COVID 19 RULES AND GUIDELINES

BSPS SCOTLAND EXPECTS EACH MEMBER/EXHIBITOR TO TAKE PERSONAL RESPONSIBILITY FOR NOT SPREADING THE VIRUS AND OBEYING ALL RULES REGARDING SOCIAL DISTANCING. FAILURE TO DO SO WILL RESULT IN YOU BEING ASKED TO LEAVE THE SHOWGROUND AND ANY RIDER WILL BE ELIMINATED FROM THEIR CLASS

- Social distance from members other than your family group by 2 meters
- Use hand sanitisers on regular basis.
- Wash hands thoroughly after any contact with facilities.
- Use lorry toilets where possible to minimise the risk.
- Obey orders given by BSPS Scotland Officials regarding social distancing.
- Wear face masks and gloves wherever possible to avoid spreading the virus.
- Temperature checks MAY be taken during the show.

DAY OF SHOW

This guidance must be adhered to by all Competitors, Stewards, Judges and BSPS Scotland Officials attending the show.

1. Competitors numbers will be available from the Secretary's Office on the day of the Show.
2. All cars and lorries must be parked with an adequate distance in accordance with social distancing as indicated by the parking attendant.
3. Limited stabling will be available by contacting Champfleurie Stables directly.
4. Hand sanitisers will be available around the site. Exhibitors should use these frequently and wash their hands to stop the spread of virus.

SHOWING GUIDELINES

1. The collecting ring and warm up area will be supervised, and all exhibitors must adhere to the instructions of the Steward in attendance.
2. Ponies in the line-up must be at least 3 metres apart, please follow the instructions of the Steward.
3. If a judge chooses to use an official BSPS mark sheet during a class, they will not be available on the day of the Show but will be published online after the show.

RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. This Show is affiliated to the British Show Pony Society and all persons entering, competing, showing or otherwise taking part in the B.S.P.S. Classes, whether or not Members of the B.S.P.S. are subject to the Constitution and Rules of the B.S.P.S., including disciplinary procedures, and shall be deemed to have consented to the jurisdiction of the B.S.P.S.
2. Neither the BSPS Scottish Branch Committee, nor any of its Officers, Servants, or Assistants shall be responsible or accountable for any loss, injury or damage to any person, animal, or property in connection with this Show.
3. Each Exhibitor shall abide by and accept as final the decision of the Judges, Referees, Chief Steward and Officials of the Show.
4. The Judges listed in the Schedule have accepted our invitation to Judge, but the Committee reserve the right to appoint substitutes should any Judge withdraw.
5. No Exhibitor may knowingly show a pony under a Judge in circumstances that would constitute a breach of **Rule 477** by the Judge.
6. Any pony taking part in Classes judged under B.S.P.S. Rules will be liable to dope testing.
7. Entries will not be accepted without the appropriate fee.

8. In ALL Classes, correctly secured British Standard Skull Caps/Riding Hats, numbers All PAS015, VG1, (BS) EN1384 2017, ASTM F1163 04a onwards, SNELL E2001, SNELL E2016 AS/NZS 3838 2003 onwards, MUST be worn by riders at all times when mounted. Hats should have a plain cover either Black, Navy Blue, Brown, Grey or Green. Velvet covers are encouraged. BSPS SCOTLAND ACCEPTS NO RESPONSIBILITY FOR ANY INJURY ARISING FROM A FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THIS REGULATION. HAT CHECKS FOR COMPLIANCE WILL BE MADE.

9. Under no circumstances will entries be changed, substituted, or amended once received.

10. Only animals entered in classes at the BSPS Scotland Autumn WHP Show 2021 may use the arenas for exercising.

11. Only tack permissible under BSPS rules may be used whilst mounted anywhere on the showground.

12. **Rule 67** - No member of the BSPS shall conduct himself in a manner or be guilty of behaviour which is derogatory to the character or prejudicial to the interests of the BSPS and in particular (but without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing) no Member shall behave in an offensive or abusive or unpleasant matter to any person at any show or at any other location where BSPS business is being transacted or via social media or the internet or via any publication in whatever format or via any other written or electronic format. Members' attention is drawn to the BSPS Social Media and Internet Policy set out in the back of the BSPS Handbook.

13. **Rule 70** – Members are responsible for the actions of any non-members who are Family Members (as defined below) or who are friends or friends of Family Members or who are employed by them or assisting, supporting or representing them or otherwise acting on their behalf and any action or conduct of such non-member which would be a breach of the Rules were he a Member shall constitute a breach of the Rules by the Member concerned. Family Member shall include a spouse or civil partner, a partner, a direct descendant or ascendant of the Member or his spouse or civil partner, brothers, sisters or adopted children of the Member or his spouse or civil partner, or any other person who is part of the same household as the Member or is in the reasonable opinion of the BSPS a member of the Member's family in the widest sense.

