Please Note: Exhibitors of Maedia Visna accredited sheep must hand to the show officials the Green SAC valid Certificate of Status when unloading. If not, the sheep will be accommodated in the Non-Attested Section and no claim may be made against the Association for Re-Testing.

A fully completed movement licence must be handed to the show officials.

All adult sheep to be shorn, and will be subject to dipping regulations if applicable.

INFECTION: If there is any doubt over Sheep Scab - Please may we ask you do not bring your sheep to the show.

Breed Society Rules to be adhered to.

THE SHOW RESERVE THE RIGHT TO AMALGAMATE OR REMOVE CLASSES IF FEWER THAN 3 EXHIBITORS, AND TO ADJUST JUDGING TIMES to ensure the smooth running of the Show.

IMPORTANT: Please note that various breeds of sheep will be judged simultaneously.

Therefore exhibitors with entries in more than one specific breed must ensure that they have sufficient handlers to exhibit in all breeds at any one time.

Junior Handler classes will be judged first. All other judging will take place after this. Specific timings are dependent on the number of entries received. Thank you for your understanding.

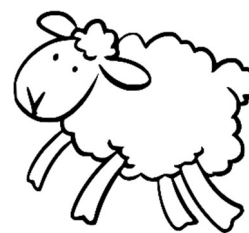

Featuring sheep, beef and dairy categories - nurturing the next generation of young farmers. We are also excited to announce that we will be continuing once again with two sheep classes U8 and U12's. Children placed first, second or third at participating shows in the Young Handlers Series will be allotted points throughout the season, which culminates at the Holsworthy and Stratton Show on Thursday 28<sup>th</sup> August. Please see below the qualifying shows for this show season where we also welcome back Camelford and Mid Devon to the series: Liskeard/Launceston/Woolsery/North Devon/Okehampton/Ashwater/Mid Devon/Camelford/Holsworthy and Stratton
