TGCA TOYS In Hand and Ridden Classes

Breed classes are qualifiers for the best of breed finals at the traditional gypsy cob Associations (TGCA) national breed championship show "TOYS"

Classes are open to all traditional gypsy cobs. Competitors do not need to know the breeding of their cob , but they must meet breed standard to enter the class.

Stallions - All stallions (four years and over) in order to enter any TGCA affiliated class MUST have be TGCA registered, have passed TGCA evaluations and their TGCA stallion disc displayed on their bridle. Stallions/ colts three year old and over , **MUST** be shown in a stallion bridle with a metal bit and chain lead .

Existing TGCA members that qualify **MUST** present their qualification card to the judge in the ring and **MUST** have already <u>completed the cobs name and</u> <u>registration number</u> prior to the judge signing.

Non members that qualify should receive non members qualification card from the judge in the ring and have 21 days to join the TGCA and register their horse to validate the qualification.

- Excessive use of artificial aids or abuse of horses/ponies will not be tolerated, any person seen to be doing so will be asked to leave the showground.
- The show or its officials cannot be held responsible for damage, loss or injury to persons or animals due to accident or any other cause.
- The organisers have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective everyone must take precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and obey instructions of the organisers.
