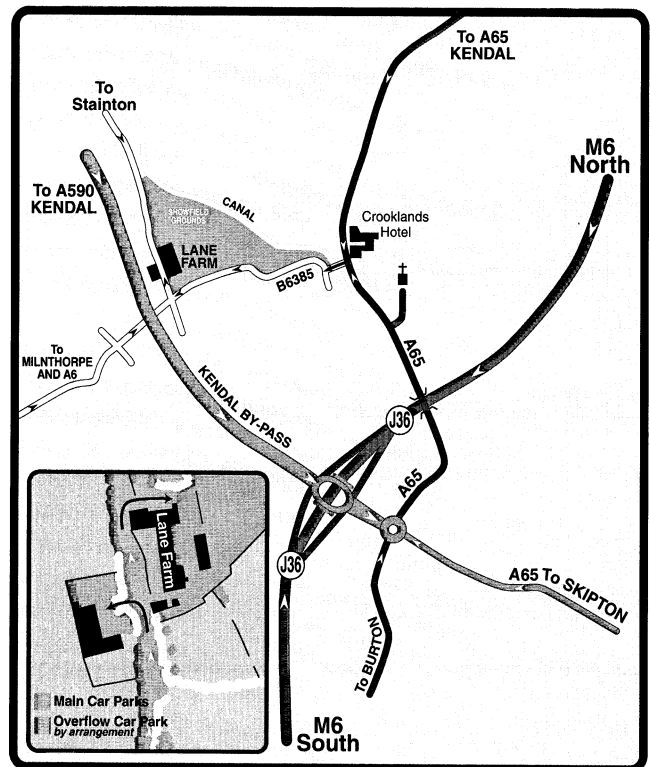

F1 MAD ABOUT BARK

A pedestal exhibit, to be staged directly on the ground against a marquee side. To be viewed and judged from the front. Exhibitor to provide base if required.

Space Allowed: Width - 120cm Depth - 120cm

Height – Optional

F2 ENCLOSED SPACE (Maximum **6** entries)

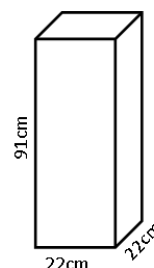
An exhibit to be staged on top of a grey solid cube 65cm x 65cm x 65cm (Johnstones Soft Sheen Moonlit Sky 10048). To be viewed and judged all round.

Space Allowed: Width – 65 cm Depth - 65cm Height – 100cm

F3 TIN – TINCULAR (Maximum **6** entries)

Staged on an individual white birch, natural wooden plinth 22cm square, height 91cm. Viewed and judged all round. Please note – the natural colour and size of plinths may vary slightly.

Space allowed: Width - 76cm Depth - 76cm Height – 152cm



F4 WILLOW PATTERN (Maximum **6** entries)

Staged on the ground. Can be staged by 2 people. To be viewed and judged from the front. Two wooden, trellis panels will be provided in a V shape.

Each panel measures: Width - 30cm Height 180cm.

Each square measure: Width – 10cm Height: 10cm

Space allowed: Width – 150cm Depth - 150cm Height – Optional



F5 TRIGONOMETRY (Maximum **6** entries)

An exhibit staged within a free standing wooden framework. The 'window' measures 73cm wide x 90cm high and is raised 77cm from the ground. Frame painted black. To be viewed and judged from the front. Exhibits may be fastened to the frame and exceed the size of the aperture. However, no materials e.g. glue or tacks which would damage the frame are permitted. **No floral foam permitted.**

Space Allowed: Width - 100cm Depth - 100cm Height - 100cm



F6 SUBMERGED

An exhibit to be staged on tables covered in pale green fabric against a marquee side. To be viewed and judged from the front. Exhibit to include glass container(s).

Space Allowed: Width - 70cm Depth - 70cm Height - 90cm

F7 GALVANISED

An exhibit to be staged on tables covered in pale green fabric against a marquee side. To be viewed and judged from the front.

Space Allowed: Width - 90cm Depth - 70cm Height - 90cm

F8 CAST ADRIFT (Maximum 6 entries)

Staged on individual tables. Table size 75cm x 182cm x 76cm from the floor. Exhibitor to provide own table covering. A black watertight tray will be provided.

Approx. size of tray: Length – 77.4cm Width – 39.3cm 2cm deep. Height optional.

Fixed rope and ring with frayed end provided. Use optional.

Space Allowed: Width - 75cm Length - 182cm Height - Optional

F9 DWELLING PLACE – Craft Class

A craft exhibit which may be made before the show and brought for staging. To be viewed and judged from the front. Petite exhibit not to exceed 25cm x 25cm x 25cm.

F10 VERDANT

A foliage exhibit. May include bracts grasses and seeds. Staged on a bench covered with green fabric. To be viewed and judged from the front.

Space Allowed: Width – 90cm Depth– 70 cm

Height – 90cm

F11 COILED (Maximum 6 entries)

A hanging exhibit, with hook provided. Height of hook approximately 2m. To be viewed and judged all round.

Space allowed: Width – 90cm Depth – 90cm Height – 120cm downwards from hook

WEIGHT LIMIT 10KG

F12 A BAUBLE – Craft Class

Staged on a bench covered with green fabric. Exhibitor to provide means of suspension.

Space Allowed: Width - 30cm Depth – 30cm Height - Optional
