COVID 19 RULES AND GUIDELINES

BSPS SCOTLAND EXPECTS EACH MEMBER/EXHIBITOR TO TAKE PERSONAL RESPONSIBILITY FOR NOT SPREADING THE VIRUS AND OBEYING ALL RULES REGARDING SOCIAL DISTANCING. FAILURE TO DO SO WILL RESULT IN YOU BEING ASKED TO LEAVE THE SHOWGROUND AND ANY RIDER WILL BE ELIMINATED FROM THEIR CLASS

DO NOT ATTEND IF YOU ARE DISPLAYING THE CORONAVIRUS SYMPTOMS

Social distance from members other than your family group by 2 meters

Use hand sanitisers on regular basis.

Wash hands thoroughly after any contact with facilities.

Use lorry toilets where possible to minimise the risk.

Obey orders given by BSPS Scotland Officials regarding social distancing.

Wear face masks and gloves wherever possible to avoid spreading the virus.

Temperature checks MAY be taken during the show.

IN ADVANCE OF THE DAY OF SHOW

- 1. Only pre-entries will be accepted for this show. **NO ENTRIES ON THE DAY.** This will help reduce numbers in the office, enable effective timetabling and where necessary, restrict entries and enable us to track and trace all those who attend the event.
- 2. All show organisers and helpers will wear appropriate PPE equipment.
- 3. There will be a maximum of 3 people, **including** the rider, per rider/pony combination, who are not subject to social distancing, allowed to attend the Show. A **PARENT/GUARDIAN** must attend to accompany any child under the age of 18 years.
- 4. BSPS Scotland has appointed Helen Outram and Peter Page as their Covid-19 Officer's.
- 5. MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC WILL NOT BE ADMITTED TO SHOWGROUND.

DAY OF SHOW

This guidance must be adhered to by all Competitors, Stewards, Judges and BSPS Scotland Officials attending the show.

- 1. Competitors numbers will be available from the Secretary's Office on the day of the Show.
- 2. All cars and lorries must be parked with an adequate distance in accordance with social distancing as indicated by the parking attendant.
- 3. Limited stabling will be available by contacting Champfleurie Stables directly.
- 4. Hand sanitisers will be available around the site. Exhibitors should use these frequently and wash their hands to stop the spread of virus.
- 5. First Aid Cover will be available during the show. In the event of an accident only the designated first aid official and those accompanying the rider who are not subject to social distancing, will attend to the incident.

SHOWING GUIDELINES

- 1. The collecting ring and warm up area will be supervised, and all exhibitors must adhere to the instructions of the Steward in attendance.
- 2. Only one person can accompany a pony/rider combination in the collecting ring. Hand sanitiser must be used before and after handling any equipment.
- 3. Ponies should only enter the show ring when called.
- 4. Ponies in the line-up must be at least 3 metres apart, please follow the instructions of the Steward.
- 5. If a judge chooses to use an official BSPS mark sheet during a class, they will not be available on the day of the Show but will be published online after the show.
- 6. Competitors are requested to leave the showground as soon as possible when they have finished their classes.

RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1. This Show is affiliated to the British Show Pony Society and all persons entering, competing, showing or otherwise taking part in the B.S.P.S. Classes, whether or not Members of the B.S.P.S. are subject to the Constitution and Rules of the B.S.P.S., including disciplinary procedures, and shall be deemed to have consented to the jurisdiction of the B.S.P.S.
- 2. Neither the BSPS Scottish Branch Committee, nor any of its Officers, Servants, or Assistants shall be responsible or accountable for any loss, injury or damage to any person, animal, or property in connection with this Show.
- 3. Each Exhibitor shall abide by and accept as final the decision of the Judges, Referees, Chief Steward and Officials of the Show.
- 4. The Judges listed in the Schedule have accepted our invitation to Judge, but the Committee reserve the right to appoint substitutes should any Judge withdraw.
- 5. No Exhibitor may knowingly show a pony under a Judge in circumstances that would constitute a breach of **Rule 477** by the Judge.
- 6. Any pony taking part in Classes judged under B.S.P.S. Rules will be liable to dope testing.
- 7. Entries will not be accepted without the appropriate fee.
- 8. In ALL Classes, correctly secured British Standard Skull Caps/Riding Hats, numbers All PAS015, VG1, (BS) EN1384 2017, ASTM F1163 04a onwards, SNELL E2001, SNELL E2016 AS/NZS 3838 2003 onwards, MUST be worn by riders at all times when mounted. Hats should have a plain cover either Black, Navy Blue, Brown, Grey or Green. Velvet covers are encouraged. BSPS SCOTLAND ACCEPTS NO RESPONSIBILITY FOR ANY INJURY ARISING FROM A FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THIS REGULATION. HAT CHECKS FOR COMPLIANCE WILL BE MADE.
- 9. Under no circumstances will entries be changed, substituted, or amended once received.
- 10. Only animals entered in classes at the BSPS Scotland Tiny Toys & Novice Flat Show 2021 may use the arenas for exercising.

