This show is a qualifier for the UK PONIES & HORSES YOUNG RIDERS ROYAL INTERNATIONAL RIDDEN Mountain & Moorland Classes

To be judged according to the rules and regulations of UK Ponies & Horses. Owners must be Adult/Life Members / Riders must be current UK Ponies & Horses Annual Members and the Ponies currently registered with UK Ponies & Horses) before time of entry in order to compete in these classes Open to Mountain and Moorland Ridden Stallion (Intermediate class only), Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over. Registered in their approved Pure Breed Society Stud Books of Connemara, Dartmoor, Dales, Exmoor, Fells, Highland, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh A, B, C or D. The highest placed exhibit in each of the following three classes, not already qualified within the first five will qualify for the UK Ponies & Horses RIHS Young Riders, M&M Ridden Finals at RIHS, Hickstead, in July 2024. Qualification will be verified by UK Ponies & Horses office.

1st, 2nd & 3rd placed combinations in Classes 68 to 70 will qualify for the UK Ponies & Horses Gold Medal Series at the UK Ponies & Horses Spring Classic 2025. Qualification cards are not given out in the ring, however results evan be verified by the office.

This show is affiliated to the British Show Pony Society (B.S.P.S) and all persons entering, competing, showing or otherwise taking part in B.S.P.S classes, whether or not members of the BSPS are subject to the Constitution and Rules of the B.S.P.S, including the disciplinary procedures, and shall be deemed to have consented to the jurisdiction of the BSPS.

This show is a qualifier for the RIHS 2024. The highest placed pony (not already qualified) from the first three ponies will qualify in the following classes: Open Lead Rein & First Ridden, 128cms, 138cms & 148cms Show Pony, Lead Rein of Hunter Type, 122cms, 133cms, 143cms, 153cms, Show Hunter Pony; Intermediate Show Riding, Show Hunter, and Open Heritage Lead Rein, First Ridden, Ridden, Pretty Polly Heritage Lead Rein & First Ridden; Pretty Polly Mixed Height Show Pony; Pretty Polly Intermediate SRT/SH, Mixed Height Show Hunter Pony; Pretty Polly exceeding 133cms but not exceeding 153cms Mixed Height Show Hunter Pony; Heritage Lead Rein & First Ridden; Heritage Ridden Classes Heritage Pretty Polly Mixed Height Ridden; Anglo & Part Bred Arab not exceeding 148cms and exceeding 148cms classes.

The 1st and 2nd prize winners only in the following classes 3, 42, 43, 44 - 46 and 48 - 51will qualify. The 1st, 2nd and 3rd in classes 2, 35 - 37 and $1^{st} - 4^{th}$ in the mixed height WHP will qualify for the BSPS championships show provided the animal is registered in accordance with Rules 21 and 26 in the 2024 BSPS Rule Book and ridden by a BSPS member.

This show is a qualifier for the BSPS "The Roger Truck Services" Challenge Animals must qualify for the Challenge by attending any BSPS affiliated show & competing in the appropriate Class- Lead Rein, First Ridden, Open Show Pony, Lead Rein of Hunter Type, Open Show Hunter Pony, Cradle and Nursery Stakes, Open Working Hunter Pony, and the Open Intermediate SRT, SH, and WH, and the Heritage Open Lead Rein, First Ridden, Ridden and WHP classes will qualify. Please see RULE 516 page 78 of the 2024 BSPS Rule book.

This show is a qualifier for the BSPS "BINKS Family" Champion Of Champions. 1st prize winners in the following classes will qualify-Open Lead, Rein First Ridden, Open Show Pony, Open W.H.P. Open S.H.P. Open L.R.H.T. Open Intermediate S.H.,S.R.T.& W.H., Open Heritage Lead Rein, First Ridden, Ridden & W.H.P. Please see RULE 519 page 80 of the 2024 BSPS Rule Book.

This Show is a qualify for the B.S.P.S. "Binks Family" Champion of Champions. 1st prize-winners in the Open Cradle & Nursery Stakes will Qualify. Please see RULE 520 page 80 of the 2024 BSPS Rule Book.

This show is a qualifier for the BSPS BLACK COUNTRY SADDLES" Best Area Rider of the Year. The champion at this show will qualify for the final at the BSPS Summer Championships Show. Owners and riders must be BSPS members to compete in classes with RIHS and Blue Riband Qualification and animals must be registered with the BSPS except for the Anglo & Part Bred Arabs who must be registered with the AHS.

