## POINTS AWARDS - For all Sheep Exhibitors

**PTS1 The Johnstone Perpetual Challenge Cup** For Exhibitors resident in Devon gaining the highest number of points in the Horse, Cattle, Sheep and Pig classes. (Ref 1)

**PTS2 The Peter Holmes Memorial Perpetual Challenge Trophy** presented by his NAAS colleagues, for the exhibitor under 35 years of age and resident in Devon gaining the highest number of points in the Cattle, Sheep and Pig classes. Exhibitors must indicate on their entry form if they are eligible for this Trophy. (Ref 114). Exhibitors please note that partnerships are not eligible for this award unless all partners are under 35 years of age.

**PTS6 The F W Verney Memorial Perpetual Challenge Trophy.** Offered by members of his family, for the Exhibitor resident in Devon gaining the highest number of points in the Sheep and Wool classes. (Ref 81).

Points will be awarded on the basis of: Sheep Classes:- First Prize 4 points, Second Prize 3 points, Third Prize 2 points, Fourth Prize 1 points. Wool Classes:- First Prize 2 points; Second Prize 1 point.

## Special Regulations applying to Sheep Section

- ENTRY FEES** - Exhibitors are permitted to make up to two entries in any class. Unless otherwise stated in the schedule. The same animal may not be exhibited in more than one class other than the Group classes.

- PENS** - Exhibitors may book a maximum of six pens in any one breed. Exhibitors may enter as many sheep as they wish but must only bring to the Show the number, which can be accommodated in the pens booked. Pen Size 5ft x 5ft. The DCAA reserves the right to limit entries and/or pens should circumstances require. In the classes for pens of two or more the animals in each pen must be of the same flock. Please note sheep hurdles must be used for their intended purpose only.

- PRIZE MONEY** - Prizes are offered in relation to the number of entries catalogued in each class. Rosettes will be awarded to fourth place in all classes regardless of the number of entries catalogued. Unless otherwise stated in the schedule.

- FLEECE CLASSES** - Exhibitors may make as many entries as they wish for these classes.
- MAEDI VISNA** - Maedi-Visna accredited accommodation will only be provided for sheep which have been signified as being of such status on the entry form. In order to be admitted to the accredited accommodation, all Maedi Visna accredited sheep must be accompanied by the appropriate SAC Form within expiry date. Scrapie Monitored sheep will be accommodated and shown in unsegregated conditions. All female sheep, whether scrapie monitored or not, of all breeds, except Dorset Horn and Poll Dorset, must, at the time of the Show be a) non pregnant (empty), b) have not lambed within 30 days prior to arrival at the Show and c) not be subject to procedures which change the seasonal breeding pattern. All female Dorset Horn and Poll Dorset, and animals subject to procedures which change the seasonal breeding pattern, must be accompanied to the Show by a declaration for each animal confirming that the sheep are a) non pregnant (empty) and b) have not lambed in the previous 30 days.
- FLOCK BOOK** - All exhibits must be entered or eligible for entry in the Flock Book of its breed except the commercial lambs. Where entered as eligible for entry, proof shall be given to the Devon County Show Manager, if required.

7. **COLOURING** - Sheep should be shown according to their respective Breed Society rules.
8. **DOCKING** - The Mutilation (Permitted Procedures) (England) Regulations 2007 Schedule 5.5 - In all cases sheep must have enough of the tail retained to cover the vulva of the female sheep and the anus of the male sheep. Sheep entered for the Devon County Show are liable to be inspected on arrival or in the lines by member of Trading Standards Service or/and Animal Health. Any sheep which do not comply will not be eligible to be shown and no refunds will be given.
9. **JUDGING RINGS** - Exhibitors must not groom, exercise or graze their sheep in the areas designated as Judging Rings. Sheep must be on halters when travelling between pens and judging rings, including the Grand Parade.
10. **SHEEP SCAB** - Exhibitors must comply with sheep scab regulations in force at the time of the Show.
11. **TIMES OF ARRIVAL** - Please note that sheep must arrive between 2pm- 7pm on Tuesday or 7:30am and 8pm on Wednesday.
12. **DEPARTURE** - All livestock must remain until 4.30pm on the last day of the show, Saturday 18th May, or longer, as the Stewards require. Livestock cannot be removed earlier without written consent of the Chief Steward/ the Honorary Veterinary Officer and the Devon County Show Manager. Such consent will only be granted under exceptional circumstances.
13. **TICKET ALLOCATION** – Wristbands will be allocated according to the table below. Wristbands allow access for all 3 days of the show.

Special Regulations applying to the Live Lamb/Carcass Section

- ENTRIES** - Exhibitors may make a maximum of two entries per class and the right is reserved to restrict entries. Each pair of lambs entered in the Butchers' Lamb class will automatically be entered into the corresponding Carcass class. Each entry to consist of a pair of butchers lambs, unless stated in the schedule. All lambs must carry a double set of EID tag and will be labelled with their corresponding catalogue number.
- TIMES OF ARRIVAL** – All live lambs must arrive at the abattoir, Gages Farm, Ashburton TQ13 7JW on Tuesday 19<sup>th</sup> May between 8am and 9am with all relevant and up to date movement licence documentation.
- JUDGING** -live lamb judging will commence at 9:30am. Judging of the carcasses will take place at the abattoir the following day and the prize-winning carcasses will then be transported to the showground for display at the Devon County Show. Carcasses not displayed will remain at Gages Farm, Ashburton TQ13 7JW and dealt with as per rule 5.
- ENTRY FEES** – Members entry fee £16 PER LAMB, non members entry fee £18 PER LAMB. This fee covers both the Live Butcher's Lamb class and the Butchers Lamb Carcass class and is to include the killing fee.
