NOTE: All competitions to be judged under British Showjumping Rules, Entries may be strictly limited in all classes. Entries are confined to Registered Horses to be ridden by Members in accordance with British Showjumping Rule 79 & 76.6. Competitors are asked to state clearly on the Entry Statement the name of the rider for each Entry, and the Owner's and Rider's British Showjumping Membership and Horse Registration Number. **Rule 82.20 NO member shall allow a stallion for which he/she is responsible as owner, lessee, authorised agent or rider to compete or be prepared to compete, in any show jumping competition without taking adequate precautions to ensure other members of the public are not put at risk of injury.**

SENIOR FOXHUNTER - FIRST ROUND / 1.20M OPEN

9:00am in Ring 5

ENTRY FEE: £25.00

Class 76 In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split and two sets of prize money awarded. Horses (or ponies in pony competitions) may compete in one section only. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes will be withheld. Rule - 76.6. For registered horses to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members. Single Phase. Speed 350mpm. Rule 310. (a) For registered horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 700 points. Four double clears will qualify - in accordance with rule 310.6. (b) For all registered horses born on or after 1 January 2015, irrespective of points. Horses will be eligible for double clear qualification to attend second rounds providing they reach the age of seven years or under in the same calendar year as the Foxhunter Final - in accordance with rule 310.6 Four double clears will qualify. Four double clears will qualify for the Senior Foxhunter Second Rounds. Qualifying period: The Senior Foxhunter Second Round qualifying period for the 2023 second rounds is 1 May '22 - 30 April '23 (subject to revision). Those horses that have qualified for the Senior Foxhunter Championship in 2023 are not eligible for qualification to the 2024 Championship. If combined with an open: In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split with two sets of prize money.

NATIONAL 1.30M OPEN

To follow Class 76 in Ring 5

ENTRY FEE: £30.00

Class 77 Rule 306. Single Phase. Speed 375mpm. Start Height 1.30m. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes will be withheld. Rule - 76.6. Open to registered horses to be ridden by Adult, Associate and Junior Members. Qualifies for: The British Showjumping National Championships. Qualifying period: 1st July-30th June. Numbers to qualify: Two double clears to qualify to the final. Double clear qualifications will not be obtained from one round competitions (e.g. Table A4 or Table A (1 Round)).

PRIZES: 1st £150, 2nd £100, 3rd £75, 4th £60, 5th £45, 6th £30

THE MARTINI & ROSSI CUP (54) will be awarded to the winner.

EQUISSAGE PULSE SENIOR BRITISH NOVICE FIRST ROUND

To follow Class 77 in Ring 5

ENTRY FEE: £20.00

Class 78A Rule 316. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 90cm. Horses (or ponies in pony competitions) may compete in one section only. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes will be withheld. Rule - 76.6. Entry qualifications: to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members. a) For horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 125 points. Four Double Clears will qualify - in accordance with Rule 316.6. b) For all horses born on or after 1 January 2018 irrespective of points. Horses will only be eligible for double clear qualification to Second Rounds if they reach the age of four years or under in the same calendar year as the British Novice Final - in accordance with Rule 316.6. Qualifies for: Senior British Novice Championship - Second Round. Qualifying period: 1st May - 30th April inclusive. Numbers to qualify: Those horses which jump a clear round in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in at least four British Novice First Round competitions held in any qualifying period will qualify to compete in the British Novice Second Rounds, irrespective of their placings for prize money in those competitions, which will be determined by the normal Table A rules (Rule 191). Horses in the class must go in to the jump-off and go clear to gain a double clear round qualification. If combined with an open: In Category 1 Shows and in the event of 30 starters or more the Open and the British Novice section will be split with two sets of prize money awarded. In Category 2 Shows the sections must always be split with two sets of prize money awarded, irrespective of starters.

SENIOR 90CM OPEN

To follow Class 78a in Ring 5

ENTRY FEE: £20.00

Class 78B Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 90cm. For registered horses in Grades: A, B & C. Ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members who will be aged 12 years or over in the current calendar year. Horses (or ponies in pony competitions) may compete in one section only. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes will be withheld. Rule - 76.6.