This show is a qualifier Blue Riband the 1st and 2nd in the following classes will qualify. Open Lead Rein & First Ridden OR open show pony OR Open show hunter pony OR open Intermediate SRT, SH will qualify. Please see RULE 515 page 80 of the 2024 BSPS Rule Book.

This show is affiliated to the Sport Horse Breading of Great Britain

Rules as per the 2024 Handbook. Owners & riders have to be current SHB(GB) members in all ridden classes. RIHS qualifying classes – Classes 11, 12 - 18 are qualifying classes for the RIHS 2024 and only horses registered on the 2024 register are eligible to enter. The two highest placed horses in the Lightweight, Middleweight, Heavyweight & Small classes will qualify for the RIHS. No horse lower than second will qualify. In the Working Hunter class the three highest placed horses will qualify. No horse lower than third will qualify. Where there is only one amateur ridden hunter class the two highest placed smalls, the two highest placed lightweights, the two highest placed middleweights and the two highest placed heavyweights will qualify. When there are two classes, in the lightweight section, the two highest placed smalls and the two highest placed lightweights will qualify and in the heavyweight section the two highest placed middleweights and the two highest placed heavyweights will qualify.

Open Working Hunter

Open to mares, geldings, stallions (must wear red, white & blue ribbon in tail) 4yrs old & over exceeding 148cms to be judged in accordance with SHB(GB) 2024 rules. Grade A show-jumpers & Advanced Event horses not eligible to compete in these classes.

Novice Working Hunter

NOVICE WORKING HUNTER. A mare, gelding or stallion (competing stallions must have a red, white and blue ribbon displayed in their tail) four years old and over not to have won a first prize of £25 or a total of £150 (or equivalent values) in prize money (including championship prize money) in any SHB(GB) affiliated Working Hunter Class, or more than 5 BE points or 200 BS points, at home or equivalent abroad before 1st January in the relevant year. Fences in Novice Working Hunter classes should have a minimum height of 0.85m (2'9") and a maximum height of 1.00m (3'3"). Working Hunters may compete 'Hors Concours' in Novice Working Hunter classes in the jumping phase only at the discretion of the show secretary but the horse cannot compete in any other Working Hunter classes for the duration of that show. Any horse that qualifies for Horse of the Year Show or Royal International Horse Show will not be eligible to compete in Novice classes from 1st January the following year, but horses that qualified for HOYS as a 4 year old are exempt. Day Ticket -this entitles competitors to compete at a maximum of 2 shows in the year at £42 per show – it covers owner and rider membership together with horse registration for these 2 shows. If the class is a qualifying class for RIHS, in order for the qualification to be valid, application for full owner/rider membership and horse registration must be received in the SHB (GB) office within 14 days. a) AFFILIATED SHOW. A Show affiliated to the Society at which the Hunter Classes are carried out in accordance with the Society's rules and regulations.

AMATEUR RULES & DEFINITION.

It is expected that Exhibitors will compete in the true spirit of these Rules. The Directors / Board / Council reserve the right, in their absolute discretion, to reclassify an Exhibitor's Amateur status/entry should they deem it necessary.

AMATEUR STATUS

A person is an Amateur for the purpose of classes run under Association Rules if he/she does not, during the current or previous season:

- Engage in breeding, livery, buying, selling, dealing, or hiring horses in a commercial capacity, or as means of deriving a source of income.
- Receive remuneration, whether it be monetary or goods in kind, for employment in the connection with horses in racing, showing, livery stable or riding school (instruction at Pony Club and Riding Club excepted). This does not include the suppliers of ancillary services such as farriers and vets.
- Own/Part own an equestrian establishment including but not limited to; riding schools, events centre, stud, or livery yard in any capacity, or receive any form of remuneration for employment at an equestrian establishment. For the avoidance of doubt for the purpose of this rule, immediate family members of an owner or part owner of an equestrian establishment who work or

are howsoever otherwise engaged or involved in any capacity, whether or not for remuneration at the equestrian establishment, will be treated as being an owner or part owner of that equestrian establishment.

