All exhibitors MUST complete the Health and Safety Risk Assessment Form.

Using the guidelines shown below, please consider what risks there are to those building up trade stands and to visitors during the Show. Outline the steps you propose to take to minimise that risk in the table on the Risk Assessment Form.

Both Forms, along with a copy of your Public Liability Insurance Certificate must be uploaded to your stand booking on the Society's stand booking system.
