Special Regulations applying to Angora Goat Section

- BRITISH ANGORA GOAT SOCIETY RULES** - All classes are held under rules, regulations and recognition of the British Angora Goat Society. All exhibits must be registered with the Society as in the ownership and in the name of the exhibitor. All goats, including kids, must be exhibited on halters unless otherwise directed by the Judge.
- ENTRY FEES** - All fees include vat @ 20%. Exhibitors may enter as many goats as they wish but must only bring to the Show the number which can be accommodated in the pens booked. It should be noted that exhibitors may be required to restrict the number of entries should there be insufficient pens available to accommodate all exhibitors and all entries.

- FLEECE CLASSES** - All fleeces must be on display until the end of the Show. Fleeces must have been shorn within the previous ten months. Fleeces must be entire with only vegetation and stains removed.
- CAPRINE ARTHRITIS ENCEPHALITIS** - There are no facilities for CAE Accredited animals.
- SHEARING** - All entries must be shorn on or after 1 January of the current year. Over or under fleeced animals may be penalised.
- DEPARTURE** - All livestock must remain until 4.30pm on the last day of the show, Saturday 18th May, or longer, as the Stewards require. Livestock cannot be removed earlier without written consent of the Chief Steward/ the Honorary Veterinary Officer and the Devon County Show Manager. Such consent will only be granted under exceptional circumstances.
