Special Regulations applying to the Cattle Section

PLEASE ALSO SEE FULL RULES AND REGULATIONS APPLICABLE TO ALL LIVESTOCK COMPETITIONS WHICH IS AVAILABLE TO DOWNLOAD FROM SHOWING SCENE IN THE DOWNLOADS SECTION AND IS ALSO SHOWN AT TIME OF ENTRY

- ENTRIES** - Exhibitors may make up to two entries per class.
- STALLS** - Exhibitors may book a maximum of ten stalls in any one breed and should note that separate stalls must be reserved for calves at foot, if required. Double stalls will be allocated to bulls of two years old or over. Each stall is 4ft wide. The DCAA reserves the right to reduce the number of stalls allocated to each exhibitor should circumstances require. Exhibitors are required to book stalls sufficient to accommodate all animals they intend to have forward at the Show.
- STALL FEES** - All fees include VAT @ 20%. In classes for pairs or groups the fee payable is per pair or group and not per animal. There is no entry fee for pair or group special classes or awards.

Please note that Stall Fees will be refunded for each animal brought to the Show at the rate of £26 per stall or £12 per calf stall. Refunds will be issued when passports are handed in at the Cattle Secretary's Office.

3. **PRIZE MONEY** - Prizes offered are related to the number of entries catalogued in each class. Rosettes will be awarded to fourth place in all classes regardless of the number of entries catalogued.

4. **INTERBREED AWARDS** - Where an animal qualifies for an Interbreed Award it must be brought forward for the judging.
5. **HERD BOOK** - All exhibits must either be entered or eligible for entry in the Herd Book or grading up register of their respective breeds, excluding the dual purpose breed.
6. **CATTLE MOVEMENTS** - Movements to and from the showground must be registered with BCMS.
7. **PASSPORTS** - Exhibitors must present the passports for all cattle attending the Show on arrival at the showground. No animal will be permitted on to the showground without a valid passport.
8. **TB PRE MOVEMENT TESTING** - All cattle coming to the Show, must have had a pre movement test with a negative result within 60 days of the end date of the Show. If, after making entries, the herd loses its Brucellosis Accredited or TB status, entry fees will be refunded on application to the Devon County Show Manager. Applications must be received in writing no later than fourteen days after the first day of the Show and must be accompanied by a veterinary certificate or ministry order.
9. **INFECTIOUS BOVINE RHINOTRACHEITIS (IBR/BHV 1)** - Exhibitors must state on the entry form if their animals are of IBR status. These animals will be housed within the Cattle lines with the necessary stipulated distances from other cattle being respected.
10. **QUALIFICATIONS** - Where prizes are offered subject to qualifying yields of lactation or similar conditions a Certificate of Yield from the NMR or CIS for the lactations concerned should be sent with the entry forms. Cows and heifers which have not calved before the Show, whether entered in milk or in calf, shall be judged along with the animals in calf, and cows and heifers which have calved before the Show - in whichever of the classes entered - shall be judged along with the animals in milk.
11. **IN-CALF ANIMALS** - A veterinary certificate of confirmed pregnancy by ultrasound or manual palpation (not milk progesterone) for animals entered in the Dry Cow classes must be available for inspection by the Chief Steward at the Show. The show reserve the right to have any animal PD tested by the onsite vet.
12. **MILKING AT THE SHOW**
- All milk yielded at the Show will be purchased by the DCAA at a rate per cow per day and payment will be made on the last day of the Show. No milk may be sold to any person other than the Association's appointed officer.
 - All milking cows exhibited are to be milked in the dairy situated near the cattle lines, except at the discretion of the dairy stewards. Facilities will be available for machine milking.
 - Machine milkers will not be required to provide their own equipment, if so doing, the units must be left in the dairy where they can be washed and sterilised.
 - Facilities will be provided for rejection of foremilk, hand washing, udder washing and dipping clusters between milking each cow. All the milking machine units will be washed and sterilised by the dairy stewards.
 - Milkers should wear some form of washable milking-coat.

- f. The times of milking will be 6.00am and 4.00pm unless otherwise arranged with the dairy stewards.
- g. The dairy stewards will arrange for the milk to be cooled in the milk reception room.
- h. Exhibitors must inform Dairy staff of any cow under treatment on arrival at the Show and or during the Show so that the milk can be discarded and full records kept.

