		Score	Comments
1.	Stay in the shade Pick up a parasol and open it		
2.	Go for a paddle Lead your pony through some water (improvise with tarpaulin if required)		
3.	Hook a duck Hook an object (duck or otherwise!)		
4.	Picnic blanket Pony to stand still on a 'blanket' (tarp or other material fine) for 10 seconds, handler to step back off the blanket		
5.	Beach ready Handler to dress in beach attire - armbands, floppy hat, sunglasses. Pony to stand still whilst doing so.		
6.	Promenade Walk away and trot back in a straight line, turning your pony away from you as you turn, return to walk and halt		
7.	Cool off Give your pony a quick cool off with a bucket and sponge - points for how still and relaxed the pony is.		
8.	Freestyle! Create your own obstacle! There will be a special rosette for the most creative.
