WINTER WORKER STAKES - Plaited & Heritage M&M

The winter worker stakes marks will be awarded on the following:

Jumping 70 Marks
Style whilst jumping 30 Marks
Conformation & Way of Going 20 Marks
Total Marks Awarded 120 Marks

The highest placed 3 ponies will qualify for the BSPS Winter Championships together with the highest placed junior rider. Ponies may compete in more than one height section.

CLASS 1 BSPS WINTER WORKER STAKES - 60CM

- Plaited or Heritage Mountain & Moorland ponies, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 158cm
- Riders of any age but must be suitably mounted for the animal they ride
- A special rosette will be presented to the highest placed child under 12 years of age on the day of the show who will also qualify for the BSPS Winter Championships

CLASS 2 BSPS WINTER WORKER STAKES – 70CM

- Plaited or Heritage Mountain & Moorland ponies, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 158cm
- Riders of any age but must be suitably mounted for the animal they ride
- A special rosette will be presented to the highest placed child under 14 years of age on the day of the show who will also qualify for the BSPS Winter Championships

CLASS 3 BSPS WINTER WORKER STAKES – 80CM

- Plaited or Heritage Mountain & Moorland ponies, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 158cm
- Riders of any age but must be suitably mounted for the animal they ride
- A special rosette will be presented to the highest placed rider under 18 years of age on the day of the show who will also qualify for the BSPS Winter Championships

CLASS 4 BSPS WINTER WORKER STAKES – 90CM

- Plaited or Heritage Mountain & Moorland ponies, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 158cm
- Riders of any age but must be suitably mounted for the animal they ride
- A special rosette will be presented to the highest placed rider under 18 years of age on the day of the show who will also qualify for the BSPS Winter Championships

CLASS 5 BSPS WINTER WORKER STAKES – 100CM

- Plaited or Heritage Mountain & Moorland ponies, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 158cm
- Riders of any age but must be suitably mounted for the animal they ride
- A special rosette will be presented to the highest placed rider under 25 years of age on the day of the show who will also qualify for the BSPS Winter Championships

1st & 2nd place winners from Class 1-5 are invited to come forward

NOVICE WORKING HUNTER PONIES

CLASS 6 BSPS NOVICE INTERMEDIATE WORKING HUNTER PONY (148-158cm)

- Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 158cms.
- Riders not to have attained their 25th birthday before 1st January in the current year.
- Max height of fences 1m.
- This class is not a winter championship qualifying class

CLASS 7 BSPS NOVICE WORKING HUNTER PONY (153cm)

- Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 153cms.
- Riders not to have attained their 20th birthday before 1st January in the current year.
- Max height of fences 95cm.
- This class is not a winter championship qualifying class

CLASS 8 BSPS NOVICE WORKING HUNTER PONY (143cm)

- Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 143cms.
- Riders not to have attained their 17th birthday before 1st January in the current year.
- Max height of fences 85cm.
- This class is not a winter championship qualifying class

CLASS 9 BSPS NOVICE WORKING HUNTER PONY (133cm)

- Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 133cms.
- Riders not to have attained their 14th birthday before 1st January in the current year
- Max height of fences 75cm.
- This class is not a winter championship qualifying class

BSPS Novice Working Hunter Pony Championship

1st & 2nd place holders from Class 6-9 are invited to come forward

OPEN (RESTRICTED) WHP SECTION

CLASS 10 BSPS WINTER OPEN (RESTRICTED) WORKING HUNTER (133cm)

- Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 133cms.
- Riders not to have attained their 14th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.
- Max height of fences 85cm.
- Animals must not have been placed 1st to 8th at the RIHS or HOYS in WHP classes in 2020/2021/2022.
- Riders on Restricted animals MUST wear an armband.

CLASS 11 BSPS WINTER OPEN (RESTRICTED) WORKING HUNTER PONY (143cm)

- Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 143cms.
- Riders not to have attained their 17th birthday before 1st January in the current year.
- Max height of fences 95cms.
- Animals must not have been placed 1st to 8th at the RIHS or HOYS in WHP classes in 2020/2021/2022.
- Riders on Restricted animals MUST wear an armband.

