Judging to commence at 10.00am. Please try to be on the field by 9.30am.

All exhibits must be complete and in working order.

Appropriate Insurance Cover to be held by all exhibitors.

All tractor / motorbike drivers should hold an appropriate full UK licence

No additional passengers to be carried on exhibits during the parade.

Stationary engines are required to run in order to be eligible for judging.

Tractors & Motorbikes will parade in the main show ring at approximately 2.30pm.

Entry fee - £3 per exhibit. Prize Money – 1st £15, 2nd £10, 3rd £5

Class 2 – Stationary Engine 1932 onwards

Class 3 – Restored Veteran Tractor pre-1952

Class 6 – Unrestored Tractor up to 1978

Class 7 – Machinery driven by tractor

Class 8 – Horse-drawn or Hand-operated Domestic, Garden or Agricultural Equipment

Class 9 – Motorcycle pre-1940

Class 10 – Motorcycle 1940 up to 1980
