18	Novice Showing	Rider to be correct size for horse/pony. Competitors will be expected to canter as a group
19	Show Pony/ show hunter pony	Not exceeding 15h
20	Ridden Plaited Horse	Open to all plaited horses exceeding 148 cm
21	Ridden Cob	Open to hogged or hairy cobs
22	Ridden coloured horse or pony	Open to coloured spotted, palomino dun and cremello. Any height
23	L.R. Show pony, Show Hunter or Mountain & Moorland	Riders aged 10 and under and ponies to be a suitable height for a L.R.
24	First Ridden show pony, show hunter or mountain & moorland	Riders aged 13 years and under and ponies to be a suitable height for a first ridden
25	L.R. / F.R. Best Rider	Judged on riding ability only, ages as above