CLASS 12 BSPS WINTER OPEN (RESTRICTED) WORKING HUNTER PONY (153cm)

- Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 153cms.
- Riders not to have attained their 20th birthday before 1st January in the current year.
- Max height of fences 1m.
- Animals must not have been placed 1st to 8th at the RIHS or HOYS in WHP classes in 2020/2021/2022.
- Riders on Restricted animals MUST wear an armband

CLASS 13 BSPS WINTER OPEN (RESTRICTED) INTERMEDIATE WHP (148-158)

- Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 158cms.
- Riders not to have attained their 25th birthday before 1st January in the current year.
- Max height of fences 1m 5cm.
- Animals must not have been placed 1st to 8th at the RIHS or HOYS in WHP classes in 2020/2021/2022.
- Riders on Restricted animals MUST wear an armband.

BSPS Winter Open (Restricted) Working Hunter Pony Championship 1st & 2nd place winners from Class 10-13 are invited to come forward

OPEN MINI WORKING HUNTER PONIES

CLASS 14 BSPS WINTER OPEN CRADLE STAKES (NON-QUALIFIER) (122cm)

- Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 122cms.
- Riders not to have attained their 11th birthday before 1st January in the current year.
- Max height of fences 60cm

CLASS 15 BSPS WINTER OPEN (RESTRICTED) NURSERY STAKES (133cm)

- Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 133cms.
- Riders not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year.
- Max height of fences 70cm.
- Restricted animals must not have been placed 1st to 8th at the RIHS in 2020/2021/2022
- Riders on Restricted animals MUST wear an armband

Class 15a BSPS OPEN NURSERY STAKES CLASS (ROYAL HIGHLAND QUALIFIER)

- Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 133cm. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year
- Maximum height of fences 75cm
- This is a qualifier for the Royal Highland Show Nursery Stakes 2022. The first 4 placed same pony and rider combinations will qualify for the 2022 Royal Highland Show Nursery Stakes provided they have jumped a clear round. Qualification will only move down the line to the next eligible pony and rider combination meeting the qualification criteria. Qualification will be in accordance with Rule 37 of the BSPS Rule and Show Handbook. This class is open to both BSPS Members and non members.

- Riders on Restricted animals MUST wear an armband.

CLASS 37 BSPS WINTER "HERITAGE" OPEN (RESTRICTED) RIDDEN – Welsh C & Ds

- Registered pure-bred Welsh Section C and D Ponies, 4 years old or over.
- Riders any age.
- Restricted qualification Not to have been placed 1st to 8th at the RIHS (except Pretty Polly & Young Riders) or HOYS or Heritage M&M Ridden Supreme Championship in the relevant M&M Classes in 2020/2021/2022
- Riders on Restricted animals MUST wear an armband.

CLASS 38 BSPS WINTER "HERITAGE" OPEN (RESTRICTED) RIDDEN – New Forest & Connemara

- Registered pure bred New Forest and Connemara Ponies, 4 years old or over.
- Riders any age.
- Restricted qualification Not to have been placed 1st to 8th at the RIHS (except Pretty Polly & Young Riders) or HOYS or Heritage M&M Ridden Supreme Championship in the relevant M&M Classes in 2020/2021/2022
- Riders on Restricted animals MUST wear an armband.

CLASS 39 BSPS "HERITAGE" OPEN (RESTRICTED) RIDDEN – Fells Dales & Highlands

- Registered pure-bred Fells, Dales and Highland Ponies, 4 years old or over.
- Riders any age.
- Restricted qualification Not to have been placed 1st to 8th at the RIHS (except Pretty Polly & Young Riders) or HOYS or Heritage M&M Ridden Supreme Championship in the relevant M&M Classes in 2020/2021/2022
- Riders on Restricted animals MUST wear an armband.

- The leader must be over the age of 16
- The lead rein must be attached to the noseband
- This class is not a winter championship qualifying class

CLASS 41 BSPS NOVICE SHOW PONY FIRST RIDDEN

- Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 122cm.
- Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 10th birthday before 1st January in the current vear
- No cantering is allowed except for individual performances. Ponies should leave the ring at walk or trot
- This class is not a winter championship qualifying class

BSPS Winter Novice Mini Show Pony Championship

1st & 2nd place winners from Class 40-41 are invited to come forward

NOVICE INTERMEDIATE

CLASS 42 BSPS WINTER MIXED NOVICE INTERMEDIATE SHOW SRT/SH

- Open to horses and ponies 4 years old or over exceeding 146cms but not exceeding 158cms.
- Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained 25th birthday before 1st January in the current year.
- This class to incorporate Intermediate SRT and Intermediate SH.