- Show a Horse owned or sponsored by a company or a commercial firm, or act as a Brand Ambassador, in any showing classes, SHB(GB) or otherwise, or a Horse for which his/her immediate family accepts livery or training charges from a person outside the immediate family concerned.
- PLEASE NOTE: a). If you ride/compete equines on a regular basis, which you do not stable at home, your Amateur status will be reviewed by the Board/Council, i.e., if you ride/compete multiple equines or ride regularly for one or more owners, you could be deemed professional.
- b). A competitor is not eligible to compete in Amateur classes on an Exhibit, which has been ridden by a Professional Rider in ANY class, SHB(GB) or otherwise, with the exception of Working classes, Side Saddle classes AND Novice classes, during the current year and the following year, up to but not including the Royal International Horse Show.
- c). (The above Rule (b) does not apply, if the Horse has been Professionally Produced and ONLY ridden by a Professional, during the current season, or if the horse has subsequently been sold and re-registered under new Ownership).
- d). On the day when an Exhibit is competing in Amateur classes, Professionals, including Professional Grooms, are not allowed to ride, to work-in (in any form), compete, or enter the Ring to groom/strip the Horse.
- e). No commercial branding can be visible in the ring, during Amateur classes (including Amateur Home Produced), this applies to equines, riders and any attendees; this also includes outside the ring, or online i.e. on social media.
- f). We may require a statement of your eligibility to compete in Home Produced classes.
- 1. AMATEUR CLASSES
- a). AMATEUR OWNER / RIDER: Open to Horses owned and ridden by an Amateur. No Professional, including Professional Grooms, are allowed into the ring to groom/strip the Horse.
- b). AMATEUR HOME PRODUCED: Open to Horses, which are either stabled at home or in a D. I. Y. yard and which since 1st January in the current year, have not been shown by a Professional during the current season or stabled in a Professional yard at any time in the current year. To be ridden by an Amateur. This does not exclude Amateur Owner Home Produced riders having lessons at any time with an instructor, providing the Horse remains stabled at home. No Professional, including Professional Grooms, are allowed into the ring to groom/strip the Horse. We may require a statement of your eligibility to compete in Home Produced classes.

This Show is affiliated to the BSHA

All Rules per the 2024 Rulebook

Classes 19 - 33 are held under the rules of the British Show Horse Association. Horses must be registered with the Association and all Owners, Exhibitors & Riders must be Association Members. Riders must be 15 years of age or older. Classes 20 - 33 REGISTRATION NUMBERS MUST BE QUOTED ON ENTRY FORM. Classes 21, 22, 23, 25, 26, 28 & 29 are qualifiers for the RIHS 2024. The first prize winner will qualify to compete at the final. If already qualified the second will qualify, if the first and second are already qualified then the third will go forward. Horses competing at the RIHS and qualifying shows in the Hunter sections of the Sport Horse Breeding of Great Britain classes at their affiliated shows cannot compete in Hack, Cobs & Riding Horse classes at the same show on the same day and vice versa. This does not apply to SHB (GB) Ridden Sport Horse classes.

The BSHA offer a Novice, Young Rider and Amateur rosette in each Open class and a Champion rosette for each section (with the exception of Open Working Show Horse, Ladies Show Horse & HOYS Hunter classes. Recipients of the Young Rider rosette will qualify for the BSHA Young Rider of the Year at the National Championship Show in September 2024. The awards will go down the line; there is no limit on how many of these rosettes can be claimed in a year. Competitors

qualifying at this for the Longines Royal International Horse Show July 2024 must submit their ONLINE entries at:- www.hickstead.co.uk/entries-results-schooling/longines-fei-jumping-nations cup-of-great-britain-at-the-longines-royal-internationalhorse-show/Schedules will be available to download.

Day tickets. Non Members may purchase up to a maximum of 2 Day Tickets per exhibitor, per horse, per rider, per season. A Day Ticket will allow entry into Novice, Amateur, Young Rider, Home Produced, Working, In-Hand and Open affiliated classes only **but will not allow entry into RIHS or HOYS qualifying classes.** Horses registered on a Day Ticket do **not** require a JMB height certificate. Competitors can apply for a Day Ticket by downloading an application form, or apply online on the BSHA website. **Novice Hack. Cob & Riding Horses.** A Novice is a BSHA registered horse (with exception of hunter) that has not won a first prize of £25, or more than a total of £150 (including Championship prize money) in any showing classes excluding Working Show Horses, Best Trained, Pairs, Side-Saddle, or In-Hand classes that were affiliated to the Association, at home or abroad, prior to the 1st January in the current year. Winnings gained as a four year old are exempt, unless that four year old has won an Open Ridden class with a first prize of £25 or more. Snaffle bridles may be worn in Novice classes.

Animals in ridden height restricted classes WILL NOT be required to be in possession of a JMB Height Certificate or verification of measurement to compete in RIHS or HOYS Qualifiers.
