Please make sure you have read ALL the rules and regulations below:

Special Rules & Regulations applying to the Live Lamb/Carcass Section

- ENTRIES** - Exhibitors may make a maximum of two entries per class and the right is reserved to restrict entries. Each pair of lambs entered in the Butchers' Lamb class will automatically be entered into the corresponding Carcass class. Each entry to consist of a pair of butchers lambs, unless stated in the schedule. All lambs must carry a double set of EID tag and will be labelled with their corresponding catalogue number.
- TIMES OF ARRIVAL** – All live lambs must arrive at the abattoir, Gages Farm, Ashburton TQ13 7JW on Tuesday 19th May between 8am and 9am with all relevant and up to date movement licence documentation.
- JUDGING** -live lamb judging will commence at 9:30am. Judging of the carcasses will take place at the abattoir the following day and the prize-winning carcasses will then be transported to the showground for display at the Devon County Show. Carcasses not displayed will remain at Gages Farm, Ashburton TQ13 7JW and dealt with as per rule 5.
- ENTRY FEES** - All fees include VAT @ 20%. Members entry fee £16 PER LAMB, non members entry fee £18 PER LAMB. This fee covers both the Live Butcher's Lamb class and the Butchers Lamb Carcass class and is to include the killing fee.

5. **PRIZE MONEY** - 1st £29, 2nd £18, 3rd £13 and 4th £11 in each class.
6. **SALE OF CARCASS** – All carcasses shall be purchased by an accredited butcher, approved by the DCAA committee at the end of the show unless the exhibitor states that they wish to retain the carcass. The minimum price attained will be calculated by using the average deadweight price per kg at Hatherleigh, Launceston & Yetminster abattoirs at the time of slaughter. The price shall be multiplied by the deadweight of each carcass with no penalties.
7. The DCAA will use their best endeavours to look after all exhibits once killed and when at the Show but will not hold themselves responsible for any loss or damage arising from any cause whatsoever. The DCAA accepts no responsibility for the transport and storage of the entries and the exhibitor does so at their own risk.
8. No members of the public are to enter the abattoir nor the killing line without the permission of the abattoir.
9. All sheep and carcass exhibits to have been the bona fide property of the exhibitor at least four calendar months prior to the Show.
10. In live and carcass classes, all exhibits must be either ewe lambs or wether lambs, being fully castrated and showing only lambs teeth (no cutting).

- 435** **Single Butchers Lamb.** Breed or cross to be clearly stated on the entry form, nominating the ram first.
