RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. This Show is Affiliated to the British Show Pony Society and all persons entering, competing, showing or otherwise taking part in the B.S.P.S. Classes, whether or not Members of the B.S.P.S. are subject to the Constitution and Rules of the B.S.P.S., including disciplinary procedures, and shall be deemed to have consented to the jurisdiction of the B.S.P.S.
2. Neither the BSPS Scottish Branch Committee, nor any of its Officers, Servants, or Assistants shall be responsible or accountable for any loss, injury or damage to any person, animal, or property in connection with this Show.
3. Each Exhibitor shall abide by and accept as final the decision of the Judges, Referees, Chief Steward and Officials of the Show.
4. The Judges listed in the Schedule have accepted our invitation to Judge, but the Committee reserve the right to appoint substitutes should any Judge withdraw.
5. No Exhibitor may knowingly show a pony under a Judge in circumstances that would constitute a breach of Rule 477 by the Judge.
6. Any pony taking part in Classes judged under B.S.P.S. Rules will be liable to dope testing.
7. Entries will not be accepted without the appropriate fee. An S.A.E. must be submitted with entries if a receipt is required. No numbers will be sent to Exhibitors prior to the Show. Competitors' numbers should be collected from the Secretary's Office on the Show Ground. Cheques and Postal Orders to be made payable to BSPS Scottish Branch Ltd. NO entries will be accepted over the telephone.
8. NO REFUND OF ENTRIES WILL BE MADE, except in the event of unforeseen cancellation of the Show, when a £5.00 levy will be deducted from each entry to cover Administration costs.
9. All Trophy winners must be members of BSPS. An ADULT must sign for the Trophy, and agree to return when requested by the BSPS Scotland, in a good, clean condition. All breakages will be charged for.
10. In ALL Classes, correctly secured British Standard Skull Caps/Riding Hats, numbers All PAS015, VG1, (BS)EN1384 2017, ASTM F1163 04a onwards, SNELL E2001, AS/NZS 3838 2003 onwards, MUST be worn by riders at all times when mounted. Hats should have a plain cover either Black, Navy Blue, Brown, Grey or Green. Velvet covers are encouraged.
BSPS SCOTLAND ACCEPTS NO RESPONSIBILITY FOR ANY INJURY ARISING FROM A FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THIS REGULATION. HAT CHECKS FOR COMPLIANCE WILL BE MADE.
11. Under no circumstances will entries be changed, substituted or amended once received.
13. Only animals entered in classes at the BSPS Scottish Branch Ltd Show may use the arenas for exercising.
14. Only tack permissible under BSPS rules may be used whilst mounted anywhere on the showground.
15. All those attending this show should conduct themselves and adhere to Rule 67 and Rule 70 of the BSPS Rule Book
Rule 67 – No Member of the BSPS shall conduct himself in a manner or be guilty of behavior which is derogatory to the character or prejudicial to the interests of the BSPS and in particular (but without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing) no Member shall behave in an offensive or abusive or unpleasant manner to any person at any show or at any other location where BSPS business is being transacted or via social media or the internet or via any publication in whatever format or via any other written or electronic format. Members' attention is drawn to the BSPS Social Media and Internet Policy set out in the back of the BSPS handbook.
Rule 70 – Members are responsible for the actions of any non-members who are Family Members (as defined below) or who are friends or friends of Family Members or who are employed by them or assisting, supporting or representing them or otherwise acting on their behalf and any action or conduct of such non-member which would be a breach of the Rules were he a Member shall constitute a breach of the Rules by the Member concerned. Family Member shall include a spouse or civil partner, a partner, a direct descendant or ascendant of the Member or his spouse or civil partner, brothers, sisters or adopted children of the Member or his Spouse or civil partner, or any other person who is part of the same household as the Member or is in the reasonable opinion of the BSPS a member of the Member's family in the widest sense.

AFFILIATIONS AND RULES

BRITISH SHOW PONY SOCIETY CLASSES

This Show is affiliated to the BSPS and all persons entering, competing, showing or otherwise taking part in BSPS classes, whether or not members of the BSPS are subject to the constitution and Rules of the BSPS, including the disciplinary procedures, and shall be deemed to have consented to the jurisdiction of the BSPS.

This Show is a qualifier for the 2017 BSPS Championships Show to be held at Arena UK. The 1st and 2nd prize winners only in Classes 1-6, 12-13, 41-44, 47-50 & 57 and the 1st, 2nd and 3rd prize winners in Classes Open Intermediate SRT (inc Mixed height), W.H & SHT, CS and Heritage classes the 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th prize winners in mixed height classes will qualify for the BSPS Championships provided the animal is registered in accordance with Rules 5 and 26 and ridden by a BSPS member.

