PIG CLASSES AND AWARDS

Entries Close Friday 10th March 2025

Please ensure that you have read the General Rules and Regulations at the back of this Schedule in addition to the Special Regulations below.

POINTS AWARDS

- **PTS1** The Johnstone Perpetual Challenge Cup For Exhibitors resident in Devon gaining the highest number of points in the Horse, Cattle, Sheep and Pig classes. (Ref 1)
- PTS2 The Peter Holmes Memorial Perpetual Challenge Trophy presented by his NAAS colleagues, for the exhibitor under 35 years of age and resident in Devon gaining the highest number of points in the Cattle, Sheep and Pig classes. Exhibitors must indicate on their entry form if they are eligible for this Trophy. (Ref 114). Exhibitors, please note that partnerships are not eligible for this award unless all partners are under 35 years of age.

Points will be awarded on the basis of:

Pig Classes:

First Prize 4 points
Second Prize 3 points
Third Prize 2 points
Fourth Prize 1 point

Special Regulations applying to the Pig Section

- 1. **PENS** Exhibitors may enter as many pigs as they wish but must only bring to the Show the number which can be accommodated in the pens booked. Pens are 6' x 6' and pigs should be penned accordingly.
- 2. ENTRY & PEN FEES All fees include VAT @ 20%. The DCAA reserves the right to cancel or amalgamate any class in the event of entries being less in number than an average of four per class, or the number of different exhibitors in the section being less than three. Please note that Penning Fees will be refunded on the following basis: The cost of 3 pens will be reimbursed to exhibitors with up to 5 entries, 4 pens for up to 10 entries and 5 pens for 10+ entries at the rate of £4.75 per pen.

Please note refunds are only available for pens with pigs in e.g., kit pens do not apply. Refunds will be issued at the Show once pigs have been penned. Kindly sponsored by Mr B Coleman

- 3. GROUP CLASS In classes for Groups the entry fee payable is per group and not per animal. Exhibitors must enter for the Group classes at the time of booking pens.
- 4. PRIZE MONEY Prizes offered relates to the number of entries catalogued in each class. Rosettes will be awarded to fourth place in all classes regardless of the number of entries catalogued.

- 5. **LITTER NUMBERS** For January classes a range of litter numbers will be accepted. Pigs brought to the Show must be selected from this range and the individual ear tag number must be notified to the Show Office by 18th March.
- 6. **REGULATIONS APPLYING TO ALL BRITISH PIG ASSOCIATION CLASSES** Pigs must be registered in a published volume, or accepted for entry in a forthcoming volume of the BPA's Herd Book. It is not sufficient for an animal to be only eligible for registration. Animals registered in a Grading Register of a Herd Book are not eligible for entry.
- 7. PIG DETAILS The ear number, registered name, Herd Book number and date of birth of each pig, and the name and Herd Book number of the sire and dam, must be supplied for printing in the Catalogue together with the name of the breeder in cases where the exhibitor is not the breeder.
- 8. **FEMALE PIGS** Female pigs (all breeds) born before 1st January in the year before the Show will be eligible to compete only if in the six calendar months prior to the Show they have farrowed, suckled and reared to four weeks of age, a birth notified litter of pigs.
- Female pigs (all breeds) born on or after 1st January and before 1st July in the year before the Show must, within 18 months of their date of birth, have farrowed, suckled and reared to four weeks of age a notified litter of pigs.
- 9. BOARS Boars of two years of age and over (all breeds) are to be certified as having sired at least three live litters within twelve months preceding the first day of the Show. The pigs comprising such litters are to have been litter notified in the BPA's Herd Book or proof of their birth must have been given to the BPA. Boars aged twelve months or more at the time of the Show, must have their tusks cut prior to the Show. All boars must be shown by two competent adult handlers who are equipped with protective boards.
- 10. **COLOURING/WHITENING** The use of artificial colouring, whitening and/or powder on pigs, and the removal of or addition of spots by artificial means, is prohibited. White woodflour is permitted.
- 11. BRITISH LOP All pigs of this breed (other than farrows accompanying sows) must have been registered before the date of entry and the ear number given on the entry form. Exhibits must be the property of a paid up Member of the British Lop Society.
- 12. PIG DENTITION The DCAA reserves the right to arrange for the examination of any pig for dentition purposes.
- 13. JUDGING RINGS Exhibitors are requested not to exercise pigs in the areas designated as Judging Rings.
- 14. TIMES OF ARRIVAL Please note that pigs must arrive between 2pm-7pm on Tuesday 13th May or 6am and 8pm on Wednesday 14th May.
- **15. DEPARTURE** All livestock must remain until 4.30pm on the last day of the show, Saturday 17th May, or longer, as the Stewards require. Livestock cannot be removed earlier without written consent of the Chief Steward/ the Honorary Veterinary Officer and the Devon County Show Manager. Such consent will only be granted under exceptional circumstances.

All Pig exhibitors to be considered for these awards unless they state otherwise. This is an Interbreed Competition and will be based upon the tidiness and cleanliness of pens, stock and stockmen and presentation of any display information.

The Judge will take into account the following:

- a) Herd signs and the display of pedigree, production and financial information; about the Herd and about Stock for sale displayed in a space not exceeding 2 metres wide by 1 metre high for each pen, either as a separate unit or in a continuous run. These measurements must include all fixings and attachments, and nails must not be used to affix the display boards to the pens. The board must be provided and fixed by the exhibitor and made of any lightweight material. Backing material will be allowed to cover the entire length of pens. Rosettes from other Shows will not be permitted as part of the display. Flowers and shrubs are not allowed to enhance the appearance of the display.
 - b) Consideration will be given to the educational content of the display targeted at the general public.

Any unregistered pigs will not be allowed in the ring. 3. All pigs entered in the show must be the bone fide property of the exhibitor and must have been transferred into their ownership by the BKKPS before being entered into the show. 4. Exhibitors must display the pigs' registration certificate (or a copy) on the pen to verify pedigree registration and ownership. 5. All pigs must be correctly tagged and the information should match with the registration certificate displayed 6. No pigs under the age of 4 months will be entered. Piglets accompanying a sow must be at least 3 weeks of age and individually tagged. 7. Boars over 12 months of age MUST have tusks trimmed and be shown by 2 adult handlers (over 18 years) with proper boards and sticks/batons. 8. Handlers are required to be of smart appearance with appropriate footwear; white coats must be worn at all times in the show ring. Proper pig boards and sticks must be used. Pig boards should not show any form of individual advertising or Herd names. 9. Animals in poor health or suffering from any form of contagious or infectious disease must not be brought to the show. 10. A competent person must be in attendance with each lot of pigs for the duration of the show and all attendants must comply with reasonable requests from the Stewards. 11. With the exception of the Stewards or other representatives of the Organisers, no person will be admitted to the judging rings or permitted to be in contact with the judges on any pretext. 12. Sows must have produced and reared a pedigree (birth notified) litter in the 12 months prior to show date. 13. Gilts are eligible to be shown up to 18 months old. after this they must meet the requirement of rule 12. 14. Boars over a year old must have sired a litter within 12 months prior to show. 15. Veteran pigs must be 6 years and over. 16. Castrated pigs will not be eligible for Champion of Champions.