BSPS Winter Mixed Novice Intermediate Show SRT/SH Championship Champion & Reserve will be awarded to the 1st and 2nd prize winners

OPEN MINI SHOW PONY

CLASS 43 BSPS OPEN SHOW PONY - LEAD REIN

- Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 122cms.
- Riders not to have attained their 8th birthday before the 1st of January in the current year.
- This class is not a winter championship qualifying class

CLASS 44 BSPS OPEN FIRST RIDDEN SHOW PONY

- Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 122cms.
- Riders not to have attained their 10th birthday before the 1st of January in the current year.
- This class is not a winter championship qualifying class

1st & 2nd place winners from Class 43-44 are invited to come forward

CLASS 45 BSPS WINTER NOVICE SHOW PONIES – MIXED HEIGHT

- Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 148cms. A snaffle bridle must be worn
- Competitors must be the right age for the height of pony they ride.
- There will be no championship for this class

CLASS 46 BSPS WINTER OPEN (RESTRICTED) INTERMEDIATE – MIXED HEIGHT

- Open to horses and ponies 4 years old or over exceeding 146cms but not exceeding 158cms.
- Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained 25th birthday before 1st Jan in the current year.
- This class to incorporate Intermediate SRT and Intermediate SH.
- Animals must not have been placed 1st to 8th at the RIHS or HOYS in*2020/2021/2022
- Riders on Restricted animals MUST wear an armband

BSPS Winter Open (Restricted) Intermediate Mixed Height Championship Champion & Reserve will be awarded to the 1st and 2nd prize winners

CLASS 47 BSPS WINTER OPEN (RESTRICTED) SHOW PONIES – MIXED HEIGHT

- Competitors must be the right age for the height of pony they ride.
- If there are significant numbers entered, the class may be split.
- Animals must not have been placed 1st to 8th at the RIHS or HOYS in*2020/2021/2022
- Riders on Restricted animals MUST wear an armband

- Snaffle bridles only
- This class is not a winter championship qualifying class

CLASS 49 BSPS NOVICE FIRST PONY OF SHOW HUNTER TYPE

- Mare or gelding 4 years old or over, not exceeding 122cm.
- Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 10th birthday before 1st January in the current year.
- Snaffle bridles only
- This class is not a winter championship qualifying class

CLASS 51 BSPS OPEN (RESTRICTED) LEAD REIN PONY OF HUNTER TYPE

- Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 122cms.
- Riders not to have attained their 9th birthday before 1st January in current year.
- Animals eligible for Restricted Lead Rein of Hunter Type Classes must not have placed 1st to 8th at the RIHS or HOYS 2020/2021/2022
- This class is not a winter championship qualifying class

CLASS 52 BSPS OPEN (RESTRICTED) FIRST PONY OF SHOW HUNTER TYPE

- Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 122cms.
- Riders not to have attained their 10th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.
- Snaffles bridles only.
- No cantering is allowed except in individual performance.
- Ponies must leave ring in walk or trot.
- This class is not a winter championship qualifying class

BSPS Winter Open (Restricted) Mini Show Hunter Pony Championship

1st & 2nd place from Class 51-52 are invited to come forward

OPEN SHOW HUNTER PONIES

CLASS 53 BSPS WINTER OPEN (RESTRICTED) SHOW HUNTER PONIES – MIXED HEIGHT

- Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 153cm
- Riders must be the correct age for the height of the animal they ride
- Animals eligible for Restricted SHP/SH must NOT have been placed 1st to 8th at the RIHS (Except Pretty Polly) or HOYS in the SHP/SH class in 2020/2021/2022
- Riders on Restricted animals MUST wear an armband

PART BRED PONIES

CLASS 54 RESTRICTED RIDDEN PART BRED PONY CLASS

- Riders any age except for those riding stallions who must have attained their 14th birthday before 1st January in the current year.
- Animals eligible for the Restricted part bred class must NOT have been placed 1st to 8th at the RIHS or HOYS in the Part bred classes in 2020/2021/2022

CLASS 55 RESTRICTED RIDDEN PART BRED PONY CLASS (WELSH & ARABS ONLY)

- Stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old or over exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 158cms.

