

Classes

F1 PICTURE PERFECT (Limited to **6** Entries)

An exhibit to be staged on a 2cm wide black metal frame. Overall size of frame 74cm wide x 200cm high. Please note these frames are fabricated and the apertures may not be absolutely exact. Frame supported at the base with feet. Exhibit to be viewed and judges all round. For details of frame please see attached drawing.

Space Allowed: Width - 80cm Depth - 30cm

Height – 220cm

F2 PEDESTAL CLASS – ARTISTIC RESTRAINT

An exhibit to be staged directly on the ground against a marquee side. To be viewed and judged from the front. Exhibitor permitted to use own base.

Space Allowed: Width - 120cm Depth - 120cm Height - Optional

F3 IN TWO PARTS

An exhibit to be staged directly on top of a **GREY** (Johnstones Soft Sheen Moonlit Sky 10048) painted solid cube 65cm x 65cm x 65cm. To be viewed and judged all round.

Space Allowed: Width - 65cm Depth - 65cm Height - 100cm

F4 BARKING MAD

An exhibit staged directly on the ground. To be viewed and judged all round. Exhibitor permitted to use own base.

Space Allowed: Width - 120cm Depth - 120cm Height - 75cm

F5 WILD AND WIRED

An exhibit to be staged on a base on the ground, positioned centrally in the space. Base painted **BLACK** 2.5cm thick x 75cm long x 75cm wide. To be viewed and judged from the front. **No floral foam permitted.**

Space Allowed: Width - 100cm Depth - 100cm Height - 200cm

F6 ORGANISED CHAOS (Limited to **6** Entries)

An exhibit staged within a free standing wooden framework. The 'window' measures 73cm wide x 90cm high and is raised 77cm from the ground. Frame painted black. To be viewed and judged from the front. Exhibits may be fastened to the frame and exceed the size of the aperture. However, no materials eg glue or tacks which would damage the frame are permitted.

Space Allowed: Width - 83cm Depth - 50cm Height - 100cm

F7 STRING AND THINGS

An exhibit to be staged on tables covered in pale green fabric against a marquee side. To be viewed and judged from the front.

Space Allowed: Width - 70cm Depth - 70cm Height - 90cm



F8 STICKS

An exhibit to be staged on tables covered in pale green fabric against a marquee side. **No floral foam permitted**. To be viewed and judged from the front.

Space Allowed: Width - 70cm Depth - 70cm Height - 90cm

F9 GLAMOROUS GLASS

An exhibit to be staged on tables covered in pale green fabric against a marquee side. **No floral foam permitted**. To be viewed and judged from the front.

Space Allowed: Width - 70cm Depth - 70cm Height - 90cm

F10 WARP AND WEFT

Small exhibit to be staged on tables covered in pale green fabric against a marquee side. To be viewed and judged from the front.

Space Allowed: Width - 20cm Depth - 20cm Height - 30cm

F11 NOVICE - TEXTURAL MELANGE

An exhibit to be staged on tables covered in pale green fabric against a marquee side. Open to any competitor who has not won a 1^{st} prize in floral art in a NAFAS or RHS competition. To be viewed and judged from the front.

Space Allowed: Width - 70cm Depth - 70cm Height - 90cm

Floral Design Competition Rules

- 1 Staging may commence 10.00am on Friday 2 June 2023. All exhibits must be completed by 6.00am on Saturday 3 June 2023. At this point all competitors must leave the marquee in preparation for judging.
- 2 Classes must be staged by only one competitor.
- 3 Competitors must not remove exhibits before the close of show on Sunday at 4.00pm. All exhibits must be removed by 6.00pm, unless by prior written arrangement.
- 4 Classes F1 F11 will be judged in accordance with the NAFAS Competitions Manual (2015 green book). It is strongly recommended that all competitors staging flower arrangements refer to this manual.
- 5 Pre-prepared work is allowed in all classes unless stated otherwise in the schedule.
- 6 Entry form at the back of this schedule or enter online.
- 7 Prizes presented at 3.30pm on Sunday 4 June 2023.
- * Exhibitor passes entitles 1 wristband per exhibitor. Exhibitors may apply for up to 4 additional passes at the discounted rate of £10, at the point of entry. All exhibitor passes are non-refundable and non-transferable.


