Individual Memberships are available at £20.00 and include admission to the Show and Members’ Marquee.

TICKETING

All exhibitors will be required to have an e-ticket or wristband to gain entry to the show field. Adult exhibitors whose entry fees total £10 or more (£9 for Sheep exhibitors) or children whose entry fees total £1 or more (unless otherwise stated) will receive an exhibitor’s e-ticket to the showground per £10 spent, up to a maximum of 5 tickets.

Additional prepaid e-tickets can be purchased at the time of class entry (maximum 4 per exhibitor) at £10 for adults (£15 on gate) and £3 for children aged 3 and over (£5 on gate). Children under 3 are admitted free of charge and do not require a ticket. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to bring a valid e-ticket or wristband with them on the day.

GENERAL REMARKS AND STIPULATIONS

Exhibitors are responsible for complying with all regulations from all statutory bodies including all movement licenses and restrictions. We also reserve the right to cancel any classes or indeed the show, should it be necessary. Refunds will not be made. Exhibitors enter the show field at their own risk. The Garstang Agricultural & Horticultural Society and its members, secretary and directors accept no responsibility for any losses incurred on the show field. Exhibitors should ensure that they have adequate insurance.

1.	BEST MULTICOLOURED GOAT Any sex
2.	WETHER OR FEMALE NOT ELIGIBLE FOR REGISTRATION under 1 year
3.	WETHER OR FEMALE NOT ELIGIBLE FOR REGISTRATION over 1 year
4.	JUNIOR HANDLER Age 16 and under
5.	FEMALE KID 8 WEEKS TO 1 YEAR
6.	FEMALE 1 - 2 YEARS not to have borne a kid
7.	ADULT FEMALE OVER 2 YEARS
8.	VETERAN FEMALE
9.	MALE KID 8 WEEKS TO 1 YEAR
10.	MALE 1 – 2 YEARS
11.	ADULT MALE OVER 2 YEARS
12.	DAM AND OFFSPRING all must have been entered in breed classes