RULE 5. *Exhibitors in qualifying positions, who have never been members of the BSPS are allowed 7 working days in which to become members and register their ponies. Please note this Rule does not apply to classes with HOYS, RIHS, Olympia or Blue Riband Qualifications.*

RULE 26. *Owners, Riders and Ponies must be registered BEFORE the date of the Show at which they qualify, except in the case of exhibitors who have never been members before who are allowed 7 days in which to become members and register their ponies. This Rule does not apply to classes with RIHS or Olympia qualification.*

THE BLUE RIBAND PONY OF THE YEAR

This Show is a qualifier for the BSPS Blue Riband of the Year, the 1st and 2nd prize winners in the Lead Rein, First Ridden or Open Show Pony or Open Show Hunter Pony or Open Working Hunter Pony or Intermediate WH, SRT and SH classes will qualify. Classes are open to both members & non-members. To qualify for the Blue Riband (members only) an armband MUST BE WORN.

BSPS CHALLENGE

This Show is a qualifier for the BSPS Challenge, the highest placed pony in Lead Rein, First Ridden, Open Show Pony, Lead Rein of Hunter Type, Open Show Hunter Pony, Cradle and Nursery Stakes, Open Working Hunter Pony and the Open Intermediate SRT, SH and WH classes that has not qualified for the 2017 Horse of the Year Show in the appropriate class, will qualify. If the highest placed pony has already qualified for the BSPS Challenge, the qualification will be awarded to the next eligible pony. If after qualifying for the BSPS Challenge a pony qualifies for the Horse of the Year Show it will forfeit its qualification for the BSPS Challenge.

BSPS PREMIER LEAGUE

This show is a qualifier for the BSPS Premier League, the 1st, 2nd 3rd and 4th placed ponies will qualify in the Lead Rein, First Ridden, Open SP, Lead Rein of Hunter Type, Open SHP, Cradle & Nursery Stakes, Open WHP, INT SRT, SH and WH, Open Heritage Lead Rein, Open Heritage First Ridden, Open Heritage Ridden and Open Heritage WHP classes, and all Mixed Height Open Classes.

BSPS CHAMPIONS OF CHAMPIONS

This Show is a qualifier for the BSPS Champion of Champions, the Champion 'Carrs BMW' Mini Show Pony, the Champion 'White Company' Mini WHP, the Champion 'Mitten Asbestos' Open Show Pony, the Champion 'Mitten Asbestos' Open WHP/WH, the Champion 'Mitten Asbestos' Intermediate, the Champion 'Mitten Asbestos' SHP, the Champion 'Mitten Asbestos' Mini Heritage, the Champion 'Mitten Asbestos' Ridden Heritage and the Champion 'Mitten Asbestos' Heritage Working Hunter Pony and in the Heritage Mixed Height/Breed classes the first prize winner will qualify.

BSPS BEST RIDER

This Show is a qualifier for the BSPS Best Rider of the Year. The Best Rider in the open Lead Rein, First Ridden, Open Lead Rein of Hunter Type, 128cms, 138cms and 148cms Open Show Pony, the 122cms, 133cms, 143cms and 153cms Open SHP, the Cradle and Nursery Stakes, the 133cms, 143cms and 153cms WHP, the Open Intermediate Show Riding Type, Show Hunter, Working Hunter classes and Open Heritage Lead Rein and First Ridden and to the best rider 25 years and under in the Heritage Ridden and WHP classes will receive a Card and qualify for the final at the BSPS Summer Championships Show.

THE BSPS "BEST OF THE BEST" SUPREME CHAMPIONSHIP

The Supreme Champion will be selected from the Champion Show Pony, Show Hunter Pony, WHP, Heritage Ridden and the Heritage WHP. To be eligible for qualification animals must be registered, owned and ridden with the BSPS and must be members of the relevant Area to compete in their area Supreme Championship.

SCOTTISH SHOW PONY, SHOW HUNTER PONY, WORKING HUNTER PONY & HERITAGE RIDDEN & WHP CHAMPIONSHIPS

The highest placed Scottish Ponies (Registered, Owned, Ridden, Produced by Scottish Branch Members) from all Show Pony, Show Hunter Pony, Working Hunter Pony, Heritage M & M Ridden & Working Hunter Pony classes, including Open & Novice, Intermediates, Lead Rein & First Ridden, Advanced Nursery, Nursery Stakes and Cradle Stakes will qualify for the above finals which will be judged in a suitable ring at the end of the day. In Mixed Type classes competitors will contest their relevant type championship.

