RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1. This Show is affiliated to the British Show Pony Society and all persons entering, competing, showing or otherwise taking part in the B.S.P.S. Classes, whether or not Members of the B.S.P.S. are subject to the Constitution and Rules of the B.S.P.S., including disciplinary procedures, and shall be deemed to have consented to the jurisdiction of the B.S.P.S.
- 2. Neither the BSPS Scottish Branch Committee, nor any of its Officers, Servants, or Assistants shall be responsible or accountable for any loss, injury or damage to any person, animal, or property in connection with this Show.
- 3. Each Exhibitor shall abide by and accept as final the decision of the Judges, Referees, Chief Steward and Officials of the Show.
- 4. The Judges listed in the Schedule have accepted our invitation to Judge, but the Committee reserve the right to appoint substitutes should any Judge withdraw.
- 5. No Exhibitor may knowingly show a pony under a Judge in circumstances that would constitute a breach of Rule 477 by the Judge.
- 6. Any pony taking part in Classes judged under B.S.P.S. Rules will be liable to dope testing.
- 7. Entries will not be accepted without the appropriate fee. An S.A.E. must be submitted with entries if a receipt is required. No numbers will be sent to Exhibitors prior to the Show. Competitors' numbers should be collected from the Secretary's Office on the Show Ground. Cheques and Postal Orders to be made payable to BSPS Scottish Branch Ltd. NO entries will be accepted over the telephone.
- 8. In <u>ALL Classes</u>, correctly secured British Standard Skull Caps/Riding Hats, numbers All PAS015, VG1, (BS) EN1384 2017, ASTM F1163 04a onwards, SNELL E2001, SNELL E2016 AS/NZS 3838 2003 onwards, MUST be worn by riders at all times when mounted. Hats should have a plain cover either Black, Navy Blue, Brown, Grey or Green. Velvet covers are encouraged.

BSPS SCOTLAND ACCEPTS NO RESPONSIBILITY FOR ANY INJURY ARISING FROM A FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THIS REGULATION. HAT CHECKS FOR COMPLIANCE WILL BE MADE.

- 9. Under no circumstances will entries be changed, substituted or amended once received.
- 10. Only animals entered in classes at the BSPS Scotland Summer Show 2019 may use the arenas for exercising.
- 11. Only tack permissible under BSPS rules may be used whilst mounted anywhere on the showground.
- 12. On the day entries will be taken from 7.00am.
- 13. **Rule 67** No member of the BSPS shall conduct himself in a manner or be guilty of behavior which is derogatory to the character or prejudicial to the interests of the BSPS and in particular (but without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing) no Member shall behave in an offensive or abusive or unpleasant matter to any person at any show or at any other location where BSPS business is being transacted or via social media or the internet or via any publication in whatever

format or via any other written or electronic format. Members' attention is drawn to the BSPS Social Media and Internet Policy set out in the back of the BSPS Handbook.

- 14. **Rule 70** Members are responsible for the actions of any non-members who are Family Members (as defined below) or who are friends or friends of Family Members or who are employed by them or assisting, supporting or representing them or otherwise acting on their behalf and any action or conduct of such non-member which would be a breach of the Rules were he a Member shall constitute a breach of the Rules by the Member concerned. Family Member shall include a spouse or civil partner, a partner, a direct descendant or ascendant of the Member or his spouse or civil partner, brothers, sisters or adopted children of the Member or his spouse or civil partner, or any other person who is part of the same household as the Member or is in the reasonable opinion of the BSPS a member of the Member's family in the widest sense.
- 15. The BSPS Scottish Branch/Board of Directors reserve the right to move, change, amalgamate or divide any class, championship or supreme as they deem fit when necessary to facilitate The running of the show. It is therefore the competitor's responsibility to keep up to date with any changes which may occur during the running of the show. Supreme of Show will be judged after all sections have been concluded.

RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY FOR QUALIFIERS

BRITISH SHOW PONY SOCIETY CLASSES

This Show is affiliated to the BSPS and all persons entering, competing, showing or otherwise taking part in BSPS classes, whether or not members of the BSPS are subject to the constitution and Rules of the BSPS, including the disciplinary procedures, and shall be deemed to have consented to the jurisdiction of the BSPS.

