Special Regulations applying to the Dairy Goat Section

- 1. BRITISH GOAT SOCIETY RULES All classes are held under the rules, regulations and recognition of the British Goat Society. All exhibits must be registered with the BGS as in the ownership and in the name of the exhibitor, the registered name and number being quoted on the entry form.
- **2. MILKERS** All goats in milk must have kidded or aborted a minimum of 30 days previous to the day of the Show. Kidding dates must be included on the entry form.
- **3. KIDS** Kids in classes 530-535 not registered by the first day of the Show will not be eligible for competition. All kids must be born by closing date of entries. The registered number of any goat initially entered as "RAF" (registration applied for) must be submitted to the Show organisers before that goat competes. Kids under 2 months of age may accompany the herd by no extra accommodation will be provided for them.
- **4. PREGNANT GOATS** No pregnant goats are to be present on the showground.
- **5. INSPECTION /PRODUCTION COMPETITION** All in milk goats placed for a prize or reserve in any recognised Inspection Class and entered in the Milking Competition must be paraded and compete in the inspection/production competition.
- **6. TIMES OF ARRIVAL** All goats shall be on the showground not later than 5.30pm on Wednesday 15th May.
- **7. STRIPPING OUT** Milkers will be stripped out under the supervision of the appointed stewards at 6.30pm on that day. Any milking goats arriving later than this will run the risk of disqualification.
- **8. ENTRY FEES - All** entry fees include VAT @ 20%. If there are two or less entries, the class will be cancelled.

- 10. CAPRINE ARTHRITIS ENCEPHALITIS Entries to be taken from BGS monitored accredited or privately tested goats only. Entries from DEFRA accredited goats cannot be accepted. Exhibitors must indicate the status of their entries on the entry form and veterinary certificates MUST be presented for inspection at the Livestock Gate prior to admission and a copy of the form must be sent with entry forms.
- **11. DEPARTURE** All livestock must remain until 4.30pm on the last day of the show, Saturday 18th May, or longer, as the Stewards require. Livestock cannot be removed earlier without written consent of the Chief Steward/ the Honorary Veterinary Officer and the Devon County Show Manager. Such consent will only be granted under exceptional circumstances.
