COVID 19 RULES AND GUIDELINES

PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING GUIDELINES CAREFULLY BEFORE ATTENDING THIS SHOW

BSPS SCOTLAND EXPECTS EACH MEMBER/EXHIBITOR TO TAKE PERSONAL RESPONSIBILITY FOR NOT SPREADING THE VIRUS AND OBEYING ALL RULES REGARDING SOCIAL DISTANCING. FAILURE TO DO SO WILL RESULT IN YOU BEING ASKED TO LEAVE THE SHOWGROUND. PLEASE DO NOT ATTEND THE SHOW IF YOU ARE CLASSIFIED AS BEING IN A VULNERABLE CATEGORY AS PER GOVERNMENT GUIDELINES.

DO NOT ATTEND IF YOU ARE DISPLAYING THE CORONAVIRUS SYMPTOMS

Social distance from members other than your family group by 2 meters
Use hand sanitisers on regular basis.

Wash hands thoroughly after any contact with facilities.
Use lorry toilets where possible to minimise the risk.
Obey orders given by BSPS Scotland Officials regarding social distancing.
Wear face masks and gloves wherever possible to avoid spreading the virus.
Temperature checks MAY be taken during the show.

IN ADVANCE OF THE DAY OF SHOW

- 1. Only pre-entries will be accepted for this show. **NO ENTRIES ON THE DAY.** This will help reduce numbers in the office, enable effective timetabling and where necessary restrict entries and be able to track and trace all those who attend the event.
- 2. There will be a limit to entries to the number of competitors in each class. A timetable will be published, after entries have closed, giving an approximate time when each class will commence. This will help to reduce the numbers on site at any one time, classes will not be held before the scheduled start time.
- 3. The show is open to Non Members as well as BSPS Members.
- 4. All show organisers and helpers will wear appropriate PPE equipment. Numbers entering the Secretary's Office on Show Day will be restricted to one person at a time to ensure social distancing is adhered to. There will be clear signage and instructions visible for all exhibitors.
- 5. There will be a maximum of 3 people per pony/horse who are not subject to social distancing, allowed to attend the Show. A **PARENT/GUARDIAN** must attend to accompany any child under the age of 18 years.

6. BSPS Scotland has appointed their Secretary as their Covid-19 Officer who has completed a Covid-19 course.

7. NO MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC WILL BE ADMITTED TO SHOWGROUND

DAY OF SHOW

This guidance must be adhered to by all Competitors, Stewards, Judges and BSPS Scotland Officials attending the show.

- 1. All vehicles arriving at the show will be checked to make sure they have pre-entered and are eligible to access the site.
- 2. All names and addresses will be recorded including, the names of those attending the show with the exhibitor, at the entrance to the venue. This will be essential should there be a requirement to track and trace those who attended the event in support of COVID-19 Track and Tracing.
- 3. All cars and lorries must be parked with an adequate distance in accordance with social distancing as indicated by the parking attendant.
- 4. There will be no overnight stabling at present due to social distancing. THIS MAY CHANGE WITH GOVERNMENT GUIDELINES AND WITH THE CONSENT OF MORRIS EQUESTRIAN CENTRE.
- 5. Toilet facilities will be managed in line with Government guidelines.
- 6. Refreshment facilities may be available at the show, these will be managed in line with Government guidance in place at the time.
- 7. Hand sanitisers will be available around the site. Exhibitors should use these frequently and wash their hands to stop the spread of virus.
- 8. First Aid Cover will be available during the show. In the event of an accident only the designated first aid official and those accompanying the rider who are not subject to social distancing, will attend to the incident.
- 9. Only one Judge will be in attendance and no marks for Flat Classes. The numbers in the ring will restricted according to numbers forward and will be dependent on the size of the ring and in accordance with government guidelines. If the class is judged in sections, the Judge may choose to mark the class or have an aide memoire to determine which ponies come in for final judging and placings. Judges will be required to mark for themselves or keep their own notes.
- 10. There will be only one steward in attendance in the flat ring and they will co-ordinate the line-up.
- 11. Only ponies due to enter a class will be allowed in the collecting ring and will only enter the show ring when called, keeping at a 2 metre distance from the pony in front.