- 1. This Show is affiliated to the British Show Pony Society and all persons entering, competing, showing or otherwise taking part in the B.S.P.S. Classes, whether or not Members of the B.S.P.S. are subject to the Constitution and Rules of the B.S.P.S., including disciplinary procedures, and shall be deemed to have consented to the jurisdiction of the B.S.P.S.
- 2. Neither the BSPS Scottish Branch Committee, nor any of its Officers, Servants, or Assistants shall be responsible or accountable for any loss, injury or damage to any person, animal, or property in connection with this Show.
- 3. Each Exhibitor shall abide by and accept as final the decision of the Judges, Referees, Chief Steward and Officials of the Show.
- 4. The Judges listed in the Schedule have accepted our invitation to Judge, but the Committee reserve the right to appoint substitutes should any Judge withdraw.
- 5. No Exhibitor may knowingly show a pony under a Judge in circumstances that would constitute a breach of Rule 477 by the Judge.
- 6. Any pony taking part in Classes judged under B.S.P.S. Rules will be liable to dope testing.
- 7. Entries will not be accepted without the appropriate fee. An S.A.E. must be submitted with entries if a receipt is required. No numbers will be sent to Exhibitors prior to the Show. Competitors' numbers should be collected from the Secretary's Office on the Show Ground. Cheques and Postal Orders to be made payable to BSPS Scottish Branch Ltd. NO entries will be accepted over the telephone.
- 8. In <u>ALL Classes</u>, correctly secured British Standard Skull Caps/Riding Hats, numbers All PAS015, VG1, (BS) EN1384 2017, ASTM F1163 04a onwards, SNELL E2001, SNELL E2016 AS/NZS 3838 2003 onwards, MUST be worn by riders at all times when mounted. Hats should have a plain cover either Black, Navy Blue, Brown, Grey or Green. Velvet covers are encouraged.

BSPS SCOTLAND ACCEPTS NO RESPONSIBILITY FOR ANY INJURY ARISING FROM A FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THIS REGULATION. HAT CHECKS FOR COMPLIANCE WILL BE MADE.

- 9. Under no circumstances will entries be changed, substituted or amended once received.
- 10. Only animals entered in classes at this show may use the arenas for exercising
- 11. Only tack permissible under BSPS rules may be used whilst mounted anywhere on the showground
- 12. On the day entries will be taken from 8am
- **13. Rule 67** No member of the BSPS shall conduct himself in a manner or be guilty of behaviour which is derogatory to the character or prejudicial to the interests of the BSPS and in particular (but without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing) no Member shall behave in an offensive or abusive or

RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY FOR BSPS WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP QUALIFIERS

B.S.P.S. QUALIFICATION

<u>Novice</u> – in the novice classes the 1st, 2nd and 3rd placed animals will qualify. In mixed height novice classes, the 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th placed ponies will qualify.

<u>Open</u> – in the open (restricted) the three highest placed Restricted animals will qualify. Riders on restricted animals MUST wear an armband when they enter the ring. In Mixed height Open (restricted) the four highest placed restricted animals will qualify

Animals must be registered before the date of the Show at which they qualify for the Winter Championships and must be ridden by B.S.P.S. Members, except in the case of exhibitors who have never been members before who are allowed 7 days in which to become members and register their ponies. **Animals must NOT have been placed 1st to 8th at the RIHS or HOYS or in the relevant classes in 2020/2021/2022.** Please note that this Rule does not apply to classes with HOYS, RIHS, Olympia or Blue Riband Qualifications. All Rules as per the 2022 BSPS Rule and Show Handbook.

WINTER WORKER STAKES

Open to both plaited or Heritage M&M ponies. The highest placed 3 ponies will qualify for the BSPS Winter Championships together with the highest placed junior rider. Ponies may compete in more than one height section.

THE ROYAL HIGHLAND SHOW - NURSERY STAKES

This Qualifying Championship is kindly Sponsored by Chamfleurie Stables

This show is a qualifier for The Royal Highland Show Nursery Stakes 2022. The first 4 placed same pony and rider combination will qualify for the 2022 Royal Highland Show Nursery Stakes provided they have jumped a clear round. Qualification will only move down the line to the next eligible pony and rider combination meeting the qualification criteria. Qualification will be in accordance with Rule 37 of the BSPS Rule and Show Handbook. This class is open to both BSPS Members and Non-Members.

Rule 37 – No rider may ride more than one pony in a class except that Riders in all WHP Classes that are not qualifiers for HOYS or RIHS who may ride up to two ponies of the same height in a class, but ONLY the first pony to jump will be competitive and go forward for Phase II judging, the second pony will not go forward for Phase II. PLEASE NOTE: EACH RIDER MUST NOT HAVE ATTAINED THEIR 12TH BIRTHDAY BEFORE 1ST JANUARY 2022 TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR THE NURSERY STAKE CHAMPION CLASS AT THE ROYAL HIGHLAND SHOW 2022. QUALIFYING PONY/RIDER COMBINATIONS IN THIS CLASS MUST ENTER THE RHS CHAMPIONSHIP CLASS NO LATER THAN MONDAY 2nd MAY 2020. ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED AFTER THIS DATE
