RING 1 – IN HAND SHOWING

Commencing at 9.30am Judge: Miss Emma Morrell

CLASS 1 BEST TURNED OUT RIDDEN AND/OR IN HAND

Turnout of both horse/pony/rider/handler will be taken into consideration.

CLASS 2 IN HAND BEST CONDITION

Open to horses and ponies of all heights and ages. May be shown plaited or unplaited

CLASS 3 IN HAND MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND

Open to all horses and ponies native to the UK, both registered and unregistered

CLASS 4 IN HAND SHOW PONY

Open to all ponies up to 14.2hh

CLASS 5 IN HAND COLOURED & ODD COLOURED

Open to skewbald, piebald, palominos, duns, appaloosas, roans, spots, paints, creams. All heights. Class will be split if entries are sufficient.

Will not start before 12:30 Judge to be confirmed

CLASS 6 IN HAND HORSE

Open to all horses over 14.2hh

CLASS 7 IN HAND HUNTER – Sponsored by Chris & Lois

Open to all horses of hunter type over 14.2hh

CLASS 8 IN HAND COB

Open to all types of cob. Maybe shown hogged, plaited or un-plaited.

- CLASS 11 LEAD REIN PONY – Kindly sponsored by GP Designs**
For ponies not exceeding 122cm (12hh). Open to mares and geldings, 4 years and over. Children must be 3 years or older but not to have reached their 9th birthday on 1st January 2021. Snaffle bit and lead reins on noseband only.
- CLASS 12 MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND**
Open to all native UK ponies, both registered and unregistered. Will be expected to walk away from the judge, trot back and continue with a simple individual show of not more than two minutes.
- CLASS 13 UNDER 14.2hh**
Open to all ponies under 14.2hh. Will be expected to walk away from the judge, trot back and continue with a simple individual show of not more than two minutes.
- CLASS 14 OVER 14.2hh**
Open to all horses over 14.2hh. After the 'go round', Will be expected to walk away from the judge, trot back and continue with a simple individual show of not more than two minutes.
- CLASS 15 RIDDEN COB – Kindly sponsored by Annette Hance**
For horses over 148cm. Cobs may be shown hogged or hairy. Open to mares and geldings 4 years and over. After the 'go round', Will be expected to walk away from the judge, trot back and continue with a simple individual show of not more than two minutes.

- CLASS 16 RIDDEN COLOURED & ODD COLOURED**

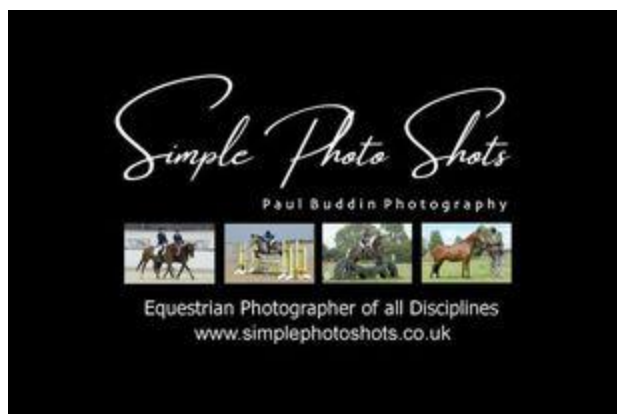
CLASS 21 CONCOURS D'ELEGANCE

Competitors, Parents and Guardians must abide by the Rules & Conditions of Entry

1. In all cases the Judge's decision is final. Entry is taken as acceptance of these rules
2. Save for death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers at this event, Marlake Equestrian Events, nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord, accepts any liability for accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, vehicles, their contents and accessories or any other personal property whatsoever, whether caused by negligence, breach of contract, or in any other way whatsoever. Entries are only accepted on this basis.
3. Correct dress and safety attire must be worn in the arenas and on the Showground.
4. Age is at the date of the Show.

6. No horses or ponies under the age of four years to enter the showground. No stallions allowed.
7. All competing horses must have had a flu vaccination not more than 6 months and not less than 7 days from the competition date. Random passports checks in operation.
8. For lead rein classes, lead rein to be attached to the noseband and pony led for the entirety of the class.
9. Entry fees will only be refunded on production of a medical/veterinary certificate.
10. The organisers reserve the right to cancel, amend or add to any of the classes as they see fit. The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry and no reason need be given.
11. There must be no galloping on the Showground, outside of the rings.
12. Health, Safety and Welfare. The organisers have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. Everyone must take all reasonable care to avoid and prevent accidents, and obey instructions given by the organisers, officials and stewards.
13. **Dogs must be kept on a lead and in close proximity of your vehicle**
14. The Show Committee has a **zero** tolerance policy towards any competitors, or their associates being abusive in anyway whatsoever to any other competitor, official or steward. Equally, no abuse towards any horse will be permitted, including excessive use of whips or spurs. Appropriate action as necessary will be taken by the Committee in these circumstances and you may be asked to leave the show ring.