- 12. The collecting ring and warm up area will be supervised, and all exhibitors must adhere to the instructions of the Steward.
- 13. Ponies in the line up must be at least 3 metres apart. If no markers are available as a guide, please follow the instructions of the Steward.
- 14. To minimise risk there will be no stripping of ponies in the ring.
- 15. The conformation section will be judged when ponies come out of the line for judging. Ponies will be asked to walk up and trot back past the judge. They must stand at least 6 metres away from the line allowing the judge to walk around the pony at a 2 metres distance.
- 16. If ponies are required to be called back into the ring for final judging, this will be done via instructions from the Steward.
- 17. The judge may decide to line ponies up and pull them forward in order from their mark sheet or notes or have a final go round to determine places.
- 18. In all lead rein classes the pony must be led by somebody who does not need to socially distance from the rider.
- 19. There will be no rosette presentation in the ring. Rosettes can be collected from the Secretary's Office after the class on foot. Exhibitors must adhere to the instructions of the official in attendance and only approach the table when asked.
- 20. If a judge chooses to use an official BSPS mark sheet during a class, they will not be available on the day of the Show but will be published online after the show.
- 21. Competitors are requested to leave the showground as soon as possible when they have finished their classes.

RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1. This Show is affiliated to the British Show Pony Society and all persons entering, competing, showing or otherwise taking part in the B.S.P.S. Classes, whether or not Members of the B.S.P.S. are subject to the Constitution and Rules of the B.S.P.S., including disciplinary procedures, and shall be deemed to have consented to the jurisdiction of the B.S.P.S.
- 2. Neither the BSPS Scottish Branch Committee, nor any of its Officers, Servants, or Assistants shall be responsible or accountable for any loss, injury or damage to any person, animal, or property in connection with this Show.
- 3. Each Exhibitor shall abide by and accept as final the decision of the Judges, Referees, Chief Steward and Officials of the Show.
- 4. The Judges listed in the Schedule have accepted our invitation to Judge, but the Committee reserve the right to appoint substitutes should any Judge withdraw.
- 5. No Exhibitor may knowingly show a pony under a Judge in circumstances that would constitute a breach of Rule 477 by the Judge.
- 6. Any pony taking part in Classes judged under B.S.P.S. Rules will be liable to dope testing.
- 7. Entries will not be accepted without the appropriate fee. An S.A.E. must be submitted with entries if a receipt is required. No numbers will be sent to Exhibitors prior to the Show. Competitors' numbers should be collected from the Secretary's Office on the Show Ground adhering to the Covid 19 guidelines set out in this schedule. Cheques to be made payable to BSPS Scottish Branch Ltd. NO entries will be accepted over the telephone.
- 8. In ALL Classes, correctly secured British Standard Skull Caps/Riding Hats, numbers All PAS015, VG1, (BS) EN1384 2017, ASTM F1163 04a onwards, SNELL E2001, SNELL E2016 AS/NZS 3838 2003 onwards, MUST be worn by riders at all times when mounted. Hats should have a plain cover either Black, Navy Blue, Brown, Grey or Green. Velvet covers are encouraged. BSPS SCOTLAND ACCEPTS NO RESPONSIBILITY FOR ANY INJURY ARISING FROM A FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THIS REGULATION. HAT CHECKS FOR COMPLIANCE WILL BE MADE.
- 9. Under no circumstances will entries be changed, substituted, or amended once received.
- 10. Only animals entered in classes at the BSPS Late Summer Show 2020 may use the arenas for exercising.
- 11. Only tack permissible under BSPS rules may be used whilst mounted anywhere on the showground.
- 12. **Rule 67** No member of the BSPS shall conduct himself in a manner or be guilty of behavior which is derogatory to the character or prejudicial to the interests of the BSPS and in particular (but without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing) no Member shall behave in an offensive or abusive or

unpleasant matter to any person at any show or at any other location where BSPS business is being transacted or via social media or the internet or via any publication in whatever format or via any other written or electronic format. Members' attention is drawn to the BSPS Social Media and Internet Policy set out in the back of the BSPS Handbook.