SCOTTISH WHP CHAMPIONSHIP

The first four prizewinners in Classes 40-43 will qualify to compete in the Scottish WHP Championship to be held at the BSPS Scotland's Finale Saturday 15th September 2018 at Morris EC.

BSPS REGISTRATION AND MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS

Owners and riders must be BSPS Members and pony registered with the BSPS to qualify in classes with BLUE RIBAND. At this show, this includes all Open Show Pony classes, Open Show Hunter Pony Classes Open Intermediate classes, Lead Rein and First Ridden classes, Open Working Hunter Pony classes. THOSE WISHING TO QUALIFY MUST WEAR AN ARMBAND.



Caledonian Showing Championships

The Caledonian Showing Championships are now well established in the showing calendar and will once again give 2018 competitors the opportunity to compete at a top level Championship Final in Scotland.

Evening Performances, loads of bling and razzmatazz everything an end of season Championship should have!

This year's show will be held at
Highfield @ Howe, near Ladybank, Fife on 13/14 October 2018

This Show is a qualifier and every horse & pony placed 1st and 2nd in all Inhand, Ridden Showing classes (not fun classes) & Working Hunter/Pony classes will qualify to compete in any appropriate class at the Finals. Qualification will be from placings, no qualification cards will be awarded in the ring, and no qualification can go down the line. Qualification is for the Horse & Pony except for Adult/Young Handler classes, where the Handler qualifies.

All qualified horses and ponies will be listed on the Caledonian Showing Show's website www.caledonianchampionships.webs.com where you will also find a regularly updated list of qualifying shows as well as a wealth of other information.

NPS SCOTLAND RULES 2018

1. Ponies may only qualify once for each NPS Scotland Competition Final. Ponies that take a second qualifier for the same section will not be allowed to enter the final.
2. All Mountain & Moorland Ponies must be registered in the main body of their respective stud book. Part bred, X registered ponies, ponies in the appendices of their main stud book and Eriskays are not eligible.
3. Qualification in the M. & M In Hand Section may go to 3rd in the Championship.
All others may go to no lower than 4th place.
4. A Judge is not obliged to award an NPS Scotland Finals qualification if he/she feels that the pony is not of a sufficient standard
5. Novice Ponies
A pony is not eligible to compete if, before 1st January in the current year, it has done any of the following:
Won an open NPS affiliated mixed M&M Ridden class
Qualified for Horse of the Year Show, Olympia or RIHS Open M&M Ridden classes
Qualified for the M&M Novice or Intermediate Ridden final at the NPS Summer Championship show (N.B. Ponies can compete as novices in this competition for two consecutive years provided they do not submit an entry to the final in the first year).
If a pony qualifies for Horse of the Year Show, Olympia or RIHS in its second year it is immediately de-noviced and cannot compete in the Kilmannan or Picton Final.
Rider any age, except stallions (see rules).
Ponies must be shown in a snaffle bit.
A minimum of 6 ponies must be stripped in qualifying rounds. All ponies will be stripped in the Final.
6. Closing Dates for Entries:
Competitors qualifying at Shows held before Monday 4th June 2018 must send their qualifying cards and entries in by Thursday 28th June 2018.
Shows after 5th June 2018 adhere to a closing date of 1st August 2018 and Late Entries will NOT be accepted. Competitors that qualify at late shows after the 1st August 2018 are required to email the secretary and send in the qualifying cards within 3 days of the show.
7. Cavasson nosebands are the only nosebands permitted in flat ridden classes.
8. Entry for the Finals can only be made by sending the official card duly signed by the Judge at the time of qualifying with your entry form.
9. The OWNER must be or become a member of NPS Scotland before entering the Finals.
10. All ridden ponies must be shown off the lead rein except in the specified Lead Rein Qualifier Class.
11. In Mountain and Moorland classes riders of stallions must be 12 years old or over when riding small breeds (Shetland, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Welsh A & B). For large breeds (Highland, Fell, Dales, Connemara, New Forest, Welsh C & D) riders of stallions must be 14 years old or over.
12. A child must have attained their 12th birthday as of the 1st January in the current year to either strip or lunge pony at a NPS show, except for stallions where age will same as in the Rule Book to ride a stallion.
13. Handlers of stallions or colts must be 14 years old or over.
14. Handlers of ponies in In Hand classes aged 14 years and under must wear a correctly secured skull caps/riding hat that meets the current standards.
15. The Final will take place at the Blair Castle International Horse Trials on Friday 24th August 2018.