- 11. Only tack permissible under BSPS rules may be used whilst mounted anywhere on the showground.
- 12. **Rule 67** No member of the BSPS shall conduct himself in a manner or be guilty of behavior which is derogatory to the character or prejudicial to the interests of the BSPS and in particular (but without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing) no Member shall behave in an offensive or abusive or unpleasant matter to any person at any show or at any other location where BSPS business is being transacted or via social media or the internet or via any publication in whatever format or via any other written or electronic format. Members' attention is drawn to the BSPS Social Media and Internet Policy set out in the back of the BSPS Handbook.
- 13. **Rule 70** Members are responsible for the actions of any non-members who are Family Members (as defined below) or who are friends or friends of Family Members or who are employed by them or assisting, supporting or representing them or otherwise acting on their behalf and any action or conduct of such non-member which would be a breach of the Rules were he a Member shall constitute a breach of the Rules by the Member concerned. Family Member shall include a spouse or civil partner, a partner, a direct descendant or ascendant of the Member or his spouse or civil partner, brothers, sisters or adopted children of the Member or his spouse or civil partner, or any other person who is part of the same household as the Member or is in the reasonable opinion of the BSPS a member of the Member's family in the widest sense.
- 14. The BSPS Scottish Branch/Board of Directors reserve the right to move, change, amalgamate or divide any class or championship as they deem fit when necessary, to facilitate the running of the show. It is therefore the competitor's responsibility to keep up to date with any changes which may occur during the running of the show. There will be no Supreme of Show held at this Show.
- 15. **Rule 60a EQUINE INFLUENZA** All pony/horses competing in BSPS Scotland Spring Show must abide by Rule 60a Equine Influenza and Tetanus vaccinations are a compulsory requirement for all pony/horses registered with the BSPS. The requirement for the first 3 vaccinations is as follows: The first 2 vaccinations 21 92 days apart, a third booster between 150 215 days, and an annual booster vaccination within 365 days thereafter. No horse should enter competitions within 7 days of an El vaccination. This rule may be subject to change from guidance from the FEI/BEF and any changes will be notified via the www.bsps.com website. The current FEI ruling is for a 6 monthly booster as opposed to annual; therefore, it is recommended that you check with the shows that fall under FEI regulation before entering e.g. Windsor, Hickstead etc.

RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY FOR QUALIFIERS

BRITISH SHOW PONY SOCIETY CLASSES

This Show is affiliated to the BSPS and all persons entering, competing, showing or otherwise taking part in BSPS classes, whether or not members of the BSPS are subject to the constitution and Rules of the BSPS, including the disciplinary procedures, and shall be deemed to have consented to the jurisdiction of the BSPS.

This Show is a qualifier for the 2021 BSPS Championships Show to be held at Arena UK. The 1st and 2nd prize winners Open LR, FR, SP, NS and the 1st, 2nd and 3rd prize winners in Classes Open Intermediate SRT (including Mixed height), W.H & SHT, CS the 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th prize winners in mixed height classes will qualify for the BSPS Championships provided the animal is registered in accordance with Rules 5 and 21 and ridden by a BSPS member.

RULE 5. Exhibitors in qualifying positions, who have never been members of the BSPS are allowed 7 working days in which to become members and register their ponies. Please note this Rule does not apply to classes with HOYS, RIHS, Olympia or Blue Riband Qualifications.

RULE 21. Owners, Riders and Ponies must be registered BEFORE the date of the Show at which they qualify for the BSPS Summer and Winter Championships, except in the case of exhibitors who have never been members before who are allowed 7 days in which to become members and register their ponies. (see Rule 5).

RULE 26. Owners, Riders and Ponies must be registered BEFORE the date of the Show at which they qualify for the BSPS Summer and Winter Championships, except in the case of exhibitors who have never been members before who are allowed 7 days in which to become members and register their ponies. This Rule does not apply to classes with RIHS or Olympia qualification.

B.S.P.S. QUALIFICATION

The 1st, 2nd & 3rd prize-winners will qualify in the Novice Classes and Open First Pony of Show Pony or Show Hunter Pony Type Class and in the MIXED HEIGHT NOVICE CLASSES the 1st, 2nd, 3rd & 4th prize winners will qualify.

In the Open Classes the three highest placed Restricted animals in each class will qualify, and in the MIXED HEIGHT OPEN CLASSES the four highest placed Restricted animals will qualify,

(riders on Restricted animals MUST wear an armband).

Animals must be registered before the date of the Show at which they qualify for the Winter Championships and must be ridden by B.S.P.S. Members, except in the case of exhibitors who have never been members before who are allowed 7 days in which to become members and register their ponies.