This Show is a qualifier for the 2019 BSPS Championships Show to be held at Arena UK. The 1st and 2nd prize winners only in Classes 1-6, 12-13, 41-44, 47–50 & 57 and the 1st, 2nd and 3rd prize winners in the Open Intermediate SRT (inc Mixed height), W.H & SHT, CS and Heritage classes the 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th prize winners in mixed height classes will qualify for the BSPS Championships provided the animal is registered in accordance with Rules 21 and 26 and ridden by a BSPS member.

RULE 21. Ponies must be registered before the date of the Show at which they qualify for the BSPS Summer and Winter Championships, except in the case of exhibitors who have never been members before who are allowed 7 days in which to become members and register their ponies (see Rule 5)

RULE 26. Owners, Riders and Ponies must be registered BEFORE the date of the Show at which they qualify for the BSPS Summer and Winter Championships, except in the case of exhibitors who have never been members before who are allowed 7 days in which to become members and register their ponies. This Rule does not apply to classes with RIHS or Olympia qualification.

THE BLUE RIBAND PONY OF THE YEAR

This Show is a qualifier for the BSPS Blue Riband Pony of the Year, the 1st and 2nd prize winners in the Lead Rein, First Ridden OR Open Show Pony OR Open Working Hunter Pony OR Open Show Hunter Pony OR Open Intermediate WH, SRT and SH classes will qualify. Classes are open to both members & non-members. **To qualify for the Blue Riband (members only) an armband MUST BE WORN.**

THE BSPS CLASSIC SECURITY (UK) LTD CHALLENGE

This Show is a qualifier for the BSPS Classic Security (UK) Ltd Challenge. Animals competing in the following Open classes will qualify: - Open Lead Rein, First Ridden, Lead Rein Hunter Type, Show Pony, SHP, Cradle and Nursery Stakes, WHP, Intermediate SH, SRT and WH and Open Heritage Lead Rein, First Ridden, Ridden and WHP classes.

THE BSPS PREMIER LEAGUE

This Show is a qualifier for the BSPS Premier League. Animals competing in the following classes will qualify:
- Lead Rein, First Ridden, Lead Rein of Hunter Type, Show Pony, SHP, Cradle Stakes, Nursery Stakes, WHP, Intermediate SH, SRT and WH and Heritage Lead Rein, First Ridden, Ridden and WHP Classes.

THE BSPS BINKS FAMILY 50TH YEAR GOLDEN ANNIVERSARY SHOW CHAMPIONS OF CHAMPIONS

This show is a qualifier for the BSPS Binks Family Champion of Champions the 1st prize winners in the following classes will qualify:- Open Lead Rein, First Ridden, Lead Rein of Hunter Type, Show Pony, SHP, WHP, Intermediate SH, SRT and WH and Open Heritage Lead Rein, First Ridden, Ridden and WHP classes.

THE BSPS BLACK COUNTRY SADDLES BEST RIDER

This Show is a qualifier for the Black Country Saddles Best Rider of the Year. The Best Rider in the Open Lead Rein, First Ridden, Open Lead Rein of Hunter Type, 128cms, 138cms and 148cms Show Pony, the 122cms, 133cms, 143cms and 153cms SHP, the Cradle and Nursery Stakes, the 133cms, 143cms and 153cms WHP, the Intermediate Show Riding Type, Show Hunter, Working Hunter classes and Open Heritage Lead Rein and First Ridden and to the best rider 25 years and under in the Heritage Ridden and WHP classes will receive a Card and qualify for the final at the BSPS Summer Championships Show.

THE BSPS "BEST OF THE BEST" SUPREME CHAMPIONSHIP

The Supreme Champion will be selected from the Champion Show Pony, Show Hunter Pony, WHP, Heritage Ridden and the Heritage WHP. To be eligible for qualification animals must be registered, owned and ridden with the BSPS and must be members of the relevant Area to compete in their area Supreme Championship.

SCOTTISH SHOW PONY, SHOW HUNTER PONY, WORKING HUNTER PONY & HERITAGE RIDDEN & WHP CHAMPIONSHIPS

The highest placed Scottish Ponies (Registered, Owned, Ridden, Produced by Scottish Branch Members) from all Show Pony, Show Hunter Pony, Working Hunter Pony, Heritage M & M Ridden & Working Hunter Pony classes, including Open & Novice, Intermediates, Lead Rein & First Ridden, Advanced Nursery, Nursery Stakes and Cradle Stakes will qualify for the above finals which will be judged in a suitable ring at the end of the day. In Mixed Type classes competitors will contest their relevant type championship.

