		Score	Comments
1.	Stay in the shade Ride your pony up to an open parasol		
2.	Go for a paddle Ride your pony through some water (improvise with tarpaulin if required)		
3.	Hook a duck Whilst mounted - hook an object (duck or otherwise!)		
4.	Picnic blanket Halt on a 'blanket' (tarp or other material fine) for 10 seconds		
5.	Beach ready Dismount - Rider to dress in beach attire - armbands, floppy hat, sunglasses. Pony to stand still whilst doing so. Remount (rider discretion to which accessories you keep on - stay safe)		
6.	Promenade Walk away and trot back in a straight line		
7.	Cool off Dismount, take off the saddle and wash off the pony's saddle area (suggest to do this last)		
8.	Freestyle! Create your own obstacle! There will be a special rosette for the most creative.