Animals must NOT have been placed 1st to 8th at the RIHS (except Pretty Polly) or HOYS or in the relevant classes in 2019/2020/2021. Please note that this Rule does not apply to classes with HOYS, RIHS, Olympia or Blue Riband Qualifications. All Rules as per the 2021 BSPS Rule and Show Handbook

THE BSPS CLASSIC SERVICES GROUP CHALLENGE

This show is a qualifier for the BSPS Classic Services Group Challenge. Animals competing in the following Open Classes will qualify: - Open Lead Rein, First Ridden, Lead Rein Hunter Type, Show Pony, SHP, Cradle and Nursery Stakes, WHP, Intermediate SH, SRT and WH and Open Heritage Lead Rein, First Ridden, Ridden and WHP classes. Ponies must not have qualified for the 2020 Horse of the Year Show. If a pony qualified for the Horse of the Year Show it will forfeit its qualification for the Classic Services Group Challenge.

THE BSPS BINKS FAMILY CHAMPION OF CHAMPIONS

This show is a qualifier for the BSPS Binks Family Champion of Champions the 1st prize winners in the following classes will qualify:- Open Lead Rein, First Ridden, Lead Rein of Hunter Type, Show Pony, SHP, WHP, Intermediate SH, SRT and WH and Open Heritage Lead Rein, First Ridden, Ridden and WHP classes.

THE BSPS BLACK COUNTRY SADDLES BEST AREA RIDER QUALIFIER

This Show is a qualifier for the Black Country Saddles Best Rider of the Year. The Best Rider in the Open Lead Rein, First Ridden, Open Lead Rein of Hunter Type, 128cms, 138cms and 148cms Show Pony, the 122cms, 133cms, 143cms and 153cms SHP, the Cradle and Nursery Stakes, the 133cms, 143cms and 153cms WHP, the Intermediate Show Riding Type, Show Hunter, Working Hunter classes and Open Heritage Lead Rein and First Ridden and to the best rider 25 years and under in the Heritage Ridden and WHP classes will receive a Card and qualify for the Black Country Saddles Best Area Rider Championship being held at this show.

Every horse & pony placed 1st and 2nd in all Inhand, Ridden Showing classes (not fun classes) & Working Hunter/Pony classes will qualify to compete in any appropriate class at the Finals. All Champions & Reserves will qualify for the Champion & Reserves Stakes Finals. Qualification will be from placings, no qualification cards will be awarded in the ring, and no qualification can go down the line. All qualified horses and ponies will be listed on the Caledonian Showing Championship Show's website www.caledonianchampionships.webs.com (and soon to come www.caledonianchampionships.co.uk) where you will also find a regularly updated list of qualifying shows and a wealth of other information. **should there not be enough qualifying shows this year, contingency plans are in place to run as an Open Show with special recognition for those who have qualified**

Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 138cm and not exceeding 148cms. Riders not to have attained their 17th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

CLASS 3 THE BSPS OPEN SHOW PONY – 138CMS

Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 128cms and not exceeding 138cms. Riders not to have attained their 15th Birthday before 1st January in the current year.

CLASS 4 THE BSPS OPEN SHOW PONY – 128CMS

Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 128cms. Riders not to have attained their 13th Birthday before 1st January in the current year.

CLASS 5 THE BSPS MIXED HEIGHT NOVICE SHOW HUNTER PONY

Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 153cms. Riders must be the correct age for the pony they ride.

CLASS 6 THE BSPS OPEN CLASS FOR PONY OF SHOW HUNTER TYPE – 153CMS

Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 143cms and not exceeding 153cms. Riders not to have attained their 20th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

CLASS 7 THE BSPS OPEN CLASS FOR PONY OF SHOW HUNTER TYPE - 143CMS

Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 133cms and not exceeding 143cms. Riders not to have attained their 17th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

CLASS 8 THE BSPS OPEN CLASS FOR PONY OF SHOW HUNTER TYPE – 133CMS

Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 122cms and not exceeding 133cms. Riders not to have attained their 14th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

CLASS 9 THE BSPS OPEN CLASS FOR PONY OF SHOW HUNTER TYPE - 122CMS

Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 122cms. Riders not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

CLASS 29 YOUNG HANDLERS – 5 to 8 YEARS OF AGE

Mare or gelding 4 years old or over, any height. Handlers 5 to 8 years of age. Handler to be judged purely on handler skills and not conformation. Not eligible for Supreme of Show.

CLASS 30 BEST COMBINATION – LEAD REIN

Mare of gelding 4 years old or over, plaited or Heritage Mountain & Moorland, Rider aged 8 years of age or under.

CLASS 31 BEST COMBINATION – 12 YEARS OF AGE OR UNDER

Mare of gelding 4 years old or over, plaited or Heritage Mountain & Moorland, Rider aged 12 years of age or under.

CLASS 32 BEST COMBINATION – TINY TOTS
