### Judge Mr M West

**Class 5** - Jar of Jam any fruit, must be clearly labelled with ingredients

**Class 6** - Jar of marmalade of any type, must be clearly labelled with ingredients

**Class 7** - 3 decorated biscuits, judged for decoration only. Decorator aged 10 or under

**Class 8** - 3 homemade & decorated biscuits, judged for taste and decoration. Made by a person aged 11 to 16 years old

**Class 9** - Victoria Sponge, we would like the ingredients listed please.

**Class 10** - Chocolate Brownie, a plate of 4, ingredients listed please.

**Class 11** - A plate of 4 flapjacks ingredients listed please

**Class 19** - 2m of bunting made from ANY recycled materials.
