JUDGE: - Mrs Helen Horsfall Stewards – DBS

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT ALL DONKEYS SHOULD BE SHOWN WITH BIT.

Entry Fee: £7.00

Prizes 1st £20; 2nd £15; 3rd £10.

Class 76 – STALLION – 4 yrs and over. To be led & no handler under 18yrs.

Note – No Stallions to be entered in any other in hand classes.

Class 77 – BEST CONDITIONED AND TURNED OUT DONKEY. Donkeys of any age. To be judged 75% condition and 25% turnout. Conformation must not be taken into account. Winner of this class does not qualify for the Championships.

Class 78 – MARE CLASS – Mares of 4 years old and over, and Broodmares of 5 years old and over with own foal at foot. Foals to be 6 weeks old and over.

The Winner of Class 78 will receive the Albert Irvine Cup.

RULES AND CONDITIONS

- 1 This Championship is for Donkey Mare **with Foal at Foot**.
- 2 All Exhibitors must have the Dam's passport. (in accordance with EU legislation for all entries which includes Donkeys), ready for inspection at the Qualifying Show and Final.
- 3 Two Donkeys to qualify if Judges & I.S.A agree that the standard is high enough.
- 4 The Qualifying Exhibitor must fill out their own Qualifying Card at each Qualifying Show.

Those rules should be read in conjunction with the I.S.A Rules

ENTRY FEE: To Qualifying Show €7 To Final €10

PRIZES: Champion €200; 2nd €150; 3rd €100; 4th €75; 5th €50; 6th €25

A prize will be presented for Combination of Best Turned Out Donkey and Suitably Dressed Handler.

Final - Moate Show – Sunday 22nd September 2024

Class 79 – GELDING CLASS – 4 years old and over.

The Winner will receive the Braughing Cornelius Perpetual Trophy.

Class 80 – YOUNG STOCK CLASSES - COLT, GELDING OR FILLY – 1, 2 or 3 years old. Colt over 1 year to be handled by an adult.

In-hand Championship is eligible to 1st and 2nd from classes 76, 78, 79 and 80.

Class 80a – BEST LOCAL DONKEY – Must be owned by a DBS member living within a 25 mile radius of the Show Ground - **NO ENTRY FEE FOR CLASS 80A ONLY**

DRIVING CLASSES

Donkeys entered must be four years old and over.

When a person of 17 years of age and under is driving a stallion an experienced Adult Whip 18 years or over must be in the vehicle at all times.

An Adult with a leading rein must be in the ring throughout the class when Junior Whips 15 years and under are competing.

Class 81 LONG REINING (The Donkey must be 4 years and over)

Class 83 – PRIVATE DRIVING

Class 84 – TRADE/TRADITIONAL (Please note that all exhibitors must be seated or standing in vehicle)

Driving Championship is eligible to 1st and 2nd from classes 82, 83 and 84.

Class 86 – YOUNG HANDLERS CLASS – Handler not to have obtained his/her 16th Birthday on Show Day. To be judged on the ability of the Young Handler and not on conformation of the Donkey.

Class 87 – RIDING CLASS – Donkeys entered must be four years old or over and must have a correctly fitting bridle and saddle. All riders must wear an approved (PAS015) correctly fitting hard hat to conform to the current BSI standards. Children of 8 years or under (minimum 3 years) may be led. When a child competes on a leading change to lead rein the Donkey must be led by a competent adult 18 year and over. Lead reins must be attached to the noseband and bit.

Both the following weight and height restrictions shall apply:

Donkeys:

Up to 10.2hh (105cms)

10.2-11.0hh (105-110cms)

11.0-12.0hh (110-120cms)

12.0-14.0hh (120-140cms)

Over 14hh (140cms)

Riders:

not over 8 stone (50kgs) + 4'0" (120cms)

not over 8 stone (50kgs) + 4'6" (135cms)

not over 9 stone (57kgs) +5'0" (150cms)

not over 10 stone (63kgs)+5'6" (165cms)

no restrictions

Class 88 – PET/AGED DONKEY CLASS – to be judged entirely on suitability as a family pet.

Conformation will not be taken into account.

Donkey Breed Society Cups and rosettes can only be presented to Donkey Breed Society Members. cards to be carried on Show Day.