PRIZES: 1st £50, 2nd £40, 3rd £30, 4th £25, 5th £20

NUPAFEED SUPPLEMENTS SENIOR DISCOVERY 1ST ROUND

To follow Class 78b in Ring 5

ENTRY FEE: £20.00

Class 79A Rule 314. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 1.00m. Horses (or ponies in pony competitions) may compete in one section only. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes will be withheld. Rule - 76.6. Entry qualifications: to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members. a) For horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 225 points. Four Double Clears will qualify - in accordance with Rule 314.6. b) For all horses born on or after 1 January 2017 irrespective of points. Horses will only be eligible for double clear qualification to Second Rounds if they reach the age of five years or under in the same calendar year as the Discovery Final - in accordance with Rule 314.6. Qualifies for: Nupafeed Supplements Discovery Championship Second Round. Qualifying period: 1st May-30th April inclusive. Numbers to qualify: Those horses that jump a clear round in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in at least four First Round competitions held in any qualifying period, will qualify to compete in the Senior Discovery Second Rounds, irrespective of their placings for prize money in those competitions, which will be determined by the normal Table A Rules (Rule 191). Horses in the class must go in to the jump-off and go clear to gain a double clear round qualification. If combined with an open: In Category 1 Shows and in the event of 30 starters or more the Open and the Discovery section will be split with two sets of prize money awarded. In Category 2 Shows the sections must always be split with two sets of prize money awarded, irrespective of starters.

Class 79B Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 1.00m. For registered horses in Grades: A, B & C. Ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members who will be aged 12 years or over in the current calendar year. Horses (or ponies in pony competitions) may compete in one section only. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes will be withheld. Rule - 76.6.

PRIZES: 1st £50, 2nd £40, 3rd £30, 4th £25, 5th £20

EQUITOP SENIOR NEWCOMERS 1ST ROUND / 1.10M OPEN

To follow Class 79b in Ring 5

ENTRY FEE: £25.00

Class 80 Rule 312. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 1.10m. In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split and two sets of prize money awarded. Horses (or ponies in pony competitions) may compete in one section only. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes will be withheld. Rule - 76.6. Newcomers: (a) For registered horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 375 points. Four double clears will qualify - in accordance with rule 312.6. (b) For all horses born on or after 1st January 2016, irrespective of Points. Horses will only be eligible for double clear qualification to Second Rounds if they reach the age of six years or under in the same calendar year as the Newcomers Final - in accordance with Rule 312.6. Four double clears will qualify for the Senior Newcomers Second Rounds. Qualifying period 1st June - 31st May inclusive. 1.10m Open: For registered horses ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members. If scheduled in a Category 3 show, there will be two separate sets of placings, one for the First Round and one for the Open section.

ENTRY FEE: £50.00

Class 81 Rule 293. Table A9. Speed 375mpm. Start Height 1.50m. DRAWN ORDER. For registered horses in Grades A & B to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior members. This competition may not be restricted to invited riders or limited to less than 40 entries. Qualifies for: The Queen Elizabeth II Cup at the Royal International Horse Show. Numbers to qualify: The top 20 riders on the Area/International Trials points list, for the period 1 April - 30 September. Points will be awarded to riders placed 6th= or higher in Area Trials on the following scale; riders placed equal will share equally the total points attributable to the combined placings (for example, four riders placed 4th equal receive: $8+4+2+0$ divided by 4 = 3.5 points each). 1st 64 points, 2nd 32 points, 3rd 16 points, 4th 8 points, 5th 4 points, 6th 2 points. Points are awarded to each rider as the result of his/her best six results on points in Area Trials held during the qualifying period. Visiting Members are eligible to compete in Area Trial competitions, but will not be awarded points. For the purposes only of calculating points, the placings of Visiting Members will be disregarded and points will be awarded to the remaining competitors according to their adjusted placings once this has been

ACCUMULATOR JUMPING COMPETITION

ENTRY FEE: £30.00

Class 82 Rule 274. Table A. Speed 375mpm. Start Height 1.25m. The order of starting must be drawn. This competition takes place over six, eight or 10 obstacles which are progressively more difficult. No combination obstacles are allowed. The progressive difficulty is not solely due to the height and spread of the obstacles, but also to the difficulty of the track. Points are awarded as follows: One point for obstacle No. 1 cleared, two points for No. 2, three points for No. 3 etc. with total of 21, 36 or 55 points. No point is awarded for an obstacle knocked down. Faults other than knock-downs are penalised as for Table A and any of these faults, including time faults, are converted into points and deducted from any jumping points scored. In the event of equality of points for first place, there will be a jump-off against the clock over a shortened course, over obstacles that may be increased in height and/or spread. The obstacles in the jump-off must be jumped in the same order as in the first round and retain their respective points allotted in the first round. This competition may also take place directly against the clock. For the last obstacle of the course, an alternative obstacle may be provided, of which one part may be designated the Joker. The Joker must be more difficult than the alternative obstacle and carry double points. If the Joker is knocked down, the points must be deducted from the total.