SCOTTISH WHP CHAMPIONSHIP

The first four prizewinners in Classes 40-43 will qualify to compete in the Scottish WHP Championship to be held at the BSPS Scotland's Finale **Saturday 14th September 2019 at Morris EC.**

BSPS REGISTRATION AND MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS

Owners and riders must be BSPS Members and pony registered with the BSPS to qualify in classes with BLUE RIBAND, and animals must be registered with the BSPS. Membership forms and payment must be received in the office no later than the last working day (Monday to Friday) prior to the date of the qualifying show (see Rule 20). At this show, this includes all Open Show Pony classes, Open Show Hunter Pony Classes Open Intermediate classes, Lead Rein and First Ridden classes, Open Working Hunter Pony classes. **THOSE WISHING TO QUALIFY MUST WEAR AN ARMBAND.**

NPS Scotland Finals (Blair Castle) Rules 2019

TO BE RUN UNDER NPS SCOTLAND FINALS (BLAIR CASTLE) RULES 2019 which are on the NPS Scotland website www.npsscotland.co.uk These rules clarify areas particular to NPS Scotland. We also run to the Rules of the NPS and again these can be found on our website.

Exhibitors are deemed to be conversant with these rules.

- Ponies may only qualify **once** for each NPS Scotland Competition Final.
- 1b Ponies that take a second qualifier for the same section **will be disqualified** from entering the final.
- 1c <u>It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to ensure that their jockey/handler is aware of their pony's qualification status</u>
- All Mountain & Moorland Ponies must be registered in the <u>main body</u> of their respective stud book. Part bred, X registered ponies, ponies in the appendices of their main stud book and Eriskay ponies are not eligible.
- 3. Qualification in the M & M In-Hand Section may go Champion, Reserve Champion and 1st Reserve Champion. This excludes the NPS Scotland Spring and Summer Shows where 1st and 2nd prize winners will qualify.
 - Qualification for M&M Novice, Open, WHP, Lead Rein, First Ridden and Riding pony/Hunter pony classes may go to no lower than 4th place.
- 4. <u>A Judge is not obliged to award an NPS Scotland Finals qualification if he/she feels that the pony is not of a sufficient standard</u>
- **5.** Cavasson nosebands are the only nosebands permitted in flat ridden class
- 6. NPS Scotland Kilmannan Novice Ridden

Ponies can compete as novices in this competition for two consecutive years provided, they do not submit an entry to the final in the first year.

7. Entries will only be accepted via our on-line entry system, Entry Master

It is the exhibitor's responsibility to keep the qualification card safely as it is essential to complete your entry. Paper entries will not be accepted.

8. Closing Dates for Entries

Wednesday 31st July 2019 for all shows prior to that date. Shows from 1st to 5th August – the closing date is 8th August

Please refer to NPS Scotland website for directions on" **How to submit your entry**" on the Entry Master

- 9. The <u>OWNER</u> must be or become a member of NPS Scotland to enter the Finals.
- 10. All ridden ponies must be shown off the lead rein except in the specified Lead Rein Qualifier Class.
- 11. In Mountain and Moorland classes riders of stallions must be 12 years old or over when riding small breeds (Shetland, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Welsh A & B). For large breeds (Highland, Fell, Dales, Connemara, New Forest, Welsh C & D) riders of stallions must be 14 years old or over.
- 12. A child must have attained their 12th birthday as of the 1st January in the current year to either strip or lunge pony at an NPS show, except for stallions where age will same as in the Rule Book to ride a stallion.
- 13. Handlers of stallions or colts must be 14 years old or over.
- 14. Handlers of ponies in In Hand classes aged 14 years and under must wear a correctly secured skull caps/riding hat that meets the current standards.
- 15. The Finals will take place at the Blair Castle International Horse Trials on Friday 23rd August 2019

Qualification will be from placings, no qualification cards will be awarded in the ring, and no qualification can go down the line. Qualification is for the Horse & Pony except for Adult/Young Handler classes, where the Handler qualifies.
