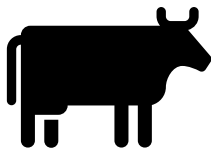

RULES OF COMPETITION

1. The Competition is Open to Members of Clubs affiliated to the Scottish Association of Young Farmers' Clubs. National Federation of Y.F.C. and Y.F.C. of Ulster, who are under Thirty years of age on **Friday 13th June 2025**.
2. Each Club may enter Two Teams of 3, but a Third Team may enter provided it is an All-Ladies' Team. One Associate member is allowed per team.
3. Each Team is allowed One Reserve who will compete only if one Member of the Team is unable to do so.
4. Competitors are forbidden to communicate with each other or with any other person until the conclusion of the Competition under penalty of disqualification of the Whole Team.
5. Competitors will judge all Pens in succession, and all Pens will operate concurrently.
6. Competitors may be required to give reasons for the placing of one Class of Stock – or more than One Class in the event of a tie. Individual winners will be required to give reasons for their placing in one or more Classes if called upon to do so.
7. The decision of the Judges shall be final.
8. All orders of the Committee must be obeyed, and the Committee reserve the right to alter any of the Rules which special circumstances may call for.
9. Each Competitor shall judge the following Classes (Four items in each class). Six minutes will be allowed in each class.
4 Classes Cattle
2 Classes Sheep
10. Official placings will be made by Judges who have been appointed for this Competition.
11. **COMPETITIONS WILL COMMENCE AT 6.30pm for 7.00pm START.**
12. Trophies won at the competition will be presented to winning exhibitors at the Annual Dinner and Presentation of Prizes due to be held on Friday 30th October 2026
IF YOU WERE PRESENTED WITH A TROPHY LAST YEAR, PLEASE RETURN IT TO THE SECRETARY AT THE EVENING OF THE STOCKJUDGING
14. **PRIZE MONEY WILL BE PAID BY BACS** no later than 1st October 2026. Please ensure that you provide bank details to the team at entries@turriffshow.org if you are placed. In the event of bank details not being provided to the Association by 1st November 2025 prize money will be retained as a donation.
