This show is one of six Shows (Camborne, Launceston, Liskeard, Stithians, Camelford and Praze) at which points will be offered towards prizes of 1st £125 and 2nd £65 in both the open cattle and sheep classes for the exhibitors gaining the most points over the 2025 Cornish Summer Show Season. Points will be awarded as follows: **1st prize** - 3 points, **2nd prize** - 2 points, **3rd prize** - 1 point. Exhibits must be entered under the same names at the relevant shows to be eligible.
