Booking your Sort-Out plot

Our booking system allows you to upload documents such as Public Liability Insurance certificates and risk assessments, so please have these ready before you start your booking. Ideally, you will already have risk assessments covering your attendance at the show; however, we can provide a template if you do not have one.

Showing Scene.com – our online booking system

Showing Scene is our online booking provider. They support many other shows and events, so if you already have an account with them, you can use the same login details to book your stand with us.

Submit Your Booking – *If you booked online in 2025, you will have an account!*

Once your booking has been submitted, it will be reviewed by the Show Team. Bookings will be declined or confirmed by email within 7 working days through Showing Scene, so please look out for these messages in your inbox.

Invoices and Payment

The email confirming your booking will include your invoice and a link to pay for your stand by card. Payments can also be made by BACS. Payment is due immediately.

Application for space

A completed online application form and full payment are required. The following rates are available for online bookings made between 17th August and 1st November 2026 only.

Complimentary admission wristbands

You will receive 2 admission wristbands per vehicle applied for. These can be collected on Sunday 8th November at check-in at the Show Cabin. **Please use the priority lane.** Wristbands must be worn for the duration of your time at the show and will be checked by security on entry to the showground.

Sunday Sort-Out – Declaration Form

To join the Sunday Sort-Out 2026, you must agree to and comply with the following terms.

Terms and Conditions

- 1. Goods offered for sale MUST be your own property and must be used, old unused items, or items made by you.**
- 2. The following items CANNOT BE SOLD: food, drink, new items, or electrical items.**
- 3. Risks to visitors and exhibitors must be kept to a minimum, and steps must be taken to avoid risk.**
Please consider the placement of heavy objects, any chemical hazards from products on sale, including asbestos such as brake linings and friction materials, and the risk of snagging on protruding objects.

4. To reduce overall risk, THE FOLLOWING ITEMS AND ACTIVITIES ARE PROHIBITED:

- The use of disposable barbeques or gas appliances.
- Any form of welding.
- Any use of petrol or tools with sharp edges.
- Display, or setting off, of any type of flare or firework.
- Starting or moving vehicles, or running engines, at the Sort-Out between 9.00 a.m. and 2.30 p.m.

5. Unsold items and rubbish

All unsold items and rubbish must be removed from site by 4.00 p.m. on Sunday 8 November 2026. Failure to do so may result in charges and refusal of future entries.

6. Refunds

Refund requests must be made in writing by email or letter and will only be considered if received by 26 October 2026. A non-refundable £20.00 administration fee will be retained.

7. Start time / close

You may arrive and wait in the priority lane from 7.30 a.m. in readiness for the Sort-Out, which will start at 9.00 a.m. There will be no traffic movement or vehicle entry onto the site from 8.30 a.m. All exhibitors must remain on site until 2.30 p.m., or at the discretion of the Health & Safety Manager. All exhibitors must have left the Sort-Out by 4.00 p.m. on Sunday 8 November 2026.

8. Disputes

In the event of any dispute, the decision of NNAS will be final.

9. Responsibility

The person booking into the Sort-Out is entirely responsible for any loss, claim, or offence arising from their presence at the Sort-Out or any neighbouring event. It is recommended that you take out public liability cover. Your vehicle and display MUST be supervised and safe for anyone likely to come into contact with them, including children. You must comply with the directions of stewards on site.

Well-behaved dogs on short leads are welcome at the show. Dogs that show any signs of aggression or are considered to be in distress will be asked to leave the showground. Dogs must not be left unattended in vehicles; NNAS may use force or break windows to release them if necessary.

Sellers who fail to comply will be asked to leave the Sort-Out immediately and may be refused future entry to the show.

Thank you for pre-booking your place in the Sunday Sort-Out. This helps the show organisers allocate space fairly and provides you with priority access on the day.