14. The BSPS Scottish Branch/Board of Directors reserve the right to move, change, amalgamate or divide any class or championship as they deem fit when necessary, to facilitate the running of the show. It is therefore the competitor's responsibility to keep up to date with any changes which may occur during the running of the show. There will be no Supreme of Show held at this Show.

15. **Rule 60a - EQUINE INFLUENZA** – All pony/horses competing in BSPS Scotland Spring Show must abide by Rule 60a Equine Influenza and Tetanus vaccinations are a compulsory requirement for all pony/horses registered with the BSPS. The requirement for the first 3 vaccinations is as follows: The first 2 vaccinations 21 – 92 days apart, a third booster between 150 – 215 days, and an annual booster vaccination within 365 days thereafter. No horse should enter competitions within 7 days of an EI vaccination. This rule may be subject to change from guidance from the FEI/BEF and any changes will be notified via the www.bsps.com website. The current FEI ruling is for a 6 monthly booster as opposed to annual; therefore, it is recommended that you check with the shows that fall under FEI regulation before entering e.g. Windsor, Hickstead etc.

BRITISH SHOW PONY SOCIETY CLASSES

This Show is affiliated to the BSPS and all persons entering, competing, showing or otherwise taking part in BSPS classes, whether or not members of the BSPS are subject to the constitution and Rules of the BSPS, including the disciplinary procedures, and shall be deemed to have consented to the jurisdiction of the BSPS.

The 1st, 2nd & 3rd prize-winners will qualify in the Novice Classes and Open First Pony of Show Pony or Show Hunter Pony Type Class and in the MIXED HEIGHT NOVICE CLASSES the 1st, 2nd, 3rd & 4th prize winners will qualify.

In the Open Classes, the three-highest placed Restricted animals in each class will qualify, and in the MIXED HEIGHT OPEN CLASSES the four-highest placed Restricted animals will qualify, (riders on Restricted animals MUST wear an armband).

RULE 5. Exhibitors in qualifying positions, who have never been members of the BSPS are allowed 7 working days in which to become members and register their ponies. Please note this Rule does not apply to classes with HOYS, RIHS, Olympia or Blue Riband Qualifications.

RULE 26. Owners, Riders and Ponies must be registered BEFORE the date of the Show at which they qualify, except in the case of exhibitors who have never been members before who are allowed 7 days in which to become members and register their ponies. This Rule does not apply to classes with RIHS or Olympia qualification.

HERITAGE QUALIFICATION

The 1st, 2nd and 3rd placed ponies in the Novice Classes will qualify and in mixed height Novice classes 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th prizewinners will qualify. In the Open (Restricted) Classes the qualification will be awarded to the three-highest placed Restricted animals in each class, and in the mixed height Open (Restricted) classes the four-highest placed Restricted animals will qualify, (riders on Restricted animals MUST wear an armband).

Animals must be registered before the date of the Show at which they qualify for the Winter Championships and must be ridden by BSPS Members, except in the case of exhibitors who have never been members before who are allowed 7 days in which to become members and register their ponies.

THE ROYAL HIGHLAND SHOW – NURSERY STAKES

This show is a qualifier for The Royal Highland Show Nursery Stakes 2022. The first 4 placed same pony and rider combination will qualify for the 2022 Royal Highland Show Nursery Stakes. Qualification will only move down the line to the next eligible pony and rider combination provided they have jumped a clear round. This class is open to both BSPS Members and Non-Members. Qualification will be in accordance with Rule 37 of the BSPS Rule and Show Handbook. This class is open to both BSPS Members and Non-Members.

Rule 37 – No rider may ride more than one pony in a class except that Riders in all WHP Classes that are not qualifiers for HOYS or RIHS. Who may ride up to two ponies of the same height in a class, but **ONLY** the first pony to jump will be competitive and go forward for Phase II judging, the second pony will not go forward for Phase II. **PLEASE NOTE: EACH RIDER MUST NOT HAVE ATTAINED THEIR 12TH BIRTHDAY BEFORE 1ST JANUARY 2022 TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR THE NURSERY STAKE CHAMPION CLASS AT THE ROYAL HIGHLAND SHOW 2022.**

CLASS 1 TRAINING STAKES – 60CMS

Open to all types of horses & ponies, 4 years old or over.

CLASS 2 THE BSPTS 122CMS HERITAGE MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND NOVICE WORKING HUNTER PONY

Registered pure bred ponies 4 years old or over, not exceeding 122cms. Riders any age. Maximum height of fences 60cms.

CLASS 3 THE BSPTS 133CMS HERITAGE MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND NOVICE WORKING HUNTER PONY

Registered pure bred ponies 4 years old or over, exceeding 122cms but not exceeding 133cms. Riders any age. Maximum height of fences 65cms.

