

YOUNG ADULTS – Exhibitors aged 12-16 years inclusive:

NEW TO KINGSBRIDGE SHOW IN 2025!

Each exhibitor will be provided with a 1m x 1m base to display their crafts. Each year, a new theme will be given and exhibitors will display a range of 5 different crafts linked to this theme. The base will be plain white but exhibitors can personalise the base with temporary decoration that must be removed when exhibits are taken down. The items are marked separately as well as given a total of points overall.

2025 Theme: Woodland:

Craft 1 - Natural Artwork. Using flowers, natural resources etc in a suitable container.

Craft 2 - Cookery/Baker. This craft will be tasted so must be covered with cling film.

Craft 3 - Poem. Written by yourself; presentation considered when judging.

Craft 4 - Artwork. An item such as drawing, painting, collage in any medium.

Craft 5 - Photograph. Capturing the theme and showing skill in the shot.

A £10 Donovan Department Store, Kingsbridge Voucher to be awarded for the most points in the Cookery/Baking Craft.

The ‘Harbour Bookshop’ Perpetual Trophy and £10 Book Voucher to be awarded for the most points in the Poem Craft.

'The Kingsbridge Pet and Garden Perpetual Cup' awarded for the most points in the Natural Art Craft.

A Challenge Cup presented by Ms A.K. Taylor to the Exhibitor with the most points in the Young Adults Section. To be won any three times before becoming the absolute property of the winner.

NB: For Novice Horticultural classes – Exhibitors aged 18 years and Under: please refer to classes 728-735 in the Horticultural Section.

GENERAL RULES AND CONDITIONS

1. All Horticulture/Homecraft/Childrens'/Arable and Young Farmer exhibits must be

delivered and placed by 9am with vehicles OFF SITE.

2.All exhibits must remain on the field until 5pm. The Show reserves the right to withhold any prize money which may have been awarded to anyone failing to comply.

3.Competent Judges will be selected, who may not be competitors at the Show. Their decision is final.

4.The Judges will be empowered to withhold the prizes including trophies/cups in any of the classes where they are of the opinion there is not sufficient merit in competition.

5.In case of protest or dispute, the same shall be stated in writing to the Show Secretary immediately the exhibit in dispute has been judged and the sum of £10 must be deposited with the Show Secretary by the person(s) raising the objection. All questions of protest or dispute will be decided by the Show, whose decision shall be binding and final on all parties.

6.In all cases where three prizes are offered, unless the exhibits exceed the number of prizes by two, one or more prizes may be withheld at the discretion of the Show.

7.In all cases where there are insufficient entries in any class, the Show reserves the right to cancel the class.

8.While the Officials take every care, the Show will not in any case or under any circumstances be responsible for any accident, loss, damage or injury to the competitors, exhibitors and to the public attending the Show, or for stock or produce which may be exhibited at the Show.

9.Owners, competitors and riders are under obligation at all times when mounted to ensure that they are wearing protective head gear complying with current British Standards.

10.All cups and trophies must be returned by 31st July to the Cup Secretary and must be kept fully insured by the prize winners while in their possession. All cups and trophies must be looked after in a careful manner and returned in the same condition as when awarded/collected, failing which the exhibitor will be responsible for repair at their own cost and may lead to disqualification from entering future shows.

Failure to return cups and trophies may lead to the Show taking legal action for their recovery and a financial penalty being imposed. Cups remain the property of Kingsbridge Show at all times.
