BSPS Ridden Tiny Tots Classes

These classes are open to both members & non members. All ponies in this section must be shown in a snaffle bridle. These classes are open to Show Ponies, Show Hunter Ponies & Pure bred Mountain & Moorland ponies. No balance, grass or side reins may be used

CLASS 1 TEENY TINY TOTS LEAD REIN (walk only)

- Mare or gelding, 4 years old or over, any type of pony not exceeding 128cm. This class will be a walk only class
- Riders aged 5 years of age or under.
- Leaders must be 16 years and over
- Leading Rein is to be attached onto the noseband. A handle on the saddle is permitted.

CLASS 2 THE BSPS TINY TOTS LEAD REIN PONY

- Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 122cm.
- Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have their 5th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Riders must be over 3yrs in this class.
- The handler must be 16 years or over
- The lead rein must be attached to the noseband. Handles on the saddle are allowed

CLASS 3 THE BSPS TINY TOTS WALK & TROT

- Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 128cm.
- Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have their 9th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Riders must be over 3yrs in this class.
- This class will be walk & trot only. There will be no change of rein on the go round.

CLASS 4 THE BSPS TINY TOTS FIRST RIDDEN PONY

- Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 128cms.
- Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 9th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Riders must be over 3yrs in this class.
- On the go round ponies will not be asked to change the rein.
- In their individual shows ponies will be expected to walk up, trot back, cantering is optional but no figure of eight or change of rein is required.
- The judge will be looking for a pony suitable to take its rider safely off the lead rein at all times

CLASS 5 THE BSPS TINY TOTS RIDDEN PONY

- Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 128cm.
- Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have their 10th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Riders must be over 3yrs in this class.
- Ponies will be asked to canter in their individual show only.

SHOW PONIES MINIS

These classes are open to both members & non members. Ponies to be shown plaited with velvet browbands. Riders would usually wear a navy show jacket. No balance, grass or side reins may be used

CLASS 6 THE BSPS OPEN LEAD REIN PONY

- Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 122cms.
- Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 8th birthday before 1st of January in the current year. Riders must be over 3yrs in this class
- The leading rein must be attached onto the noseband. Leaders to be 16yrs or over.

CLASS 7 THE BSPS OPEN FIRST RIDDEN PONY

- Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 122cms.
- Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 10th birthday before 1st of January in the current year. Riders must be over 3yrs in this class.
- There is no cantering on the go round.

1st & 2nd place winners from this section are invited to come forward

Champion & Reserve are eligible for Supreme of Show

SHOW HUNTER MINI PONIES

These classes are open to both members & non members. Ponies to be shown plaited with plain browbands and a snaffle bridle. Riders would usually wear a tweed show jacket. No balance, grass or side reins may be used

CLASS 8 THE BSPS OPEN LEAD REIN PONY OF SHOW HUNTER TYPE

- Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 122cms.
- Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 9th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Riders must be over 3yrs in this class
- This is NOT a handy pony competition but in their individual shows ponies may be asked to negotiate a small obstacle.
- The leading rein must be attached onto the noseband. Leaders to be 16yrs or over.

CLASS 9 THE BSPS OPEN FIRST PONY OF SHOW HUNTER TYPE

- Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 122cms.
- Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 10th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Riders must be over 3yrs in this class.
- No cantering except for individual performance. Ponies must leave the ring at walk or trot.

ENTRANTS ON THE DAY WILL NOT BE GIVEN ACCESS TO A CLASS WITHOUT AN ENTRY SLIP – PLEASE ENSURE THAT THE SLIPS ISSUED TO YOU ARE HANDED TO THE STEWARD WHEN ENTERING THE RING

RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. This Show is affiliated to the British Show Pony Society and all persons entering, competing, showing or otherwise taking part in the B.S.P.S. Classes, whether or not Members of the B.S.P.S. are subject to the Constitution and Rules of the B.S.P.S., including disciplinary procedures, and shall be deemed to have consented to the jurisdiction of the B.S.P.S.
2. Neither the BSPS Scottish Branch Committee, nor any of its Officers, Servants, or Assistants shall be responsible or accountable for any loss, injury or damage to any person, animal, or property in connection with this Show.
3. Each Exhibitor shall abide by and accept as final the decision of the Judges, Referees, Chief Steward and Officials of the Show.
4. The Judges listed in the Schedule have accepted our invitation to Judge, but the Committee reserve the right to appoint substitutes should any Judge withdraw.
5. No Exhibitor may knowingly show a pony under a Judge in circumstances that would constitute a breach of Rule 477 by the Judge.
6. Any pony taking part in Classes judged under B.S.P.S. Rules will be liable to dope testing.
7. Entries will not be accepted without the appropriate fee. An S.A.E. must be submitted with entries if a receipt is required. No numbers will be sent to Exhibitors prior to the Show. Competitors' numbers should be collected from the Secretary's Office on the Show Ground. Cheques and Postal Orders to be made payable to BSPS Scottish Branch Ltd. NO entries will be accepted over the telephone.
8. In **ALL Classes**, correctly secured British Standard Skull Caps/Riding Hats, numbers All PAS015, VG1, (BS) EN1384 2017, ASTM F1163 04a onwards, SNELL E2001, SNELL E2016 AS/NZS 3838 2003 onwards, MUST be worn by riders at all times when mounted. Hats should have a plain cover either Black, Navy Blue, Brown, Grey or Green. Velvet covers are encouraged.
BSPS SCOTLAND ACCEPTS NO RESPONSIBILITY FOR ANY INJURY ARISING FROM A FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THIS REGULATION. HAT CHECKS FOR COMPLIANCE WILL BE MADE.
9. Under no circumstances will entries be changed, substituted or amended once received.
10. Only animals entered in classes at this show may use the arenas for exercising
11. Only tack permissible under BSPS rules may be used whilst mounted anywhere on the showground
12. On the day entries will be taken from 8am
13. **Rule 67** - No member of the BSPS shall conduct himself in a manner or be guilty of behaviour which is derogatory to the character or prejudicial to the interests of the BSPS and in particular (but without prejudice to the generality

of the foregoing) no Member shall behave in an offensive or abusive or unpleasant matter to any person at any show or at any other location where BSPS business is being transacted or via social media or the internet or via any publication in whatever format or via any other written or electronic format. Members' attention is drawn to the BSPS Social Media and Internet Policy set out in the back of the BSPS Handbook.

- 14 Rule 70** – Members are responsible for the actions of any non-members who are Family Members (as defined below) or who are friends or friends of Family Members or who are employed by them or assisting, supporting or representing them or otherwise acting on their behalf and any action or conduct of such non-member which would be a breach of the Rules were he a Member shall constitute a breach of the Rules by the Member concerned. - 16.** Rule 49a Body protectors MUST be worn when jumping in any WHP and WH classes including practice ring at BSPS Affiliated Shows. (including Tiny Tots, Cradle, Nursery, Stakes, WSP, LRWSP and Training stakes) Riders must wear a body protector when working in (practice jumps) and the jumping phase in all BSPS organised and affiliated events.

BSPS MEMBERS SHOULD ENSURE THAT THEIR PONY REGISTRATION AND MEMBERSHIP CARDS ARE AVAILABLE TO VIEW IN THE RING IF REQUIRED BY A JUDGE OR STEWARD

RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY FOR BSPS WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP QUALIFIERS

B.S.P.S. QUALIFICATION

Novice – in the novice classes the 1st, 2nd and 3rd placed animals will qualify. In mixed height novice classes, the 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th placed ponies will qualify.

Open – in the open (restricted) the three highest placed Restricted animals will qualify. Riders on restricted animals MUST wear an armband when they enter the ring. In Mixed height Open (restricted) the four highest placed restricted animals will qualify

Animals must be registered before the date of the Show at which they qualify for the Winter Championships and must be ridden by B.S.P.S. Members, except in the case of exhibitors who have never been members before who are allowed 7 days in which to become members and register their ponies. **Animals must NOT have been placed 1st to 8th at the RIHS or HOYS or in the relevant classes in 2020/2021/2022.** Please note that this Rule does not apply to classes with HOYS, RIHS, Olympia or Blue Riband Qualifications. All Rules as per the 2022 BSPS Rule and Show Handbook.

RULE 5. Exhibitors in qualifying positions, who have never been members of the BSPS are allowed 7 working days in which to become members and register their ponies. Please note this Rule does not apply to classes with HOYS, RIHS, Olympia or Blue Riband Qualifications.

RULE 21. Owners, Riders and Ponies must be registered BEFORE the date of the Show at which they qualify, except in the case of exhibitors who have never been members before who are allowed 7 days in which to become members and register their ponies. This Rule does not apply to classes with RIHS or Olympia qualification.

Every horse & pony placed 1st in all Inhand, Ridden Showing classes (not fun classes) & Working Hunter/Pony classes will qualify to compete in any appropriate class at the Finals. All Champions & Reserves will qualify for the Champion & Reserves Stakes Finals. Qualification will be from placings, no qualification cards will be awarded in the ring, and no qualification can go down the line. Qualification is for the Horse & Pony except for Adult/Young Handler classes, where the Handler qualifies. All qualified horses and ponies will be listed on the Caledonian Showing Show's website www.caledonianchampionships.webs.com where you will also find a regularly updated list of qualifying shows and a wealth of other information.
