CELEBRATING A CENTURY



BANNER ADVERTISING

Banner advertising is available in all of our entertainment rings across the Show including the Astor Ring, Countryside Ring, Heritage Ring, Woodland Ring and Livestock Rings (cattle, sheep and goat).

SPONSOR A COMPETITION

The livestock and equine competitions are a cardinal aspect of the Kent County Show. Across the three days we host over 500 classes, from cattle, sheep and goats to inhand showing, ridden, driving and showjumping. There are also competitions in floral art, bees, honey and pale making. Without sponsorship of these classes we wouldn't be able to offer prize money and trophies to the winners.

You can support a class, or classes, of your choice or an entire section. There is also the opportunity for the sponsor to be mentioned in the commentary while the class is taking place, and sponsors are encouraged to hand out winner rosettes and trophies, taking full advantage of the official photo opportunities.



SPONSOR A SHOW AREA

2023 is a big year of entertainment! Sponsor one of our interactive and educational Show Areas to benefit from the huge public engagement in these sections.

LIVING LAND ZONE

The new food and farming area, which offers a taster of our educational event, Living Land, was a huge success in 2022.

With a buzzing atmosphere, the marquee, supported by the Educational Department of the National Fruit Show and LEAF Education, was dedicated to educating the public both young and old about where their food comes from, and how everyday food products are made. This year, we plan on continuing to develop this area by increasing the the amount of interactive activities and covering additional food items.

MEMBERS' LOUNGE AND LAWN

Open to our 700 members, 200 stewards, plus 100's of judges and sponsors, the exclusive Members' Area and Lawn offers our VIP guests the opportunity to sit and relax, with private viewing of all the exciting events taking place each day in the Astor Ring. Members can also access the Members' Restaurant throughout the day for a hot or cold meal and refreshments.



FLORAL ART ZONE

The Floral Art Zone is the place you can find a flare of colour and horticultural talent as the exhibitors spend hours designing and then carefully curating and pruning their fabulous floral creations. Once the judging has taken place, visitors are treated to a refuge away from the hustle and bustle of the Show, filled with delightful floral sites and smells.

WOOL TENT

Have a go at sheep shearing in the 'Story of Wool' marquee and then watch the process of the wool being spun into fabric or rope. Also experience some of the bio products from the sheep while the sheep competitions happen just outside.



STOCKMANS' TENT

Situated in the heart of the Showground, refreshments and breakfast will be available to all those staying on the Showground and committing their time to show animals, cars, or trade with us. In the evening the tent will provide entertainment to those camping on site. There is opportunity within the Stockmans' Tent for branding, a pop up display, and the opportunity to hand out merchandise to the visitors.

GRANDE PARADE

The Grade Parade of Livestock takes place each day of the Show. On Friday and Sunday it takes place in the Livestock Section, which is central to the whole Show. On Saturday, the animals travel across the site to the Astor Ring to show for the prize and trophy giving. Sponsors will get the opportunity to have branded breed boards that are carried throughout the parade by our stewards.



BANDSTAND

The Bandstand is situated in the heart of the Show, the Village Green. Surrounded by catering outlets, the bandstand is a hive of activity, with people taking refuge from the hustle and bustle to enjoy good food and entertainment. By sponsoring the Bandstand, your business will benefit from branded banners around the area, plus personalised commentary between live performances.



SPONSOR A DISPLAY

We are also one of the only shows in the country to hold the International Trial Showjumping class, attracting top level horses and riders to compete.