12. WASHING OF COWS - Exhibitors are prohibited from washing dairy cows with shampoos that contain phenols.

13. BULLS AND OTHER UNRULY ANIMALS - No bull exceeding ten months will be admitted to the showground unless it has a clamp or ring in its nose and, if necessary, shall be led by a leading stick. Handlers of beef heifers should have with them bulldogs. Exhibitors must be satisfied in all cases, and at all times, that the correct and appropriate restraining method and equipment is provided for use by animal handlers and where appropriate heifers should be trained to accept "bulldogs" as a restraint. All cattle must be secured to the satisfaction of the stewards, who shall have the power to exclude from the showground any vicious or unruly animal. Bulls must be double tied in the lines and have two handlers when moving around the showground. All animals must be properly halter trained before they come to the Show. Stock attendants are responsible for their own cattle at all times.

14. DEPARTURE - All livestock must remain until 4.30pm on the last day of the show, Saturday 18th May, or longer, as the Stewards require. Livestock cannot be removed earlier without written consent of the Chief Steward/ the Honorary Veterinary Officer and the Devon County Show Manager. Such consent will only be granted under exceptional circumstances.

15. Photographs and/or film footage will be taken at this event. These images may be used by the Devon County Agricultural Association, its subsidiaries (including but not limited to Devon County Show) and show sponsors in the following ways: • Printed publicity • Online publicity (including but not limited to Facebook, Instagram & Twitter) • Website use – (DCAA, its subsidiaries or sponsors) • Any other fair use in marketing and promoting the Devon County show by ourselves and our sponsors They will be stored securely and will not be kept for longer than they are needed for the purposes listed above. 

Burke Perpetual Challenge Trophies

The **Burke Perpetual Challenge Trophies** were introduced as a new award at the RASE Royal Show in 1951. The **Burke Trophies** mark the occasion of Sir Roland Burke's retirement in 1950 after twenty years of office.

Extracted from the Journal of the Royal Agricultural Society of England 1951:

'The Council accepted with gratitude three challenge cups from Sir Roland Burke (formerly Honorary Director) for competitions annually at the Royal Show. The trophies, offered in perpetuity, were awarded at the 1951 Cambridge Show as follows: (a) for the best two champions of a breed – one male and one female in the beef cattle section ; (b) for the best two champions of a breed – one male and one female in the dairy section; (c) for the best New Implement.'

Today, more than seventy years since the first presentation, the **Burke Trophies** remain the most prestigious cattle awards within UK farming.

Each year, a host agricultural society is chosen by RASE to be the host of the **Burke Trophies**. Exhibitors compete for the trophies at the host society's annual agricultural show.

The Burke Perpetual Challenge Trophy Judges

Mr William McLaren Netherton Aberdeen Angus, Perthshire, Scotland (Beef)

Internationally renowned Aberdeen Angus breeder and owner of the Netherton Herd William, is the fourth generation of the McLaren family which has dedicated over 100 years to breeding pedigree Aberdeen Angus cattle.

William is also Past President of the Aberdeen Angus Cattle Society and is currently General Secretary of the World Angus Secretariat.

The Netherton herd needs no introduction being one of the most influential prefix's of our time, having sold genetics in to every continent, they were the first to weigh cattle in 1958 and the first to sell the entire adult portion of their herd in one to Highland Wagyu under the Mohmar prefix, which William now runs alongside Netherton.

William has judged across the world in many different breeds, including Perth & Stirling Bull Sales, the Royal Highland Show, Sydney, Agribition and Farmfair International to name a few.



Mrs Wendy Young Churchroyd Dairy Shorthorns, West Riding, Yorkshire (Dairy)

Past President of the Dairy Shorthorn Cattle Society, Wendy currently sits on the breed society council. Wendy runs her cattle preparation business Clippaholics, working across the full spectrum of breeds.

Wendy has judged multiple breeds including at the New Zealand Dairy Event.

The Churchroyd prefix has become a household name within Shorthorn breeding circles with successes at major shows, chart-topping proven bulls in AI and record-breaking type classification scores. Indeed, the herd recently featured in Cowsmopolitan (the international multi dairy breed magazine) for the unique achievement of two consecutive generations of 97-point home-bred cows.

Multiple National Show and All Breed All Britain Calf Show Championship winners, the Churchroyd herd has claimed a constant string of three-coloured rosettes at county level across the decades.
