
- 12. Equines when not competing must be kept to the stable or collecting enclosures. They must be kept under control at all times.
- 13. Competitors who enter more than one class which may clash do so entirely at their own risk. Classes will not be held up and no entries will be refunded.
- 14. Manes and tails may be plaited, pulled or left natural. Animals under 12 months may not be clipped out but show trimming is allowed. The cosmetic touching up of spots or use of stage makeup on the head is not allowed.
- 15. All ridden Horses/Ponies must be four years old and over. Junior, family and novice ponies must be shown in a snaffle. No spurs allowed in the Ridden classes.
- 16. For the ridden classes, classes open to children 3 years and over. Except the fancy dress classes where there is no age restriction. It is the parent/guardians responsibility for care and safety of the child at all times.
- 17. Three year old mares with foal at foot will not be eligible for Youngstock classes. All foals must be at least 30 days old on the day of the show and be shown at foot until they reach 5 months old. Foals may be shown in a halter, slip or headcollar.
- 18. All stallions and colts four years old and over must be adequately bitted and in possession of a stallion license with their relevant breed society.
- 19. Misuse of drugs: The administration of any substance not a normal nutrient, whether intentionally or unintentionally, which may affect the performance, temperament or soundness of an exhibit is forbidden. Such forbidden substances are listed in Appx.IV, F.E.I Veterinary Regulations.
- 20. Cruelty: Excessive whipping, stimulation by noise, intimidation or infliction of pain by any means, is forbidden in all parts of the showground and stable areas at all times.
- 21. Conduct: All exhibitors must behave in an orderly and professional manner and not show under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
- 22. All persons entering the showground do so at their own risk. The organisers accept no responsibility for any accident, loss or injury however caused to any animal, person or property. Parking of horse boxes and trailers in the designated areas only.
- 23. Amateur Home Produced Rules—Handler/rider must be the owner of the animal entered and not to have been paid for showing or producing any pony for a third party, this includes any remuneration either as employment, casual showing, or any in-kind benefits whatsoever. Animal not to have resided on a professional yard on show or training livery in 2024. And not to have been shown by a professional in 2024. Horse not to have received regular training from a visiting professional in 2024.

Please note that classes may be divided or amalgamated depending on the number of Entries.

Ring One & Two will take place in the Hereford Ring. A warm up area will be allocated. Camping on site. Toilets and Showers.

Stables

Ample stabling available to book which can be done online through the showing scene platform. Alternatively complete the stable booking form and return with your entries. Stables are available from 5.30pm Friday 19th July –End of Show Sunday and can be booked for 1 night £40 or 2 nights £50. Straw is £7 per bale. Stable plan will be at end of stable block.

Trophies

If you have a trophy from a previous year please remember to bring it back or make arrangements to return it in time for this years Breed Show. Many Thanks.

General Show Rules – Please read carefully

- 1. Entries must be on official forms with correct fees (non-refundable) payable to BSpPS by the closing date. No substitution of entries is permitted. No entries on the day except for classes 30 39. Entries by minors (under 18) should be checked and signed by a parent, guardian or trustee.
- Entries must include full pedigree if known. Incorrect pedigree can lead to disqualification, genuine mistakes will result in the animal being moved to the correct class. The
 BSpPS will not be held responsible for any inaccuracy in any pedigree or other particulars in the catalogue, though every care will be taken.
- 3. The BSpPS reserves the right to amalgamate classes should there be insufficient entries, change or replace judges, add or retain prizes or championships at their discretion. If any class is cancelled entry fees would be refunded. The council reserves the right to reject an entry form, or person if it seems appropriate to do so.
- 4. Animals must be within the height guidelines for their class. Where the height is specified in a class, an Official may require such an animal to be measured. Half an inch will be allowed for normal shoes. Height guidelines as NPS for ponies 2 years old and over.
- 5. Age of rider shall be taken as that on the day of show. The age of a Horse/Pony shall be calculated from 1st January in the year of its birth.
- 6. Objections made in writing and with a deposit of £10.00 handed to the secretary within 15 minutes of the finish of the class concerned. If, upon investigation, the protest is found to be frivolous, the sum shall be forfeited to the Society's funds.
- 7. The owner/handler of any equine showing signs of disease or distress will be asked to remove the animal from the showground.
- 8. Judges must not judge Horses/Ponies, which they, or their immediate family have bred, sold, leased, produced or received financial gain from, excluding stud fees.
- 9. The Judge's decision shall be final. Classes should be judged on conformation, correct movement and manners, depending on the class description. Coat, colour and markings should be taken into consideration if two or more Horses/Ponies are equal on their other merits. Is it at the discretion of the judge to withhold the 1st or other prizes should the quality of entries not justify the prize.
- 10. A riding hat and safety harness to current standards, MUST BE WORN by all competitors in ridden classes. WHIPS and CANES must not exceed 30" except for side saddle. Exhibitors and Grooms must be neatly dressed in the show ring.
- 11. All dogs MUST be kept on a lead and under proper control at all times.

Points System Championship - Points will be awarded to Winners from Class 30–39 as follows: 1st - 5 Points 2nd - 4 Points 3rd - 3 Points 4th - 2 Points and 5th - 1 Point. The Exhibitor with the most Points will be awarded Champion followed by Reserve and Second Reserve.

Open to Animals on all BSpPS Registers/Appendix.

Class 30: HANDY PONY/HORSE - Animals may be in hand or ridden. Points awarded per obstacle. *Please note this class will run over the lunch break by one of our volunteers*

Class 31: FANCY DRESS. Animals may be in hand, ridden or driven

Class 32: COLOUR PARADE. Animals will be grouped together according to their markings and judged in their colour groups. 1^{st} and 2^{nd} in each group. In hand, ridden or driven.

Class 33: YOUNG HANDLER - Handlers 16 yrs and under.

Class 34: AMATEUR HOME PRODUCED - In-Hand (Please see Rule No. 23)

Class 35: AMATEUR HOME PRODUCED - Ridden (Please see rule No. 23)

Class 36: PROGENY. Minimum of 2 animals.

Class 37: CONCOURS d'ELEGANCE. *Qualifier for Concours d'Elegance of GB. *Animals may be in hand, ridden or driven.*

Class 38: TRADITIONAL TACK & TURNOUT. Animals may be in hand, ridden or driven.

Class 39: OPEN DRIVING - you will be required o give a short individual show.

*Concours d'Elegance - First, second and third placed horses/ponies not already qualified in eligible classes will qualify for the Champion of Britain Title classes to be held at Onley Equestrian Centre, Rugby, Warwickshire on Saturday 24th & Sunday 25th August 2024. If a horse/pony has already qualified, cards may be handed down to 6th place at judge's discretion. Each qualified horse/pony will receive a qualification card in the ring which will enable the owner to enter the Championship Show, provided the owner and rider/handler are, or become registered with the Concours d'Elegance Society within 21 days of the qualifying show.
