The BDS Iceline Yorkshire Ltd National Championships

RULES

All classes judged under BDS Rules, these can be found on the BDS Website.

Correctly fitting hard hats recommended, **compulsory** for drivers, grooms, passengers aged 14 and under, when in the carriage or in attendance with a turnout.

Only pneumatic tyres specifically designed for carriages (no car tyres)

All horses/ponies must be 4 years old or over.

Special award to the best groom in each class

All exhibitors should hold their own insurance.

Trophy for highest placed junior whip.

Trophies awarded in all classes.

All trophies to be returned to the Carriage Driving Secretary
at least **One Month** prior to 2027 Show date.

Entry Fee Classes 1-4 £15.00

Concours and £10.00

Prize money in all classes: 1st £25, 2nd £10, 3rd £5

Rosettes to 6th place

This show is a qualifier for the **BDS Iceline Yorkshire Ltd National Championships**.

The highest placed turnout in the designated type section, disregarding those already qualified down to 6th place, will qualify for the 2026 National Driving Championship semi finals at Addington Equestrian Centre on 5th September, 2026. Type sections c, d, e, j, k & l.

- (c) Private driving over 13:2 hh – single, pair or tandem
- (d) Private driving 13:2 hh and under single, pair or tandem
- (e) Registered mountain & moorland (excluding registered welsh) single, pair or tandem
- (j) Single or tandem turnout driven to a two wheeled exercise vehicle
- (k) Single, pair or tandem turnout driven to a four wheel exercise vehicle
- (l) Single, pair or tandem coloured horse or pony, any vehicle

Judging to Commence not before 1pm

Class 1: Novice

Open to single or multiple, harnessed to any suitable vehicle. Combinations not to have won a first rosette prior to 1st January 2026

Class 2: Local

Open to single or multiple harnessed to any suitable vehicle, shown by exhibitor living within 15 miles of Leek.

Class 3: Exercise Vehicle

Open to single or multiple. Driven to a none traditional type vehicle including those with pneumatic tyres specifically designed for carriages (I.e not car tyres). Lamps not needed.

Class 4: Private Driving

Private Driving, single or multiple harnessed to a traditional or traditional type vehicle.

Class will be split if sufficient entries.
