#### CONDITIONS FOR ENTRY

- 1. All jumping competitions will be held according to the rules and regulations of British Showjumping.
- 2. Entries in classes 250 263 are restricted to horses registered with British Showjumping and ridden by members in accordance with the 2023 British Showjumping Rule book.
- 3. **Entries close Monday 1st July 2024** or earlier in competitions where entries are limited. Entries will not be accepted after the closing date.
- 4. Each entry must be accompanied by the appropriate entry fee, which includes VAT. Entry cancellations must be made in writing to <a href="mailto:alice.bennett@kcas.org.uk">alice.bennett@kcas.org.uk</a> not later than 12 noon on Wednesday 3rd July. are confirmed in writing by Friday 5th July latest. This refund will then be Refunds of 50% entry fees will be made only if the cancellations made within one month of the date of the Show. Please note that stable charges are not refundable.
- 5. Nomination entries will not be accepted.
- 6. Exhibitors/owners/riders British Showjumping membership numbers must be shown on the entry form together with the horse's registration number.
- 7. A time limit will be adopted for all jumping competitions and will be announced before the competition starts. Automatic timing apparatus will be in operation.
- 8. When a standard has been reached competitors making more than a certain number of faults may be retired.
- 9. In the jumping classes a substitute entry will be accepted only in accordance with British Showjumping Rules 79.3.
- 10. The Committee reserves the right to alter or amend the program if it should be necessary.
- 11. Rapping in the collecting ring or anywhere on, or in the vicinity of the Showground is strictly prohibited. Any abuse of horses will not be tolerated in accordance with British Showjumping Rule 103.
- 12. Dress. All competitors must wear uniform, hunting costume or appropriate hats and coats to comply with British Showjumping Rule 101.
- 13. The drawn order of jumping for each competition will be done by 4pm on the day before that competition. This order of jumping will be displayed on <a href="www.kcas.org.uk">www.kcas.org.uk</a> and in the collecting ring and competitors must jump in this order. Any competitor missing his turn may be eliminated from the competition.
- 14. Competitors will be permitted to inspect the course dismounted only during the times allocated for this purpose and must be correctly dressed. Details will be posted on the collecting ring notice board.
- 15. The Society reserves the right to limit entries and to introduce a standard if necessary.

BSJA Rule 274. Table A. Speed 375mpm. Height of fences approximately 1.30m, plus the joker at a maximum height of 1.45m. Drawn order.

This competition takes place over 6, 8 or 10 obstacles which are progressively more difficult. No combination obstacles are allowed. The progressive difficulty is not solely due to height and spread of the obstacles, but also to the difficulty of the track.

This class will be strictly restricted to 40 entries. Entries will be accepted in order received. No rider may enter more than TWO horses in this class.

Points are awarded as follows:

One point for obstacle No. 1 cleared, two points for No. 2, three points for No. 3 etc. with total of 21, 36 or 55 points.

No point is awarded for an obstacle knocked down. Faults other than knock-downs are penalised as for Table A and any

of these faults, including time faults, are converted into points, and deducted from any jumping points scored.

In the event of equality of points for first place, there will be a jump-off against the clock over a shortened course, over obstacles that may be increased in height and/or spread. The obstacles in the jump-off must be jumped in the same order as in the first round and retain their respective points allotted in the first round.

This competition may also take place directly against the clock.

For the last obstacle of the course, an alternative obstacle may be provided, of which one part may be designated the Joker. The Joker must be more difficult than the alternative obstacle and carry double points. If the Joker is knocked down, the points must be deducted from the total.

This class will be strictly restricted to 40 entries. Entries will be accepted in order received. No rider may enter more than THREE horses in this class.

Eligibility: All horses/ponies eligible except Grade A horses and JA ponies. Both Horse and Rider can compete for more than one team.

Scoring: One round - best three scores to count towards the team total. The first round will be timed and used if equality for lower placings.

Ties: Jump off for first place only. One nominated team member for each team to jump off. Equality of minor placing will be decided on the aggregate times of the three scoring members of each tying team.

Course Specification: As BRC Intermediate.

Entries will be run as drawn orders under paragraph 14 of the Conditions of Entry for Showjumping. The drawn order will be displayed on the Kent County Agricultural Society website.
