COVID 19 RULES AND GUIDELINES

BSPS SCOTLAND EXPECTS EACH MEMBER/EXHIBITOR TO TAKE PERSONAL RESPONSIBILITY FOR NOT SPREADING THE VIRUS AND OBEYING ALL RULES REGARDING SOCIAL DISTANCING. FAILURE TO DO SO WILL RESULT IN YOU BEING ASKED TO LEAVE THE SHOWGROUND AND ANY RIDER WILL BE ELIMINATED FROM THEIR CLASS

DO NOT ATTEND IF YOU ARE DISPLAYING THE CORONAVIRUS SYMPTOMS

Social distance from members other than your family group by 2 meters

Use hand sanitisers on regular basis.

Wash hands thoroughly after any contact with facilities.

Use lorry toilets where possible to minimise the risk.

Obey orders given by BSPS Scotland Officials regarding social distancing.

Wear face masks and gloves wherever possible to avoid spreading the virus.

Temperature checks MAY be taken during the show.

IN ADVANCE OF THE DAY OF SHOW

- 1. Only pre-entries will be accepted for this show. **NO ENTRIES ON THE DAY.** This will help reduce numbers in the office, enable effective timetabling and where necessary, restrict entries and enable us to track and trace all those who attend the event.
- 2. There will be a limit to entries to the number of competitors in each class. A timetable will be published, after entries have closed, giving an approximate time when each class will commence. This will help to reduce the numbers on site at any one time, classes will not be held before the scheduled start time.
- 3. All show organisers and helpers will wear appropriate PPE equipment.
- 4. There will be a maximum of 3 people, including the rider, per pony/horse who are not subject to social distancing, allowed to attend the Show. A **PARENT/GUARDIAN** must attend to accompany any child under the age of 18 years.
- 5. BSPS Scotland has appointed Helen Outram and Elaine Smillie as their Covid-19 Officer's.

6. ANY ONE NOT ON THE ONLINE TRACK & TRACE FORM AND MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC WILL NOT BE ADMITTED TO SHOWGROUND. THE BSPS SECRETARY MUST BE INFORMED OF ANY CHANGES TO THE TRACK AND TRACE DETAILS SUPPLIED WHEN PRE-ENTERING THE SHOW PRIOR TO THE DATE OF THE SHOW.

DAY OF SHOW

This guidance must be adhered to by all Competitors, Stewards, Judges and BSPS Scotland Officials attending the show.

- 1. All vehicles arriving at the show will be checked to ensure they have pre-entered and are eligible to access the site.
- 2. Competitors numbers will be available from the Secretary's van adjacent to the outdoor pavilion.
- 3. All cars and lorries must be parked with an adequate distance in accordance with social distancing as indicated by the parking attendant.
- 4. Limited stabling will be available by contacting Morris EC directly.
- 5. Hand sanitisers will be available around the site. Exhibitors should use these frequently and wash their hands to stop the spread of virus.
- 6. First Aid Cover will be available during the show. In the event of an accident only the designated first aid official and those accompanying the rider who are not subject to social distancing, will attend to the incident.

SHOWING GUIDELINES

- 1. The collecting ring and warm up area will be supervised, and all exhibitors must adhere to the instructions of the Steward in attendance.
- 2. Only one person can accompany a pony/rider combination in the collecting ring. Hand sanitiser must be used before and after handling the poles.
- 3. Exhibitors/trainers/parents must not enter the practice arena. The practice fence will be adjusted to the required height by the BSPS Scotland Stewards in attendance
- 4. Only 2 people will be allowed to walk the course per pony (the rider, plus parent/trainer, who do not need to social distance) and when walking the course competitors must socially distance by 2 metres from other competitors and complete the task as quickly as possible.
- 5. Ponies should only enter the show ring when called.
- 6. The ring Steward will record marks staying 2 metres apart from the Judge.
- 7. Ponies who have been placed will be called back into the ring via instructions from the Steward. Ponies in the line-up must be at least 3 metres apart. If no markers are available as a guide, please follow the instructions of the Steward.
- 8. COMPETITORS MUST WEAR BACK PROTECTORS IN WHP PRACTICE AREA AND CLASSES.
- 9. If a judge chooses to use an official BSPS mark sheet during a class, they will not be available on the day of the Show but will be published online after the show.
- 10. Competitors are requested to leave the showground as soon as possible when they have finished their classes.

RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

BSPS MEMBERS SHOULD ENSURE THAT THEIR MEMBERSHIP CARDS ARE AVAILABLE TO VIEW IN THE RING IF REQUIRED BY A JUDGE OR STEWARD

- 1. This Show is affiliated to the British Show Pony Society and all persons entering, competing, showing or otherwise taking part in the B.S.P.S. Classes, whether or not Members of the B.S.P.S. are subject to the Constitution and Rules of the B.S.P.S., including disciplinary procedures, and shall be deemed to have consented to the jurisdiction of the B.S.P.S.
- 2. Neither the BSPS Scottish Branch Committee, nor any of its Officers, Servants, or Assistants shall be responsible or accountable for any loss, injury or damage to any person, animal, or property in connection with this Show.
- 3. Each Exhibitor shall abide by and accept as final the decision of the Judges, Referees, Chief Steward and Officials of the Show.
- 4. The Judges listed in the Schedule have accepted our invitation to Judge, but the Committee reserve the right to appoint substitutes should any Judge withdraw.
- 5. No Exhibitor may knowingly show a pony under a Judge in circumstances that would constitute a breach of Rule 477 by the Judge.
- 6. Any pony taking part in Classes judged under B.S.P.S. Rules will be liable to dope testing.
- 7. Entries will not be accepted without the appropriate fee.
- 8. In ALL Classes, correctly secured British Standard Skull Caps/Riding Hats, numbers All PAS015, VG1, (BS) EN1384 2017, ASTM F1163 04a onwards, SNELL E2001, SNELL E2016 AS/NZS 3838 2003 onwards, MUST be worn by riders at all times when mounted. Hats should have a plain cover either Black, Navy Blue, Brown, Grey or Green. Velvet covers are encouraged. BSPS SCOTLAND ACCEPTS NO RESPONSIBILITY FOR ANY INJURY ARISING FROM A FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THIS REGULATION. HAT CHECKS FOR COMPLIANCE WILL BE MADE.

9. Under no circumstances will entries be changed, substituted, or amended once received.

- 10. Only animals entered in classes at the BSPS Scotland Spring Show 2021 may use the arenas for exercising.
- 11. Only tack permissible under BSPS rules may be used whilst mounted anywhere on the showground.

- 12. **Rule 67** No member of the BSPS shall conduct himself in a manner or be guilty of behavior which is derogatory to the character or prejudicial to the interests of the BSPS and in particular (but without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing) no Member shall behave in an offensive or abusive or unpleasant matter to any person at any show or at any other location where BSPS business is being transacted or via social media or the internet or via any publication in whatever format or via any other written or electronic format. Members' attention is drawn to the BSPS Social Media and Internet Policy set out in the back of the BSPS Handbook.
- 13. **Rule 70** Members are responsible for the actions of any non-members who are Family Members (as defined below) or who are friends or friends of Family Members or who are employed by them or assisting, supporting or representing them or otherwise acting on their behalf and any action or conduct of such non-member which would be a breach of the Rules were he a Member shall constitute a breach of the Rules by the Member concerned. Family Member shall include a spouse or civil partner, a partner, a direct descendant or ascendant of the Member or his spouse or civil partner, brothers, sisters or adopted children of the Member or his spouse or civil partner, or any other person who is part of the same household as the Member or is in the reasonable opinion of the BSPS a member of the Member's family in the widest sense.
- 14. The BSPS Scottish Branch/Board of Directors reserve the right to move, change, amalgamate or divide any class or championship as they deem fit when necessary to facilitate the running of the show. It is therefore the competitor's responsibility to keep up to date with any changes which may occur during the running of the show. There will be no Supreme of Show held at this Show.
- 15. **Rule 60a EQUINE INFLUENZA** All pony/horses competing in BSPS Scotland Spring Show must abide by Rule 60a Equine Influenza and Tetanus vaccinations are a compulsory requirement for all pony/horses registered with the BSPS. The requirement for the first 3 vaccinations is as follows: The first 2 vaccinations 21 92 days apart, a third booster between 150 215 days, and an annual booster vaccination within 365 days thereafter. No horse should enter competitions within 7 days of an El vaccination. This rule may be subject to change from guidance from the FEI/BEF and any changes will be notified via the www.bsps.com website. The current FEI ruling is for a 6 monthly booster as opposed to annual; therefore, it is recommended that you check with the shows that fall under FEI regulation before entering e.g. Windsor, Hickstead etc.

RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY FOR QUALIFIERS

BRITISH SHOW PONY SOCIETY CLASSES

This Show is affiliated to the BSPS and all persons entering, competing, showing or otherwise taking part in BSPS classes, whether or not members of the BSPS are subject to the constitution and Rules of the BSPS, including the disciplinary procedures, and shall be deemed to have consented to the jurisdiction of the BSPS.

RULE 5. Exhibitors in qualifying positions, who have never been members of the BSPS are allowed 7 working days in which to become members and register their ponies. Please note this Rule does not apply to classes with HOYS, RIHS, Olympia or Blue Riband Qualifications.

RULE 21. Owners, Riders and Ponies must be registered BEFORE the date of the Show at which they qualify for the BSPS Summer and Winter Championships, except in the case of exhibitors who have never been members before who are allowed 7 days in which to become members and register their ponies. (see Rule 5).

RULE 26. Owners, Riders and Ponies must be registered BEFORE the date of the Show at which they qualify for the BSPS Summer and Winter Championships, except in the case of exhibitors who have never been members before who are allowed 7 days in which to become members and register their ponies. This Rule does not apply to classes with RIHS or Olympia qualification.

B.S.P.S. QUALIFICATION

The 1st, 2nd & 3rd prize-winners will qualify in the Novice Classes and Open First Pony of Show Pony or Show Hunter Pony Type Class and in the MIXED HEIGHT NOVICE CLASSES the 1st, 2nd, 3rd & 4th prize winners will qualify.

In the Open Classes the three highest placed Restricted animals in each class will qualify, and in the MIXED HEIGHT OPEN CLASSES the four highest placed Restricted animals will qualify, (riders on Restricted animals MUST wear an armband).

Animals must be registered before the date of the Show at which they qualify for the Winter Championships and must be ridden by B.S.P.S. Members, except in the case of exhibitors who have never been members before who are allowed 7 days in which to become members and register their ponies. **Animals must NOT have been placed 1st to 8th at the RIHS (except Pretty Polly) or HOYS or in the relevant classes in 2019/2020/2021.** Please note that this Rule does not apply to classes with HOYS, RIHS, Olympia or Blue Riband Qualifications. All Rules as per the 2021 BSPS Rule and Show Handbook.

THE BSPS CLASSIC SERVICES GROUP CHALLENGE

This show is a qualifier for the BSPS Classic Services Group Challenge. Animals competing in the following Open Classes will qualify: - Open Lead Rein, First Ridden, Lead Rein Hunter Type, Show Pony, SHP, Cradle and Nursery Stakes, WHP, Intermediate SH, SRT and WH and Open Heritage Lead Rein, First Ridden, Ridden and WHP classes. Ponies must not have qualified for the 2020 Horse of the Year Show. If a pony qualified for the Horse of the Year Show it will forfeit its qualification for the Classic Services Group Challenge.

THE BSPS BINKS FAMILY CHAMPION OF CHAMPIONS

This show is a qualifier for the BSPS Binks Family Champion of Champions the 1st prize winners in the following classes will qualify:- Open Lead Rein, First Ridden, Lead Rein of Hunter Type, Show Pony, SHP, WHP, Intermediate SH, SRT and WH and Open Heritage Lead Rein, First Ridden, Ridden and WHP classes.

THE BSPS THE WHITE COMPANY CHAMPION OF CHAMPIONS

This show is a qualifier for the BSPS The White Company Mini WHP Champion of Champions the 1st prize winners in Open Cradle and Nursery Stakes will qualify.

THE ROYAL HIGHLAND SHOW – NURSERY STAKES

This Qualifying Championship is kindly Sponsored by Chamfleurie Stables

This show is a qualifier for The Royal Highland Show Nursery Stakes 2021. The first 6 placed same pony and rider combination who jump clear will qualify for the 2021 Royal Highland Show Nursery Stakes. Qualification will only move down the line to the next eligible pony and rider combination provided they have jumped a clear round. This class is open to both BSPS Members and Non-Members. Qualification will be in accordance with Rule 37 of the BSPS Rule and Show Handbook. This class is open to both BSPS Members and Non-Members.

