Biosecurity Measures: All birds must be inspected for signs of illness before travelling to the show and it is recommended they are kept isolated from other birds and monitored for signs of illness for at least fourteen day after the show.

Premises of origin for all birds entered must be registered with the Animal & Plant Health Agency (APHA) on the GB Poultry Register and you must provide evidence of registration at the show.

All birds must remain isolated from other birds at the show until inspected by the bird expert present.

If Avian Flu restrictions are in place at time of show and poultry can not be shown exhibitors will be reimbursed
