Scarecrow Competition Rules:

- Schools/clubs may enter a maximum of 2 scarecrows.
- Scarecrows should either be free standing or made so they can be attached to a fence post.
- Not to exceed 2m tall x 1m wide
- Can be displayed outside, if necessary.
- All Scarecrows need to be delivered to the Show field between 10am-3pm on Thursday 5th September or Friday 6th September.
- To be collected after 5pm on the Show day or the morning of Sunday 8th September. Any not collected will be lovingly disposed of.

NB: An exhibit is plant material with or without accessories. No artificial plant material to be used. Height is not restricted except where stated. Open staging on off white surface and against side of marquee. All classes will be viewed and judged from the front.

Exhibitors may choose to bring exhibits pre-done or assemble on site by 9.00am.

- 603 From the Toy Box – a miniature exhibit. Space allowed 10cm width,
10cm depth, height unlimited
- 604 Our Crazy life – a modern exhibit. Space allowed 60cm width,
60cm depth
- 605 Farming Life – an exhibit. Space allowed 60cm width, 60cm depth
- 606 Happy Memories – a NOVICE class for anyone who has not won a first
prize in the Floral Art Section of this show. Space allowed 60cm width,
60cm depth.
