Kenilworth & District Agricultural Society KENILWORTH SHOW - SHOWING REGULATIONS

- I. Exhibits in all classes must be the bona-fide property of the exhibitors and must be in their possession and ownership at the date fixed for the closing of entries.
- 2. It shall be left to the discretion of the Judges whether a third prize be awarded in classes where there are less than four entries and a second prize where there are less than three entries.
 - The Society reserves the right to amalgamate or cancel any class or classes in the event of insufficient entries being received. If there are sufficient entries of a particular breed the society can add a breed class if they see fit.
- The decisions of the Judges shall be final. Objections of any kind must be made in writing and delivered to the Secretary, together with a deposit of £25 for each objection, within one hour of the Judges' decision being given on the day of the show. Such objections to be considered by the Committee, or a quorum of the same, and their decision to be final. The deposit to be forfeited if the objection be deemed frivolous.
- 4. The Committee do not hold themselves responsible for any loss or accident of any kind that may arise on the Show Ground, involving exhibitors or exhibitors property.
- 5. Each Animal must be in the charge of an attendant and suitably haltered, and must stand against its number as catalogued, and all attendants will be required to conform to any rules and regulations the Committee may deem expedient to enforce. Exhibitors are required to provide 2 leaders for each BULL over 9 months old.
- 6. Livestock considered not to be under control, in the view of the Chief Steward, will be asked to leave the Showground, forfeiting their entry fees and other fees paid.
- 7 All animals must be on the Showground by 9.00 a.m. and must not leave the Showground until after the Grand Parade.
- 8. Any exhibitor sending an animal to the Show knowing the same to be suffering from a contagious disease may be expelled from the Society. Exhibitors are reminded that the Society will accept no responsibility for animals which contract any disease, as the result of exhibition at the Show.
- 9. All Stock must be paraded when and where required. First, Second and Third prize-winners in all Livestock Classes (other than Sheep) are required to appear in the Grand Parade. Failure to do so (except in exceptional circumstances and with the Chief Steward's consent) may result in forfeiture of prize money and trophies)
- 10. The Stewards reserve the right of refusing any entry into the Show ring.
- 11. An exhibitor cannot act as Judge's Steward in any Class in which he has an entry.
- All entries **must** be made on the official entry form and full particulars of each exhibit including sire and dam where applicable to be completed. No animal to win more than two first prizes excepting Championships and Specials.
- All Challenge Cups must be returned to the Secretary by not later than 31st March 2022.
- 14 The Committee will not be responsible for any error, which may appear in the Catalogue, or for any entry being made in the wrong Class.
- 15 **Entries close** finally on **Saturday 14th May 2022**. It will greatly assist the Committee and Secretary if entries are sent at least one week before this date. Late Entries cannot be accepted.
- The stewards of the Society reserve the right to have any animal examined by a veterinary surgeon, who may take samples of any body fluids for the purposes of laboratory testing to establish if any substance which is not considered a normal nutrient has been administered to the animal. If any examination or tests prove positive, then the facts will be reported to the Council of the Society and to any appropriate breed Society or other organisation.
- 17 Kenilworth Show reserves the right to amalgamate classes in the event of a minimum of five entries per class from three exhibitors.
- PASSES: Vehicles carrying livestock and their accompanying attendants will be admitted free of charge therefore <u>no passes will be issued</u>. Livestock attendants travelling separately to the livestock vehicle may apply in advance for a vehicle pass.

KENILWORTH & DISTRICT AGRICULTURAL SOCIETY LIVESTOCK VETERINARY REQUIREMENTS

The Society regrets that it is not possible to receive Livestock exhibits prior to the day of the show, except in exceptional circumstances and with the Secretary's permission.

The Society's Veterinary Officer will be present on the showground for the duration of the show. In any case concerning the health of an animal the decision of the Society's Veterinary Officer shall be final.

EVERY EXHIBITOR OF LIVESTOCK shall be liable to pay to the Society a sum not exceeding £25.00 as and for liquidating damages for each and every animal sent for Exhibition which, in the opinion of any of the Society's Veterinary Officer is showing any symptoms of contagious or infectious disease. An animal accepted for entry must not be consigned to the Showground if either it or the herd to which it belongs becomes subject to movement restrictions served by any Officer of the Ministry of Agriculture, Department of Agriculture for Scotland, the Local Authority or the Police.

CATTLE

Must be from Herds which are free from restrictions imposed under:

- 1. The Tuberculosis Order 1964
- 2. The Brucellosis Orders

NEITHER THE SOCIETY NOR IT'S OFFICERS shall in any way be responsible or accountable for anything that may happen, from any cause or circumstance to Exhibitors, their servants, exhibit, vehicle, crate, package, or any other article or thing brought to the Show or attributable in any way to the Society's Show.

Each Exhibitor shall be solely responsible for any consequential or other loss, injury, damage done to or occasioned by, or arising from any animal or article exhibited by him and for its description in the Catalogue and shall indemnify the Society against all legal or other proceedings in regard thereto. Exhibitors shall be responsible for the behaviour of their servants and for the consequences of any misconduct of such servants.

Advice about Cattle Passports

Cattle Passports will be required and need to be officially stamped/recorded by the Society. Relevant numbers and bar codes for stock will be issued on the day of the Show.


