MUST be produced in the ring when requested or the qualification will be forfeit.

NPS Silver Medal Rosette Championships

These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. NPS Silver Medal Rosettes are only awarded when the owner of the champion pony is a Qualifying or Life member of the NPS.

A valid membership card must be in the rider's/handler's possession on entering the ring and be produced immediately on request by either the judge or the steward. If the owner of the Champion pony is not a member, or the owner's membership card is not immediately produced, the rosette may be awarded to the Reserve Champion provided they have the required membership card.

If the Champion pony has previously qualified it is still entitled to the Silver Medal Rosette, but the qualification card goes to the Reserve Champion pony, provided the owner of that pony is a member of the NPS. The Silver Medal Rosette and the qualification card can be awarded no lower than first Reserve (third). Foals are not eligible for Silver Medal Championships

Qualifiers are entitled to compete in the final of the Silver Medal Rosette Championship to be held at the NPS Summer Championship Show **5th – 7th August 2025**.

This show is a qualifier for the South West Pony Association Championships
to be held on 28 - 30 August 2025
at The David Broome Event Centre, Crick, Monmouthshire. NP26 5XP

To qualify for the 2025 Championships:

Enter one of the qualifying classes at this show.

If you are placed first or second in the class, you should be given a qualifying card.

- 1) Fill in the information required on the front of the card.
- 2) Register with Showing Scene if not already registered. *This is Free*
- 3) Join SWPA via www.showingscene.com as a **2025** Member
- 4) Take a picture of the card and upload to the relevant Championship Class
(Championship Classes are 1 – 134 on Saturday of the Championships)

Please Note:

Membership Fee for the 2025 Championships is £25 which includes two adults and all children at the same address and all equines owned or leased by the family.

ALL STALLIONS 4 YEARS AND OVER MUST BE GRADED LICENSED AND REGISTERED WITH BSPA IN ORDER TO COMPETE. BSPA BRIDLE DISCS TO BE WORN. TO IN ORDER TO QUALIFY ALL OWNERS/HANDLERS/RIDERS MUST BE MEMBERS OF THE BSPA AND ALL HORSES/PONIES REGISTERED WITH BSPA PRIOR TO THE SHOW. BSPA QUALIFICATION CARDS MUST BE PRODUCED IN THE RING AND BE SIGNED BY THE JUDGE, OTHERWISE QUALIFICATION IS INVALID.

SUPREME IN HAND SEMI FINAL SUPREME IN-HAND HORSE OR PONY OF THE YEAR SEMI FINAL

The Supreme Inhand Championship is a qualifier for the Supreme In-Hand Semi Final at the National Pony Society Great British In-Hand Show, 14th September 2025 at Vale View Equestrian Centre, which is a qualifier for Horse of the Year Show, NEC, 8th – 12th October 2025.

The objective of the competition is to find the supreme light horse or pony in-hand champion of the year, irrespective of breed or type (excluding heavy horses).

The Champion horse or pony from the following classes will be eligible to compete in the Supreme InHand Semi Final, provided it has not already won a Supreme In-Hand qualifier in 2025.

Champion of each M&M Breed (Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, Dales, Fell, Highland, Welsh A, Welsh B, New Forest, Connemara, Welsh C, Welsh D), Hack & Riding Horse Champion, Hunter Pony Champion, Hunter Breeding Champion, Sports Horse Champion, Coloured Inhand Champion, Show Pony Champion, Show Pony/Hunter Pony Home Produced Champion, M&M Home Produced Champion & Part Bred Inhand Champion.

If the Champion has already qualified for Horse of the Year Show 2025 or is ineligible, then the Reserve Champion may come forward to The NPS Great British In-Hand Show, provided it has not already qualified and is eligible.

If both Champion and Reserve Champion have already qualified for Horse of the Year Show 2025 or are ineligible then the Semi-Final will not be represented at the NPS Great British In-Hand Show.

Foal champions and geldings four years old and over are not eligible to compete or eligible to qualify for Horse of the Year Show.

In the event of a horse/pony having been awarded more than one section Championship at this show, that horse/pony will represent both/all sections and the Semi-Final qualification will not pass down to the Reserve Champion in the 2nd and any subsequent sections.

All classes are open to Yearlings, 2 year olds, 3 year olds, Stallions, broodmares and barren mares only. Broodmares must be with foal at foot or a relevant certificate of pregnancy. Mares which have not yet foaled or that have lost their foals are eligible to enter with a relevant certificate of pregnancy for the following year.

There will be no direct entry into the Supreme In-Hand Championship Semi Final, all animals must be a section champion or reserve champion (as applicable).

Where the Champion is not eligible, the Reserve can come forward (if eligible).

NPS /AREA 15 British Isles Area In Hand Championship

M&M Champion to qualify for: The NPS/ASSENDONS Area Final Freestyle to Music

The owner does not have to be an NPS member for the pony to enter this competition or to qualify but the owner must be a Qualifying or Life member of the NPS to enter the final. If the Champion and/or Reserve Champion have already qualified then the qualification may go to the third place, but no lower.

RULES AND CONDITIONS

1. The organisers and each of the show's officers, servants or agents shall not be in any way responsible or accountable for any loss, injury or damage that may happen (from any cause or circumstances whatsoever) to exhibitors or their servants or agents or other members of the public, to any animal or property, or to any vehicle brought onto the showground, or on premises used in conjunction with the show, or while entering or leaving, or for anything else in conjunction with, or arising out of, or attributable to the show.
2. In all classes the judge's decision is final.
3. This show is run under the showing and competition rules of the National Pony Society (NPS). A copy of the NPS Rule Book is available online or hard copies can be requested from the NPS Office.
4. Qualifying rounds are open to both NPS Members and Non Members BUT ONLY the highest placed NPS Qualifying or Life Members on production of their NPS Membership Card will be eligible to qualify for the Final. Qualification to go no lower than third place.
5. Any person wishing to lodge a protest having reference to any persons or exhibit, shall do so in writing within 30 minutes of the completion of the class and at the same time shall deposit a sum of £50. If the investigation by the committee shows the protest is not sustained, the deposit shall be forfeited to the funds of the show. The committee's decision will be final.
6. All Mountain and Moorland ponies must be registered with their respective breed society and be shown in accordance with their individual society rules.
7. The organisers reserve the right to amend the judges' panel and order of classes if it should become necessary.
8. The committee cannot be held responsible for the clashing of classes – competitors should bear this in mind when making their entries. **No entry fees will be refunded.**
9. The committee reserves the right to amalgamate classes if deemed necessary.
10. The committee reserves the right to refuse entries without giving a reason.
11. The committee reserves the right to retain all or part of the entry fees in the event of the show being cancelled.
12. Stallions and colts. In hand classes: handlers must have attained their 14th birthday before the 1st of January in the current year. Ridden small breeds classes: riders must have attained their 11th birthday before the 1st of January in the current year. Ridden large breed classes: riders must have attained their 14th birthday before the 1st of January in the current year. NPS Stallion Discs **must** be displayed on all ridden stallions. In Hand colts and stallions are advised to display a stallion bridle marker.. Stallion Discs are available from the NPS Office
13. No pony under the age of 4 may compete in any ridden class.
14. Spurs are not allowed in any ridden class
15. Anyone found mistreating a horse or pony may be asked to leave the showground and be reported to the appropriate body.
16. All attendants in the ring must present themselves correctly attired and must **wear a hat**. Failure to do this may result in being asked to leave the ring.
17. All dogs must be kept on a lead.
18. Pre Entries are non refundable
