All adult sheep to be shorn, and will be subject to dipping regulations if applicable.

INFECTION: If there is any doubt over Sheep Scab - Please may we ask you do not bring your sheep to the show. Breed Society Rules to be adhered to.

THE SHOW RESERVE THE RIGHT TO AMALGAMATE OR REMOVE CLASSES IF FEWER THAN 3 EXHIBITORS, AND TO ADJUST JUDGING TIMES to ensure the smooth running of the Show.

IMPORTANT: Please note that various breeds of sheep will be judged simultaneously.

Therefore exhibitors with entries in more than one specific breed must ensure that they have sufficient handlers to exhibit in all breeds at any one time.

Junior Handler classes will be judged first. All other judging will take place after this. Specific timings are dependent on the number of entries received. Thank you for your consideration.
