Fruit Tea Loaf

300g Mixture Dried Fruit and	225ml Hot Tea
Cherries	
Approx 75ml Grated Rind and Juice	50g Soft Butter
of One Orange	
100g Soft Light Brown Sugar (or	1 Egg
light muscovado)	
225g Self Raising Flower	4 tbsp Demerara Sugar

Soak the fruit – Place dried fruits in a bowl and pour over the hot tea, orange rind and juice. Cover with clingfilm then leave for at least 4 hours or overnight. Preheat oven to 180C (160C Fan)/ Gas mark 4. Grease and line the base of a 2lb loaf tin. Beat together the butter and sugar until creamy then beat in the egg and flour. Carefully stir through the fruit mixture. Spoon the mixture into the tin then smooth the surface with the back of a spoon. Sprinkle all over a thick layer of demerara sugar. Bake for 1 hour or until a skewer inserted into the centre comes out clean. Leave to cool in the tin, then turn out.

Regulations

- 1. The competition is OPEN to all individuals
- 2. Every Exhibit must be the work of the Exhibitor and MUST NOT HAVE BEEN EXHIBITED at a previous Border Union Show. All Knitting must be hand done.
- 3. One entry only allowed in each class per exhibitor.
- 4. Entry Fee of 50p for each exhibit is payable at the time of entry.
- 5. Labels will be issued to attach to exhibits. Please ensure that **labels are securely tied or fixed on to Exhibits**.
- 6. Exhibits will be received at the Bake and Create Section (Thorburn Building behind main hall) Between 9am and 10am on Friday 25th July (The green gate will be closed to all traffic from 10am)
- 7. Judging will commence at 10.30am on Friday
- 8. The hall will be open to the public on Friday afternoon Approx. 1.30pm to 5.30pm, and on Saturday from 9am till 4.30pm. The exhibits will be kept in safety overnight. **Trophies wil be presented at 4.30pm on Saturday, exhibits can be removed immediately afterwards. No entry for cars before 5.30pm. All Exhibits unclaimed by 6.00pm will be disposed of to charities.**
- 9. The following prizes will be awarded in each class—1st, 2nd, 3rd. Highly Commended will be awarded in classes with 12 or more entries. Children's classes at judges discretion.
- 10. Judges decision is final.
- 11. In the case of a tie for the Cup Winner in any section, the cup will be awarded to the competitor with the highest awards.
- 12. Exhibitors who have 12 or more entries will receive a free pass to the showground on Saturday 27th July
- 13. Entries (with entry fee) to be in the hands of Ms Sarah Plummer, 2 Carham Cottage, Cornhill on Tweed TD12 4RW No Later than Friday 18th July.
- 14. Entry money may be paid by BACS online to BUAS Bank of Scotland Account Sort code 80-16-57 Account No 00115245. Please use surname as reference.
- 15. Prize winners will receive their prize money at the entrance to the hall on Saturday. All entries in the Junior Section must be the Child's own work.

The Industrial Cup will be awarded to the competitor with the highest aggregate of points over the whole section. (+£5 and £3 runner up)

The Jean Wilson Trophy to be awarded to the best entry in the Baking Classes (1-16)

Margaret Forest Rose Bowl will be awarded to the competitor with the highest aggregate of points in the Floral Art Section (+£3) Shaw Salver will be awarded to the runner up in the Floral Art Section (+£2)

The Mary Rogerson Trophy will be awarded to the best arrangement in the Floral Art Section (+£3)