CLASS 4 THE BSPTS 143CMS HERITAGE MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND NOVICE WORKING HUNTER PONY

Registered pure bred ponies 4 years old or over, exceeding 133cms but not exceeding 143cms. Riders any age. Maximum height of fences 75cms.

CLASS 5 THE BSPTS EX. 143CMS HERITAGE MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND NOVICE WORKING HUNTER PONY

Registered pure bred ponies 4 years old or over, exceeding 143cms. Riders any age. Maximum height of fences 85cms.

***HERITAGE M & M NOVICE WORKING HUNTER PONY CHAMPIONSHIP
OPEN TO 1ST AND 2ND PRIZE WINNERS FROM CLASSES 2 - 5***

CLASS 6 THE BSPTS EX. 143CMS HERITAGE MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND OPEN (RESTRICTED) WORKING HUNTER PONY

Registered pure bred ponies 4 years old or over, exceeding 143cms. Riders any age. Maximum height of fences 95cms.

CLASS 7 THE BSPTS 143CMS HERITAGE MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND OPEN (RESTRICTED) WORKING HUNTER PONY

Registered pure bred ponies 4 years old or over, exceeding 133cms but not exceeding 143cms. Riders any age. Maximum height of fences 85cms.

CLASS 8 THE BSPTS 133CMS HERITAGE MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND OPEN (RESTRICTED) WORKING HUNTER PONY

Registered pure bred ponies 4 years old or over, exceeding 122cms but not exceeding 133cms. Riders any age. Maximum height of fences 75cms.

CLASS 9 THE BSPTS 122CMS HERITAGE MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND OPEN (RESTRICTED) WORKING HUNTER PONY

Registered pure bred ponies 4 years old or over, not exceeding 122cms. Riders any age.

***HERITAGE OPEN M & M WORKING HUNTER PONY CHAMPIONSHIP
OPEN TO 1ST AND 2ND PRIZE WINNERS FROM CLASSES 6 - 9***

CLASS 10 MINI TRAINING STAKES – 50CMS

Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 133cm. Riders not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Max height of fences 50cm

CLASS 11 OPEN CRADLE STAKES (NON-QUALIFIER)

Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 122cms. Riders not to have attained their 11th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Max height of fences 60cm.

CLASS 12 THE BSPTS OPEN (RESTRICTED) NURSERY STAKES

KINDLY SPONSORED BY CHAMPFLEURIE STABLES

Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 133cms. Riders not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Max height of fences 70cm. ***This class is a qualifier for The Royal Highland Show 2022.***

***MINI WHP CHAMPIONSHIP
OPEN TO 1ST AND 2ND PRIZE WINNERS FROM CLASSES 11 AND 12***

PLEASE NOTE: ANIMALS MAY NOT COMPETE IN THE 153CM AND INTERMEDIATE CLASS AT THE SAME SHOW IN THE SAME SECTION.

CLASS 13 TRAINING STAKES – 70CMS

Open to all types of horses & ponies, 4 years old or over.

CLASS 14 THE BSPTS CLASS FOR NOVICE WORKING HUNTER PONY – 133CMS
Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 133cms. Riders not to have attained their 14th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Max height of fences 75cm.

CLASS 15 THE BSPTS CLASS FOR NOVICE WORKING HUNTER PONY – 143CMS
Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 143cms. Riders not to have attained their 17th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Max height of fences 85cm.

CLASS 16 THE BSPTS CLASS FOR NOVICE WORKING HUNTER PONY – 153CMS
Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 153cms. Riders not to have attained their 20th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Max height of fences 90cm.

CLASS 17 THE BSPTS CLASS FOR NOVICE INTERMEDIATE WORKING HUNTER PONY
Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 158cms. Riders not to have attained their 25th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Max height of fences 1m.

***NOVICE WORKING HUNTER PONY CHAMPIONSHIP
OPEN TO 1ST AND 2ND PRIZE WINNERS FROM CLASSES 14 - 17***

CLASS 18 THE BSPTS CLASS FOR OPEN (RESTRICTED) INTERMEDIATE WORKING HUNTER PONY
Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 158cms. Riders not to have attained their 25th birthday before 1st January in the Current year. Max height of fences 1m 5cm.

CLASS 19 THE BSPTS CLASS FOR OPEN (RESTRICTED) WORKING HUNTER PONY – 153CM
Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 153cms. Riders not to have attained their 20th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Max height of fences 1m

CLASS 20 THE BSPTS CLASS FOR OPEN (RESTRICTED) WORKING HUNTER PONY – 143CMS
Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 143cms. Riders not to have attained their 17th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Max height of fences 90cm.

CLASS 21 THE BSPS CLASS FOR OPEN (RESTRICTED) WORKING HUNTER PONY – 133CMS

Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 133cms. Riders not to have attained their 14th birthday before the 1st January in the current year. Max Height of fences 85cm.