Rule 37 – No rider may ride more than one pony in a class except that Riders in all WHP Classes that are not qualifiers for HOYS or RIHS. Who may ride up to two ponies of the same height in a class, but **ONLY** the first pony to jump will be competitive and go forward for Phase II judging, the second pony will not go forward for Phase II.

PLEASE NOTE: EACH RIDER MUST NOT HAVE ATTANED THEIR 12TH BIRTHDAY BEFORE 1ST JANUARY 2021 TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR THE NURSERY STAKE CHAMPION CLASS AT THE ROYAL HIGHLAND SHOW 2021.

THE ROYAL HIGHLAND SHOW ARE VERY KINDLY ALLOWING LATE ENTRIES TO THE NURSERY STAKE CHAMPIONSHIP CLASS AT THEIR SHOW. ALL RIDER/PONY COMBINATIONS WHO QUALIFY AT THIS SHOW MUST PLACE THEIR ENTRIES FOR THE CHAMPIONSHIP CLASS AT THE RHS AS SOON AS POSSIBLE.

BSHA CLASSES

Held under the rules of the British Show Horse Association. Horses must be registered with the Association and all Owners, Exhibitors and Riders must be Association Members. Riders must be 15 years of age or older. **Registration numbers must be quoted on entry form.** Classes 56 - 62 are qualifiers for The Royal International Horse Show. The first prize winner will qualify to compete at the final. If already qualified the second will qualify, if the first and second are already qualified then the third will go forward. Horses competing at the RIHS and qualifying shows in Hunter sections of The Sport Horse Breeding of Great Britain at their Affiliated Shows cannot compete in Hack, Cobs and Riding Horse classes at the same show, on the same day and vice versa. This does not apply to SHB (GB) Ridden Sport Horse classes. The BSHA offer a Novice, Young Rider and Amateur rosette in each Open class and a Champion rosette for each section (with the exception of Open Working Show Horse, Ladies Show Horse & HOYS Hunter classes).

NEW FOR 2021- The 1st or highest placed prize winners in each Open Affiliated class will qualify to compete in the BSHA Hunter and National Championship Shows in September 2021.

SPORT HORSE BREEDING (GB) CLASSES

All Hunter Classes will be judged under the 2021 Rules of the Sport Horse Breeding of Great Britain. Classes 63 – 68 classes are qualifying events for the 2021 RIHS and only horses registered on the 2021 Show Hunter Register are eligible to enter. Registration numbers MUST be quoted on entry forms and owners and members must be members of the society. The two highest placed horses in Classes 63 – 66 WILL QUALIFY TO ENTER. No horse lower than 2nd in its Class will qualify. Amateur Hunter Classes 67 – 68 in the Lightweight section, the two highest placed smalls and the two highest placed lightweights will qualify and in the heavyweight section the two highest placed middleweights and the two highest placed heavyweights will qualify. **REFER TO 2021 RULE BOOK FOR NEW AMATEUR STATUS RULING FOR THE CURRENT YEAR.**

VETERAN HORSE SOCIETY – AREA QUALIFIER 2021. First round qualifier for the Veteran Horse Society Supreme Final: VETERAN HORSE OF THE YEAR 2021 Kindly Sponsored by Allen & Page.

Classes 54 and 55 Open to members and non-members. All competitors and grooms must adhere to VHS Rules in all circumstances. Failure to do so may result in immediate disqualification.

VHS Regional Final qualification. All competitors placed 1st to 4th in each age category will qualify for the corresponding class at VHS Regional Finals. Members must carry their cards in the ring and have their showing card signed by the judge in the ring as proof of qualification. Non-members will receive a red qualification card which can be exchanged for signed showing card when applying for VHS membership. It is the competitors responsibility to present their Showing card to the judge. **Regional Finals are open to members only.** All competitors are eligible to enter open classes at the National Veteran Championships, to be held at Arena UK Lincolnshire on 1st - 3rd October 2021. No qualification or membership necessary. See VHS website for schedule.

Qualification will be from placings, no qualification cards will be awarded in the ring, and no qualification can go down the line.

- CLASS 9 THE BSPS CLASS FOR NOVICE WORKING HUNTER PONY 143CMS

 Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 143cms. Riders not to have attained their 17th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Max height of fences 85cm.
- CLASS 10 THE BSPS CLASS FOR NOVICE WORKING HUNTER PONY 153CMS
