The 2022 Kenilworth Show will be held on Saturday 4th June 2022. We are inviting applications from owners of vintage and classic vehicles to exhibit them at the show. If, however, you have a vehicle of exceptional interest then it may also be considered, at our discretion. This might be a high-end sports car, an unusual vehicle or something simply lovely to look at.

Applicants will be issued with a vehicle pass which will permit entry for the exhibitor and their vehicle on the day. Anyone else wishing to attend the show will be required to purchase their own individual entry ticket.

This section of our show is very popular and applications will be considered on a first entered basis. We would be very grateful if you would apply as early as possible and we look forward to welcoming you to the show.

All vehicles must be on site ready for the show to open at 08:30. Unfortunately late arrivals will not be permitted onto the showground. All vehicles must not be moved from their allotted position, until authorised by the show organiser and not before 15 minutes after the conclusion of events in the main ring (approximately around 17:30). This is a requirement by the HSE and the insurance Guidelines companies.

KENILWORTH SHOW 2022 - REGULATIONS & GUIDELINES FOR VINTAGE & CLASSIC VEHICLE SECTION

All Owners shall be considered as having read and understood the following regulations.

Insurance: Details of the current Insurance Policy must be forwarded to the Show with your application

Security: Owners are reminded that only a limited security presence will be on the showground for the duration of the event, including some set up and breakdown time. Kenilworth Show cannot accept any responsibility for the loss or damage to vehicles, goods or equipment.

Theft: The Show reserves the right to appoint a Show Official or Security Guard with powers to stop and search vehicles leaving the Showground and/or to assist the Police.

First Aid: First Aid, including ambulances will be available from 7 a.m. until 6.30 p.m. on the day of the Show. Out of these hours contact should be made with the Show Organiser at the Show Office to co-ordinate medical cover. The First Aid post is located near Red Gate.

Police/Fire Services: Please dial 999 or 112 and state your exact location on the Showground e.g. Classic Car Area so that you may be easily located. Gridded show maps are at the Show Office and Public Entrance Gates. Lost Property: Unclaimed lost property may be deposited with the Show Organiser's Tent at the end of the day.