- 13. **Rule 70** Members are responsible for the actions of any non-members who are Family Members (as defined below) or who are friends or friends of Family Members or who are employed by them or assisting, supporting or representing them or otherwise acting on their behalf and any action or conduct of such non-member which would be a breach of the Rules were he a Member shall constitute a breach of the Rules by the Member concerned. Family Member shall include a spouse or civil partner, a partner, a direct descendant or ascendant of the Member or his spouse or civil partner, brothers, sisters or adopted children of the Member or his spouse or civil partner, or any other person who is part of the same household as the Member or is in the reasonable opinion of the BSPS a member of the Member's family in the widest sense.
- 14. The BSPS Scottish Branch/Board of Directors reserve the right to move, change, amalgamate or divide any class, championship or supreme as they deem fit when necessary to facilitate the running of the show. It is therefore the competitor's responsibility to keep up to date with any changes which may occur during the running of the show. Supreme of Show will be judged after all sections have been concluded.
- 15. **Rule 60a EQUINE INFLUENZA** All pony/horses competing in BSPS Scotland Late Summer Show must abide by Rule 60a Equine Influenza and Tetanus vaccinations are a compulsory requirement for all pony/horses registered with the BSPS. The requirement for the first 3 vaccinations is as follows: The first 2 vaccinations 21 92 days apart, a third booster between 150 215 days, and an annual booster vaccination within 365 days thereafter. No horse should enter competitions within 7 days of an El vaccination. This rule may be subject to change from guidance from the FEI/BEF and any changes will be notified via the www.bsps.com website. The current FEI ruling is for a 6 monthly booster as opposed to annual; therefore, it is recommended that you check with the shows that fall under FEI regulation before entering e.g. Windsor, Hickstead etc.

CLASS 2 NOVICE FIRST RIDDEN PONY (SHOW PONY, SHOW PONY OF HUNTER TYPE)

Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 122cms. Open to all types SP & SHP. Riders not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st of January in the current year.

Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 122cms. Riders not to have attained their 8th birthday before the 1st of January in the current year.

CLASS 4 THE BSPS OPEN SHOW PONY FIRST RIDDEN

Mare or gelding 4 years old and over, not exceeding 122cms. Riders not to have attained their 10th birthday before the 1st of January in the current year.

THE BSPS MINI SHOW PONY CHAMPIONSHIP

OPEN TO 1ST & 2ND PRIZEWINNERS FROM CLASSES 3 AND 4

WILL NOT COMMENCE NOT BEFORE - TBC PRIOR TO DAY OF SHOW

CLASS 5 THE BSPS OPEN SHOW HUNTER PONY LEAD REIN

Mare or gelding 4 years old and over not exceeding 122cms. Riders not to have attained their 9th birthday before 1st January in current year.

CLASS 6 THE BSPS FIRST PONY OF SHOW HUNTER TYPE

Mare or gelding 4 years old and over not exceeding 122cms. Riders not to have attained their 10th birthday before the 1st January in the current year. Snaffles bridles only. No cantering is allowed except in individual performance. Ponies must leave ring in walk or trot.

OPEN TO 1ST & 2ND PRIZEWINNERS FROM CLASSES 5 AND 6

Mare or gelding 4 years old and over not exceeding 148cms. Competitors must be the right age for the height of pony they ride.

1ST & 2ND PRIZEWINNERS TO RECEIVE CHAMPION & RESERVE CHAMPION

CLASS 8 THE BSPS MIXED HEIGHT RESTRICTED SHOW PONIES

Mare or gelding 4 years old and over not exceeding 148cms. Competitors must be the right age for the height of pony they ride. Animals eligible for this class must not have been placed 1st to 8th at the RIHS (except pretty Polly) or HOYS in the Show Pony classes in 2018/2019/2020.

1ST & 2ND PRIZEWINNERS TO RECEIVE CHAMPION & RESERVE CHAMPION

WILL NOT COMMENCE NOT BEFORE - TBC PRIOR TO DAY OF SHOW

CLASS 9 THE BSPS OPEN SHOW PONIES – 128CMS

Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 128cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 13th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

CLASS 10 THE BSPS OPEN SHOW PONIES – 138CMS

Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 128cms and not exceeding 138cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 15th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

CLASS 11 THE BSPS OPEN SHOW PONIES – 148CMS

Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 138cms and not exceeding 148cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 17th birthday before 1st January in the current year

THE BSPS SHOW PONY CHAMPIONSHIP

OPEN TO 1ST & 2ND PRIZEWINNERS FROM CLASSES 9, 10 AND 11

Mare or gelding 4 years old and over not exceeding 153cms. Competitors must be the correct age for the height of animal they ride.

CLASS 13 THE BSPS MIXED HEIGHT RESTRICTED SHOW HUNTER PONIES

Mare or gelding 4 years old and over not exceeding 153cms. Competitors must be the correct age for the height of animal they ride. Animals eligible for this class must not have been placed 1st to 8th at the RIHS (except pretty Polly) or HOYS in the Show Hunter Pony classes in 2018/2019/2020.

Mare or gelding 4 years old and over exceeding 133cms and not exceeding 143cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 17th Birthday before 1st January in the current year.
